




Hebrews 11:1

seated at the right hand of the throne of God.




Romans 5

• **4** and endurance produces character, and character produces hope,


5 and hope does not put us to shame, because God's love has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit who has been given to us.



will be burned as fuel for the fire.

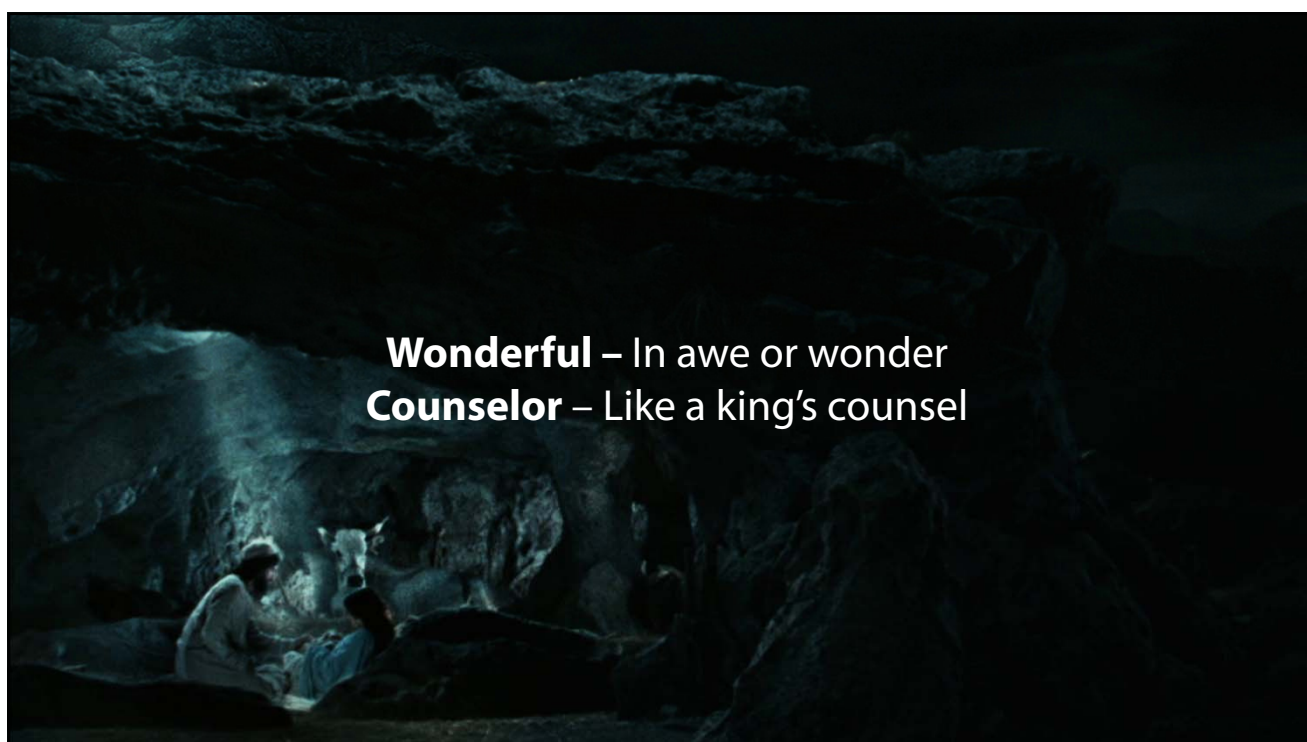
