- •1819 Founding of Singapore by Sir Stamford Raffles.

 Early Anglican settlers from British East India Company in Singapore.
- •1826 Anglican Church established.
- •1843 Rev Keasberry set up Malay Chapel in Prinsep Street which is today's Prinsep Street Presbyterian Church.
- ·1864 Philip Robinson with 6 others started brethren fellowship
- •1885 Methodist missionaries James Thoburn and William Oldham landed in Singapore.
- •1928 Assembly of God church established.
- •1937 Baptist church established.
- •1953 Lutheran Church established.

Our Brethren Pioneer(s)

- An English Christian Businessman, Philip Robinson
- ▶ 1857, set Foot in Singapore
- In Early 1860s, likeminded believers gathered
 - Bible Study, Fellowship & Break-Bread at the Lord's Table
- At First, Evangelistic Efforts Concentrated on the British **Colonial Society**
- Later, a Real Burden To Reaching out to all Races
- In 1864, a Mission Room was started at 108 Bencoolen Street as beginnings of a Brethren Assembly.

Bethesda Katong Church

NEW CHURCH Branch Of The Bethesda In Katong

A new \$10,000 church has been built in Katong. It is situated off Dunman Road at the corner of Carpmael and Pennefather Roads, and is a branch of "Bethesda," Katong.

Is a branch of "Betnessua," Katong.

Mr. Wee Thiam Seng, a retired banker, presented the land for the site, and the money for the building and equipment was subscribed by members of "Bethesda," Bras Basah Road, except for a donation from up-country.

The church provides accommodation for more than 200 people, and is intended to serve the Katong district. It is to be known as "Bethesda," Katong, and services will be held in English, Chinese and Tamil on Sundays, Tuesdays and

The church will be formally opened on Feb. 29 at 6 p.m. by Mr. Wee Thiam Seng.

The Sunday School, hitherto held in two shophouses in East Coast Road, will be transferred to the new church as from Sunday, March 1. More than 100 children attend the classes every than 10 Sunday.

The new church is an attractive little building made of brick and tile, teak and "chengai." The estimated worth of the building, land and equipment is in the neighbourhood of \$10,000.




Newspaper Report of Opening of Bethesda (Katong) February 1936.

- Young leaders of BKC committed to the Great Commission began children ministry work in Bedok-Tampines vicinity in Dec 1979.
- Then, the Lord provided an ideal piece of land for a new church, BKC launched by faith the project to plant a new church at this site.







BBTC - Our History


- Other brethren assembly came alongside:
 - Bethesda (Frankel Estate) Church (BFEC)
 - Bethesda Bedok Mission Home (now Bethesda Pasir Ris Mission Church).
- BBTC was registered as a legal entity, on 8 Aug1984.
- 1st worship service was held on 2 Nov 1986.
- The beloved late Dr Benjamin Chew was our first Chairman Elder of the council.
- Nov 1988, BKC gave complete autonomy and the BBTC Council became an independent assembly of believers.

Proverbs 27:17 As iron sharpens iron, so one person sharpens another.


3. Circumstances
