




and a two-edged sword in their hand ...






1. <u>Decide</u> to bring our praises to God at all times.

Psalm 34:1 (NIV) I will bless the Lord <u>at all times</u>; His praise shall <u>continually</u> be in my mouth.

Psalm 138:1-2

1 <u>will</u> praise You with my whole heart; before the gods <u>will</u> sing praises to You. 2 <u>will</u> worship toward Your holy temple, and praise Your name for Your lovingkindness and Your truth; for You have magnified Your word above all Your name.



2A. Praise brings us into the <u>courts</u> of God.


Psalm 100:4 Enter into His gates with thanksgiving, and <u>into His courts with</u> **praise**. Be thankful to Him, and bless His name.

2B. Praise is preceded by thanksgiving.

Psalm 100:4 Enter into His gates with thanksgiving, and into His courts with praise. <u>Be thankful</u> to Him, and bless His name.

Thank God for what He <u>HAS</u> done!

2C. Praise is preceded by <u>confidence</u> to come into the Presence of God by the <u>Blood of Jesus</u> and through the <u>Lord Jesus</u>, our High Priest.

Hebrews 10:19-22

19 Therefore, brethren, having **boldness** to enter the Holiest by the **blood of Jesus**, 20 by a new and living way which He consecrated for us, through the veil, that is, His flesh, 21 and having a **High Priest** over the house of God, 22 let us <u>draw near</u> with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water.

Let us now appropriate the Blood and call on the Lord

Summary Steps to Come Into The Presence of God:

- 1. <u>Decide</u> to bring our praises to God at all times.
- Confidence to come into the Presence of God by the <u>Blood of Jesus</u> and through the <u>Lord Jesus</u>, our Great High Priest.
- 3. Thanksgiving Spirit of Gratefulness.
- 4. Praise.
- 5. Worship.

3A. Praise enables us to declare and proclaim who God is.

Hebrews 13:15 Therefore by Him let us continually offer the <u>sacrifice of praise</u> to God, that is, the <u>fruit of our lips</u>, giving thanks to <u>His Name</u> / <u>confessing</u> <u>His Name / exalting His Name</u>.

1 Peter 2:9 But you are a <u>chosen generation</u>, a <u>royal priesthood</u>, a <u>holy nation</u>, His <u>own special people</u>, that you may <u>proclaim</u> the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light.

Enlarge our Praise Vocabulary! Know God and His Ways!

Praise enables us to declare and proclaim who God is. 3A. Psalm 23: The 7 Redemptive Names of God: He is my Jehovah-Rohi who loved me and gave His life for me. i. He is my Jehovah-Shalom the LORD, My Peace. ii. He is my Jehovah-Tsidkenu the LORD, My Righteousness. III. He is my Jehovah-Jireh the LORD will provide. İV. He is my Jehovah-Rapha the LORD who heals. 3B. Praise enables us to call on the specific name of God in order to draw upon the specific grace that we need in our lives.
Psalm 68:19 Blessed be the Lord, Who daily loads us with benefits, the God of our salvation! Selah

3B. Praise enables us to call on the <u>specific name</u> of God in order to draw upon the <u>specific grace</u> that we <u>need</u> in our lives.

Psalm 103:1-5 (AMP)

1 Bless and affectionately praise the Lord, O my soul, and all that is [deep] within me, bless His holy name. 2 Bless and affectionately praise the Lord, O my soul, and do not forget any of <u>His benefits</u>; 3 Who <u>forgives</u> all your sins, Who <u>heals</u> all your diseases; 4 Who <u>redeems</u> your life from the pit, Who <u>crowns</u> you [lavishly] with <u>lovingkindness and</u> <u>tender mercy</u>; 5 Who <u>satisfies</u> your years with good things, so that your <u>youth is renewed</u> like the [soaring] eagle.

- **3C.** Praise means we call out the **specific attributes** of each person of the God-head over our lives.
 - i. The love of Father-God.
 - ii. The light [grace and truth] of the Lord Jesus.
 - iii. The life of the Holy Spirit.




Give thanks and praise for the Bread - the Body of Christ

- 1. He died for our <u>salvation</u> Romans 10:9-10
- He died to pay the <u>penalty</u> for our sins Romans 6:23; John 1:29; 2 Corinthians 5:21
- 3. He died to place us in His <u>Body</u> 1 Corinthians 12:12-13
- He died for our names to be in the <u>Book of Life</u> John 3:3; 3:16; Luke 10:20; Revelation 20:15
- 5. He died to give us the *life-giving Spirit* 1 Corinthians 15:45
- 6. He died for our *bodily healing* Matthew 8:16-17
- 7. As led ...

Give thanks and praise for the Cup - the Blood of Christ

- 1. His Blood <u>*cleanses*</u> our sins Hebrews 9:22
- 2. His Blood <u>covers</u> our sins 1 John 2:2
- His Blood <u>redeems</u> us and we receive <u>forgiveness</u> of our sins -Colossians 1:14; Ephesians 1:7
- 4. His Blood is the seal of the *New Covenant* 1 Corinthians 11:25
- 5. His Blood gives us *life* Hebrews 9:14-15
- 6. We overcome the evil one by His Blood Revelation 12:1
- 7. As led ...







Expresses joy, jubilation and celebration.





25 But about midnight when Paul and Silas were praying and singing hymns of praise to God, and the prisoners were listening to them;
26 suddenly there was a great earthquake, so [powerful] that the very foundations of the prison were shaken and at once all the doors were opened and everyone's chains were unfastened.

As we bring our burdens and yokes to God, Sing <u>Spiritual Songs</u> to the Lord

Ephesians 5:19 speaking to one another in psalms and hymns and **spiritual songs**, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord ...

Colossians 3:16 Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom, teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and <u>spiritual songs</u>, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord.

5. High Praise:

- An intense level of praise.
- Songs sung in the heavenlies by angels, creatures and saints around the <u>Throne of God</u>.


Root of the word "hallelujah" which means "praise (halla) to jah (God)".

5A. High Praises open doors for God to battle for us.

Isaiah 30:32 (NKJV) And in every place where the staff of punishment passes, which the Lord lays on him, it will be with <u>tambourines and</u> <u>harps</u>; and <u>in battles of brandishing He will</u> <u>fight with it</u>.

Isaiah 30:32 (AMP) And every blow of the rod of punishment, which the Lord will lay on them, <u>tambourines and lyres</u>; and in battles, brandishing weapons, He will fight Assyria.



5B. High Praises enables us to overcome our <u>enemies</u> and <u>the enemies</u> <u>of God</u>.

2 Chronicles 20:21-22


21 And when he had consulted with the people, he appointed those who should <u>sing to the Lord</u>, and who should <u>praise the beauty of holiness</u>, as they went out before the army and were <u>saying</u>: "<u>Praise the Lord</u>, <u>for His mercy endures</u> forever." 22 Now when they began to sing and



to praise, the Lord set ambushes against the people of Ammon, Moab, and Mount Seir, who had come against Judah; and they were defeated.

5B. High Praises enables us to overcome our <u>enemies</u> and <u>the enemies</u> <u>of God</u>.

Matthew 5:44 But I say to you, <u>love</u> your enemies, <u>bless</u> those who curse you, <u>do good</u> to those who hate you, and <u>pray</u> for those who spitefully use you and persecute you ...



5C. High Praises on the lips of our children will give us strength and will <u>silence our enemies</u>.

Judges 2:7, 10

7 So the <u>people served the Lord</u> all the days of Joshua, and all the days of the elders who outlived Joshua, who had <u>seen</u> <u>all the great works of the Lord which He had done for Israel</u>.

10 When all that generation had been gathered to their fathers, <u>another generation</u> arose after them who <u>did not know the Lord</u> <u>nor the work which He had done for Israel</u>.



5C. High Praises on the lips of our children will give us strength and will <u>silence our enemies</u>.

Psalm 145:4-11

4 One generation shall praise Your works to another, and shall declare Your mighty acts. 5 I will meditate on the glorious splendor of Your majesty, and on Your wondrous works.
6 Men shall speak of the might of Your awesome acts, and I will declare Your greatness. 7 They shall utter the memory of Your great goodness, and shall sing of Your righteousness.
8 The Lord is gracious and full of compassion, slow to anger and great in mercy. 9 The Lord is good to all, and His tender mercies are over all His works. 10 All Your works shall praise You, O Lord, and Your saints shall bless You. 11 They shall speak of the glory of Your kingdom, and talk of Your power



5C. High Praises on the lips of our children will give us strength and will <u>silence our enemies</u>.

Psalm 78:5 For He established a <u>testimony</u> in Jacob, and appointed a <u>law</u> in Israel, which He commanded our fathers, that they should <u>make them</u> <u>known to their children</u>; 6 that the <u>generation to come</u> might know them, the children who would be born, that they may arise and declare them to their children, 7 that they may <u>set their hope in God</u>, and <u>not forget the</u> <u>works of God</u>, but <u>keep His commandments</u>; 8 and may not be like their fathers, a stubborn and rebellious generation, a generation that did not set its heart aright, and whose spirit was not faithful to God. 9 The children of Ephraim, being armed and carrying bows, turned back in the day of battle.
10 They did not keep the covenant of God; they refused to walk in His law, 11 and forgot His works and His wonders that He had shown them.

Let us bring our high praises to the Lord!

Bottom Line How to be a Praise-Empowered Believer?

Jeremiah 2:2 (NIV) Go and proclaim in the ears of Jerusalem, saying, 'Thus says the Lord, "<u>I remember [earnestly] the lovingkindness and devotion of your youth</u>, <u>your time of betrothal [like that of a bride during the early years in Egypt and again at Sinai], when you followed Me in the wilderness</u>, through a land not sown.

God remembers no more our sins that are under the Blood!

But, He remembers our <u>devotion</u> to Him!
