Isaiah 60:1-3

1 Arise, shine; for <u>your light</u> has come! And the <u>glory of the Lord</u> is risen upon you. 2 For behold, the darkness shall cover the earth, and <u>deep darkness</u> the people; but the Lord will arise over you, and <u>His glory will be seen upon</u> <u>you</u>. 3 The Gentiles shall come to <u>your light</u>, and kings to the <u>brightness of</u> <u>your rising</u>. 14 Then He appointed twelve, that they might <u>be with Him</u> and that He might send them out <u>to preach</u>, 15 and to have <u>power to heal sicknesses</u> and <u>to cast out</u> <u>demons</u>...

I. Be with <u>Jesus</u>.

The Lord Jesus called the disciples to be with Him.



1. The disciple must first be plugged in the **<u>Body Life</u>**.



John 3:3 Jesus answered and said to him, "Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one is <u>born again</u>, he cannot <u>see</u> the kingdom of God."

John 3:5 Jesus answered, "Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one is **born of water and the Spirit**, he cannot **enter** the kingdom of God.

1. The disciple must first be plugged in the **Body Life**.

1 Corinthians 12:13 For by one Spirit we were all baptized into one body—whether Jews or Greeks, whether slaves or free and have all been made to drink into one Spirit.



2. The disciple must be a true worshipper.

John 4:23-24

23 But the hour is coming, and now is, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth; for the Father is seeking such to worship Him.
24 God is Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth."







3. The disciple must fill his life with the <u>Word of God</u>.

Colossians 3:16 Let the <u>word of Christ dwell in you richly</u> <u>in all wisdom</u>, teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord.

Ephesians 6:17 And <u>take</u> the helmet of salvation, and <u>the sword of the Spirit</u>, <u>which is the word</u> <u>of God</u> ...

Proverbs 3:5-6 5 <u>Trust</u> in the Lord with <u>all</u> your heart, and <u>lean not on your own</u> <u>understanding</u>; 6 in <u>all</u> your ways acknowledge Him, and <u>He shall</u> <u>direct your paths</u>.







1. As priests and kings to share the **<u>full</u>** gospel.

Luke 4:18 The Spirit of the Lord is upon Me, because He has anointed Me to preach the <u>gospel to the poor</u>; He has sent Me to <u>heal the broken-hearted</u>, to proclaim <u>liberty to the captives</u> and recovery of <u>sight</u> to the blind, to set at <u>liberty those who are</u> <u>oppressed</u> ...

Luke 4:18a The Spirit of the Lord is upon Me, because He has anointed Me to preach the gospel to the poor ...

Acts 1:8 But you shall receive cover when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses

to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.

 The disciple must know that the <u>source</u> of his power to share the gospel, heal, cast out demons, etc. comes from the <u>Holy</u> <u>Spirit</u>.



Acts 10:38 how <u>God anointed</u> <u>Jesus of Nazareth with the</u> <u>Holy Spirit and with power</u>,

who went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him. 3. Consequently, the disciple must live a life empowered by



- A. the Love of Father-God;
- **B.** the <u>Word</u> of God;
- C. the Spirit of God.

 The disciple must be aware that God has made him to be both a priest and king.

Revelation 1:5-6

5 and from Jesus Christ, the faithful witness, the firstborn from the dead, and <u>the ruler over the kings of the earth</u>. To Him who loved us and washed us from our sins in His own blood, 6 and has <u>made us kings and priests</u> to His God and Father, to Him be glory and dominion forever and ever. Amen. 5. The disciple must be clear of the different roles of priests and kings.

As kings, we speak to the <u>mountain</u> [demons, sickness, situations, etc.]

Speaking to the mountain is **<u>NOT</u>** speaking to God.

- A. Speaking to God is prayer as a priest.
- **B.** Speaking to the mountain is our commanding and rebuking the mountain as a <u>king</u>.

For <u>with authority</u> and power He <u>commands</u> the <u>unclean</u> <u>spirits</u>, and they come out."

In Jesus name, I come against you -(pain, cancer cells, ache, flu, virus, germs, bacteria, spirit of infirmity, deaf & dumb spirit ..) Get out of the body! You have no more hold over this body! This body is now cleansed and covered by the blood of Jesus! You are nullified, GO! In Jesus' name.

Matthew 21:19 And seeing a <u>fig tree</u> by the road, He came to it and found nothing on it but leaves, and <u>said</u> to it, "Let no fruit grow on you ever again." Immediately the <u>fig tree</u> withered away.

Mark 11:21 And Peter, remembering, said to Him, "Rabbi, look! The <u>fig tree</u> which You <u>cursed</u> has withered away."

Mark 4:39 Then He arose and <u>rebuked</u> the <u>wind</u>, and said to the <u>sea</u>, "Peace, be still!" And the <u>wind</u> ceased and there was a great calm.

In Jesus name, I speak to you rain clouds, go away from this place! There shall be no rain on this grounds in Jesus' name!

In Jesus name, every unclean spirit in this hotel room, go away from here! This room is cleansed and covered by the Blood of the Lamb! Lord, we ask for Your peace, wisdom, favour and Your very Presence to be with us in our stay here these 5 days! in Jesus' name! As priests and kings, the disciple is called by the Lord to strategically pray for the salvation of loved ones and <u>share</u> the Gospel of the Kingdom of God.



2 Corinthians 4:3-4, 6

3 But even if our gospel is <u>veiled</u>, it is <u>veiled</u> to those who are perishing, 4 <u>whose minds the god of this age has</u> <u>blinded</u>, who do not believe, lest the <u>light of the gospel</u> of the glory of Christ, who is the image of God, should <u>shine</u> <u>on them</u>. 6 For it is the <u>God who commanded light to shine</u> <u>out of darkness</u>, who has <u>shone in our hearts to give</u> <u>the light of the knowledge</u> of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ.

Matthew 12:29 Or how can one enter a strong man's house and plunder his goods, unless <u>he first binds the strong man</u>? And <u>then he will plunder his house</u>.

 As priests and kings, the disciple is called by the Lord to strategically pray for the salvation of loved ones and <u>share</u> the Gospel of the Kingdom of God.

A Methodology for Sharing the Gospel:

Luke 10:5-9

5 But whatever house you enter, first say, 'Peace to this house.' **6** And if a <u>son of peace</u> is there, your peace will rest on it; if not, it will return to you. **7** And remain in the same house, <u>eating and drinking</u> such things as they give, for the laborer is worthy of his wages. Do not go from house to house. **8** Whatever city you enter, and they receive you, eat such things as are set before you. **9** And <u>heal the sick there</u>, and <u>say to them</u>, '<u>The kingdom of God has come near to you</u>.'
