


Context of Luke 24: Resurrection Sunday



The Road to Emmaus – Lk 24

13 And **behold**, **two of them** were going **that very day** to a village named Emmaus, which was about **seven miles** from Jerusalem. 14 And they were talking with each other about all these things which had taken place.



16 But their **EYES WERE prevented** from recognizing Him. 17 And He said to them, "What are these words that you are exchanging with one another as you are walking?" And they **stood still, looking sad**. 18 One of them, named Cleopas, answered and said to Him, "Are You the **Only one** visiting Jerusalem and unaware of the things which have happened here in these days?"

19 And He said to them, "What

things?" And they said to Him, "The things about Jesus the

Nazarene, who was a **prophet** mighty in deed and word in the sight of God and all the people, 20

and how the chief priests and our rulers delivered Him to the sentence of death, and crucified Him.

21 But we **Were hoping** that it was He who was going to redeem Israel. Indeed, besides all this, it is

the **third day** since these things happened.

22 But also some women among us amazed us. When they were at the tomb early in the morning, 23 and did not find His body, they came, saying that they had also seen a vision of angels who said that He was alive. 24 Some of those who were with us went to the tomb and found it just exactly as the



women also had said; but Him they did not see."

28 And they approached the village where they were going, and He acted as though He were going

farther. 29 But they urged Him, saying, "Stay with us, for it is getting toward evening, and the day is now nearly over." So He went in to stay with them. 30 When He had reclined at the table with them, **He took the bread and blessed it**, and

breaking it, He began giving it to them. 31 Then their **CYES WERE Opened** and they recognized Him; and He vanished from their sight.



32 They said to one another, "Were not **Our hearts burning** within us while He was speaking to us on the road, while He was **explaining the Scriptures** to us?" 33 And they got up **that very hour** and returned to Jerusalem, and found gathered together the eleven and those who were with them, 34 saying, "The Lord has really risen and has appeared to Simon." 35 They began to relate their experiences on the road and how He was recognized by them in the **breaking of the bread.**




Scriptures MUST inform our MIND of who GOD is. And NOT experiences.





Reflection from Penn on receiving a bible from a Believer



"I've always said that I don't respect people who don't proselytize (convert someone to your faith). I don't respect that at all. If you believe that there's a heaven and a hell, and people could be

going to hell or not getting eternal life, and you think that it's not

really worth telling them this because it would make it socially awkward how much do you have to hate somebody to not proselytize? How much do you have to hate somebody to believe everlasting life is possible and not tell them that?

"I mean, if I believed, beyond the shadow of a doubt, that a truck was coming at you, and you didn't believe that truck was bearing down on you, there is a certain point where I tackle you.

And this (proselytize) is more important than that."




