

#### Deuteronomy 25:17-19

17 Remember what Amalek did to you on the way as you were coming out of Egypt, 18 how he met you on the way and attacked your rear ranks, all the stragglers at your rear, when you were tired and weary; and he did not fear God. 19 Therefore it shall be, when the Lord your God has given you rest from your enemies all around, in the land which the Lord your God is giving you to possess as an inheritance, that you will blot out the remembrance of Amalek from under heaven. You shall not forget.

- 8 Now Amalek came and fought with Israel in <u>Rephidim</u>.

13 So Joshua defeated Amalek and his people with the edge of the sword. 14 Then the Lord said to Moses, "Write this for a memorial in the book and recount it in the hearing of Joshua, that I will utterly blot out the remembrance of Amalek from under heaven." 15 And Moses built an altar and called its name, The-Lord-Is-My-Banner; 16 for he said, "Because the Lord has sworn: the Lord will have war with Amalek from generation to generation."

B. <u>Defective</u> covering

When the **immediate covering** over us is **faulty**, we must bring ourselves under the **next** level of covering.

#### Example #1 When the <u>husband</u> is not providing the covering.



**Example #2** When <u>parents</u> are not providing the covering.





7. Other reasons we can <u>lose</u> our protection / covering:
Example #1 - Not <u>walking</u> in obedience.

1 John 1:7 ... we walk in the light as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us from all sin.  Other reasons we can <u>lose</u> our protection / covering: Example #2 - Having an <u>unforgiving</u> spirit.

Matthew 6:12 And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors.

 Other reasons we can <u>lose</u> our protection / covering: Example #2 - Having an <u>unforgiving</u> spirit.

Matthew 6:14-15 14 For if you <u>forgive men their trespasses</u>, your heavenly Father will also forgive you. 15 <u>But if you do not forgive men their</u> <u>trespasses</u>, <u>neither will your Father</u> <u>forgive your trespasses</u>.



#### James 5:19-20

19 ... if anyone among you <u>wanders from</u> <u>the truth</u>, and someone turns him back,
20 let him know that he who turns a sinner from the error of his way will <u>save a soul</u> <u>from death</u> and <u>cover a multitude of sins</u>.



These backslidden / wayward ones are **deceived** and cannot discern correctly.

**Galatians 6:3** For if anyone thinks himself to be something, when he is nothing,

he **deceives** himself.



**Revelation 3:17** Because <u>you say</u>, I am rich, have become wealthy, and have need of nothing--and <u>do not know</u> that you are wretched, miserable, poor, blind, and naked ...

Romans 12:3 ... not to think of himself **MORE highly than he ought to think**, but to think soberly, as God has dealt to each one a measure of faith.



James 1:22 ... be doers of the word, and not <u>hearers</u> only, <u>deceiving</u> yourselves.
