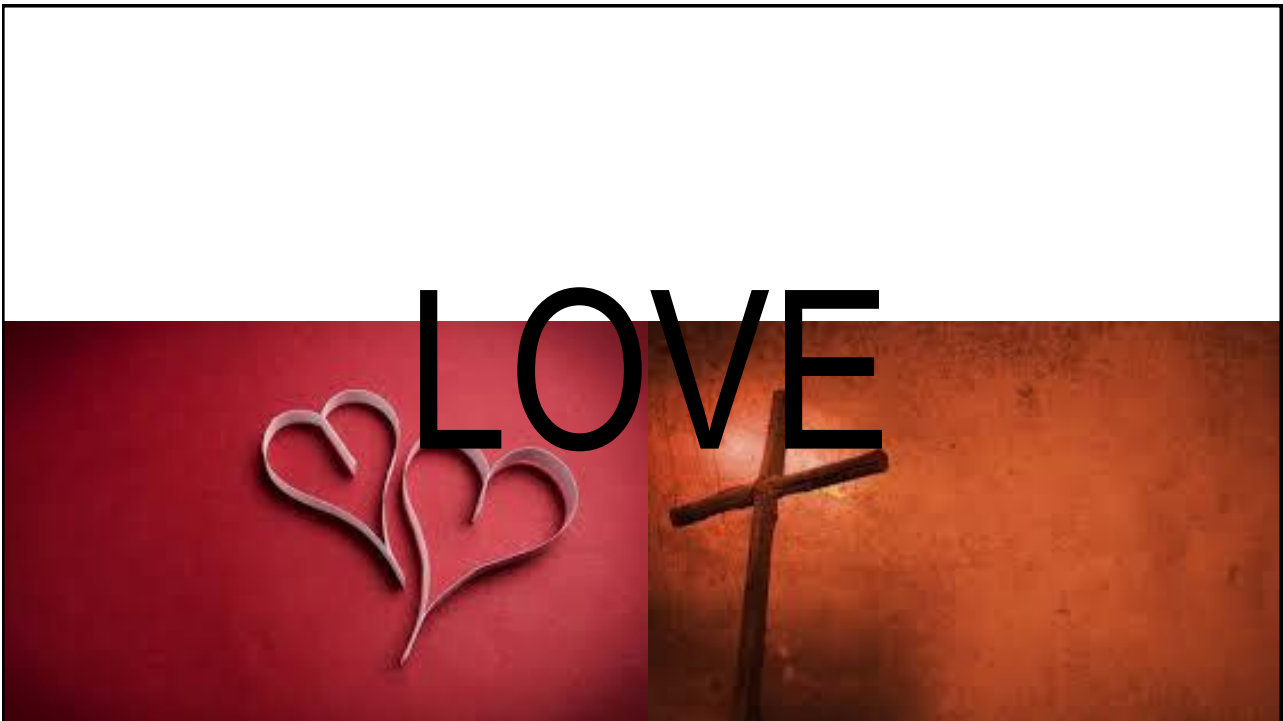

⁷ It always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres.

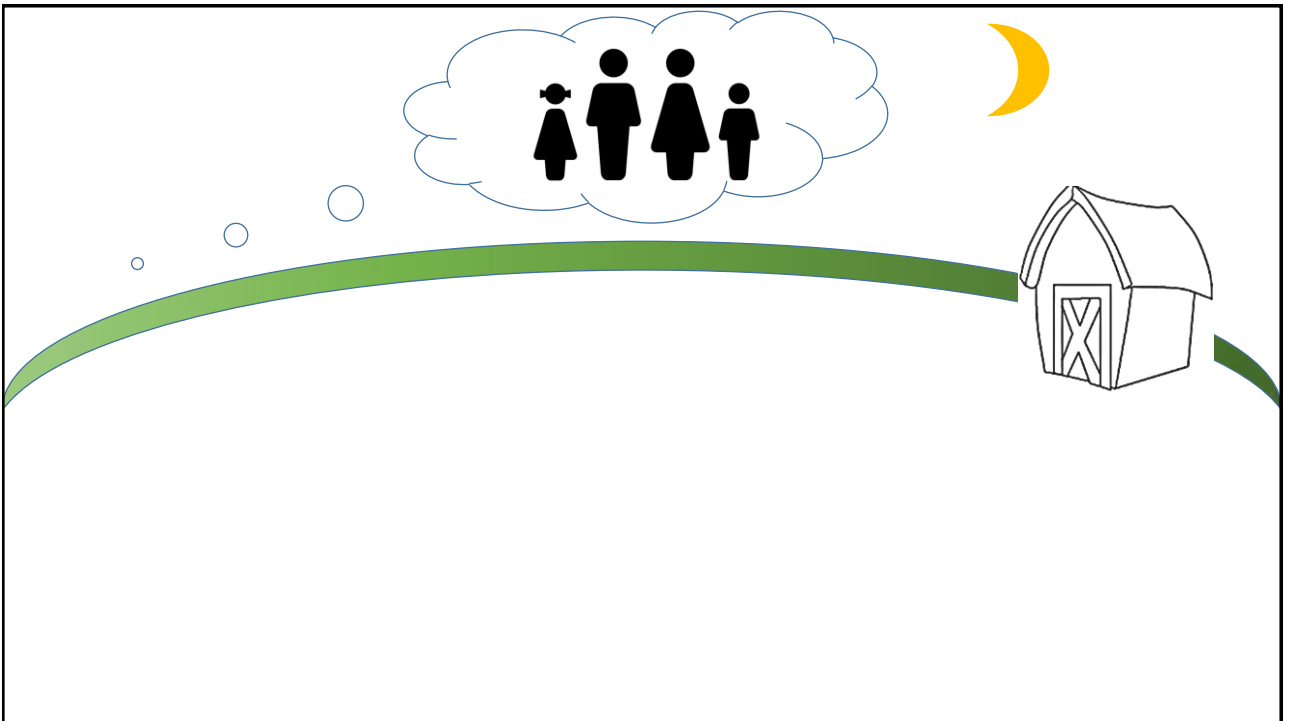
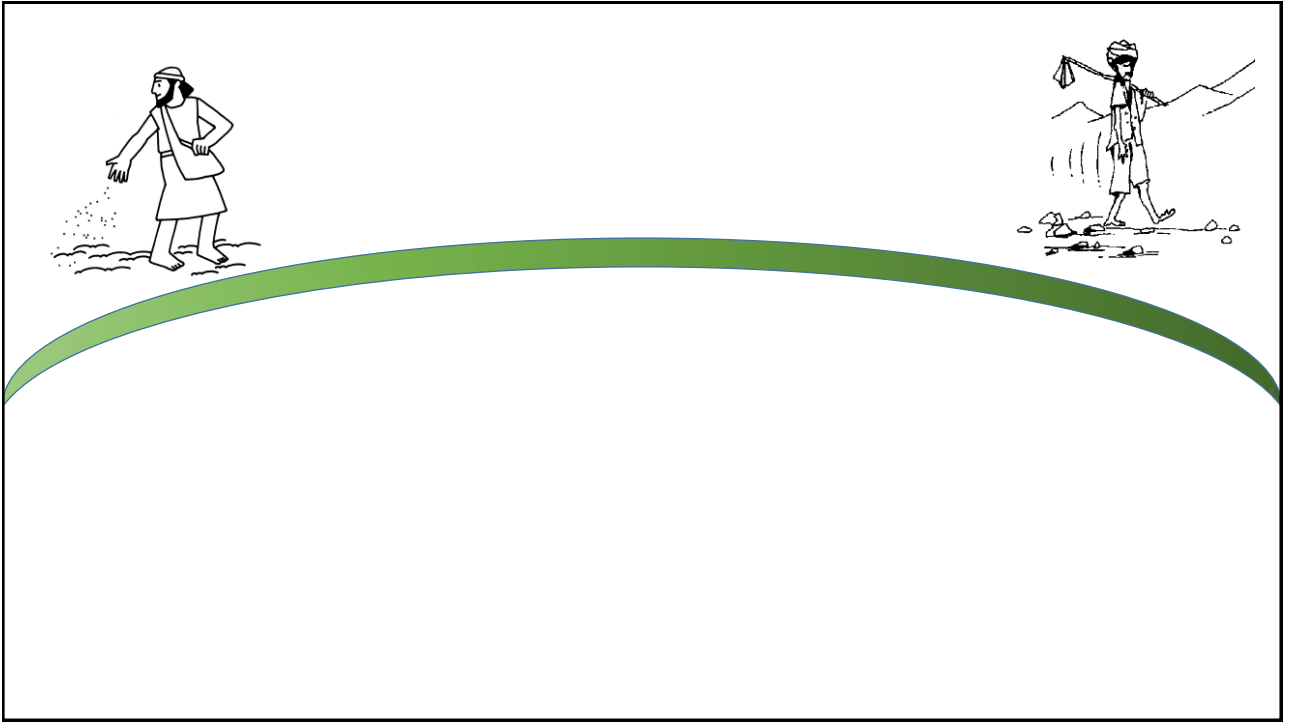


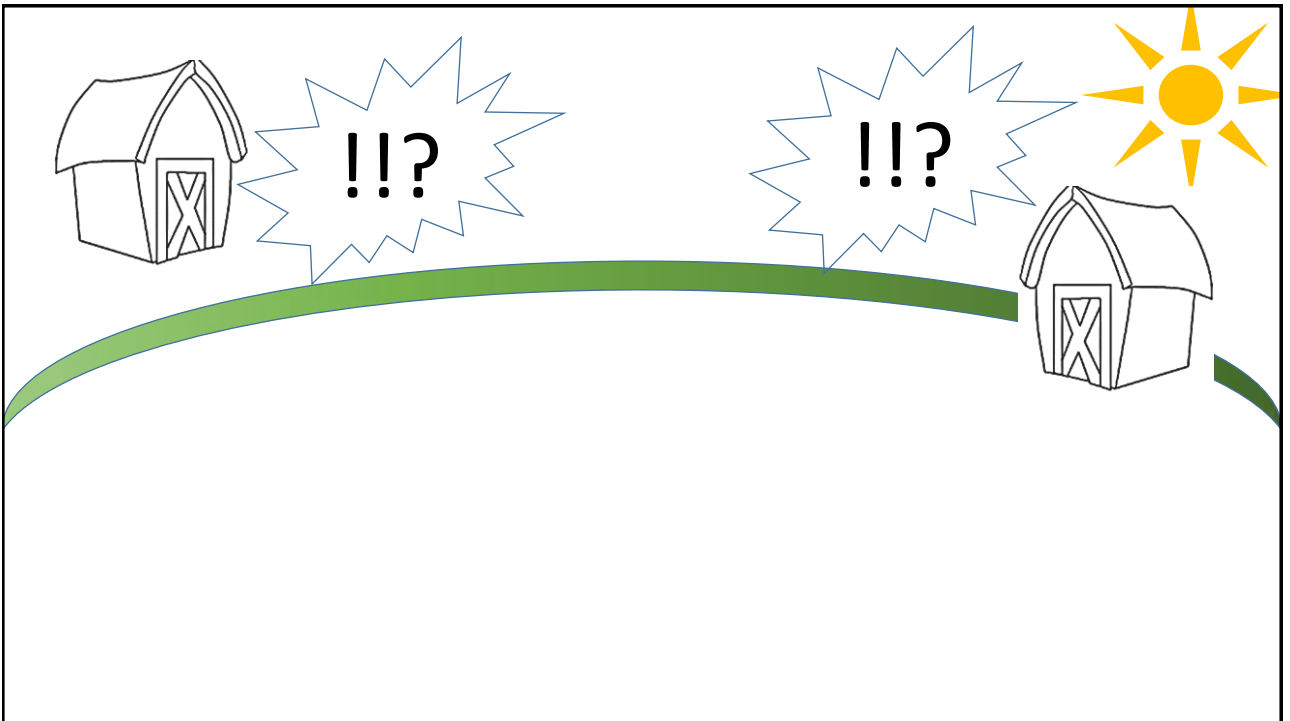

To follow Jesus

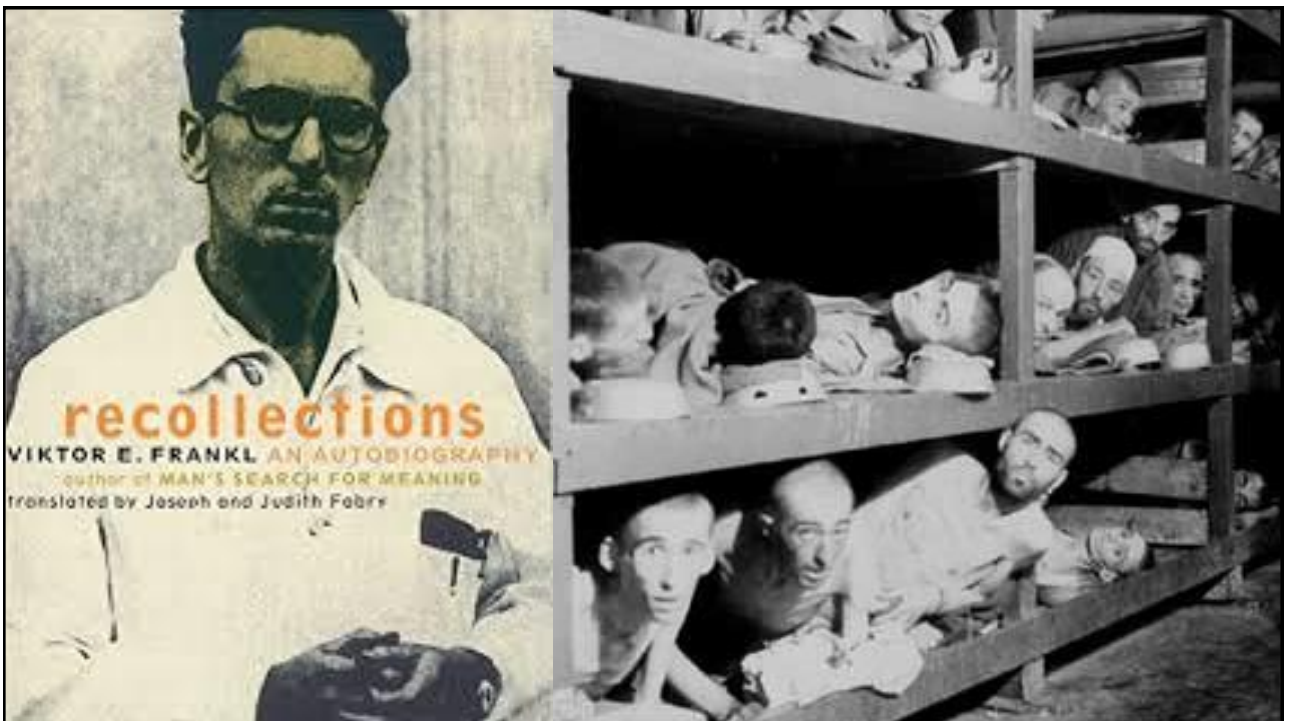
1 John 5:3
