



Joel 2:28-32

28 And it shall come to pass afterward that <u>I will pour out My Spirit on all flesh</u>; Your sons and your daughters shall <u>prophesy</u>, Your old men shall <u>dream dreams</u>, Your young men shall <u>see visions</u>. 29 And also on My menservants and on My maidservants I will pour out My Spirit in those days. 30 "And I will show <u>wonders in the heavens and in the earth</u>: Blood and fire and pillars of smoke. 31 The sun shall be turned into darkness, and the moon into blood, before the coming of the great and awesome day of the Lord. 32 And it shall come to pass that <u>whoever calls on the name of the Lord shall be saved</u>.  The Anointing <u>in / within</u> is the <u>Presence</u> of God in the believer since <u>Pentecost</u>.
 The Presence of God <u>never</u> leaves the believer.
 The Anointing within the believer is <u>permanent</u>.
 The anointing within abides in the believer <u>forever</u>.
 The <u>Blood of Jesus</u> covers the believer perfectly cf OT.
 That's why the Holy Spirit can dwell <u>in</u> the NT believer but <u>not</u> in the OT because <u>blood covering</u> of animal sacrifices were <u>temporary</u>.







1.	Generally, when we use the term " Anointing ", we are referring to the Anointing <u>On / Upon</u> the believer. The Anointing On / Upon is also known as:		
	Α.	Ephesians 5:18	- the infilling of the Holy Spirit of Power.
	В.	Acts 1:5	- the <u>baptism</u> with the Holy Spirit.
	C.	Luke 24:49	- Endued - Clothed with power.
	D.	Acts 1:4	- The Promise of the Father.
	Ε.	Acts 1:8	- The Holy Spirit <u>on/upon</u> you.
	F.	Acts 2:4	- Being <u>filled</u> with the Holy Spirit.



 We see the Anointing On / Upon in the <u>OT</u> when the Holy Spirit came <u>on / upon</u> a man of God to enable and empower him to accomplish a work of God.

e.g. 1 - Gideon

Judges 6:34 But the Spirit of the LORD came **<u>upon</u>** Gideon; then he blew the trumpet, and the Abiezrites gathered behind him.

Empowered with **Boldness-Courage**!

 We see the Anointing On / Upon in the <u>OT</u> when the Holy Spirit came <u>on / upon</u> a man of God to enable and empower him to accomplish a work of God.

e.g. 2 - Jephthah

Judges 11:29 Then the Spirit of the LORD came **<u>upon</u>** Jephthah, and he passed through Gilead and Manasseh, and passed through Mizpah of Gilead; and from Mizpah of Gilead he advanced toward the people of Ammon.

Empowered with Leadership to War!

 We see the Anointing On / Upon in the <u>OT</u> when the Holy Spirit came <u>on / upon</u> a man of God to enable and empower him to accomplish a work of God.

e.g. 3 - Samson

Judges 15:14 When he came to Lehi, the Philistines came shouting against him. Then the Spirit of the Lord came mightily **upon** him; and the ropes that were on his arms became like flax that is burned with fire, and his bonds broke loose from his hands.

Empowered with <u>Supernatural</u> Strength!

 We see the Anointing On / Upon in the <u>OT</u> when the Holy Spirit came <u>on / upon</u> a man of God to enable and empower him to accomplish a work of God.

e.g. 4 - King Saul

1 Samuel 10:6 Then the Spirit of the LORD will come **<u>upon</u>** you, and you will prophesy with them and be turned into another man. **10** When they came there to the hill, there was a group of prophets to meet him; then the Spirit of God came **<u>upon</u>** him, and he prophesied among them.

Empowered to <u>speak</u> the oracles of God!

II. The Anointing <u>On / Upon</u> is the Power of God working <u>in</u> and <u>through</u> that believer.
3. The Anointing On / Upon continues in the <u>NT</u> up to today. <u>Pentecost</u> makes a difference in the Anointing On / Upon. Instead of just coming upon a <u>few</u> men as in the OT, the Anointing On / Upon is now available to <u>all</u> believers.

II. The Anointing <u>On / Upon</u> is the Power of God working <u>in</u> and <u>through</u> that believer.

3. The Anointing On / Upon **continues** in the **NT** up to today.

Acts 1:8 But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come <u>upon</u> you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.





- A. To live **victoriously** overcoming:
 - i. the power of <u>sin</u>.

Free from the sins of the past guilt, strongholds, words spoken, bad incident, molested, mocked, bullied, theft, adultery, fornication, ...

Free from the sins of the present addiction to pornography, gambling, temper, guilt, theft, strongholds, adultery, fornication, loose tongue ...

- A. To live victoriously overcoming:
 - ii. the pull of the world (kosmos).

1 John 2:16 For all that is in the world—the <u>lust of the flesh</u>, the <u>lust of the eyes</u>, and the <u>pride of life</u>—is not of the Father but is of the world. A. To live <u>victoriously</u> overcoming:
iii. the <u>evil</u> one.

Luke 10:19 Behold, I give you the <u>authority to trample</u> on serpents and scorpions, and <u>over all the power of the enemy</u>, and nothing shall by any means hurt you.

Revelation 12:11 And they **overcame him** by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony, and they did not love their lives to the death.

A. To live victoriously overcoming:

iii. the evil one.

2 Timothy 1:7 For God has not given us a **spirit of fear**, but of power and of love and of a sound mind.

Romans 8:15 For you did not receive the <u>spirit of bondage again</u> to fear, but you received the Spirit of adoption by whom we cry out, "Abba, Father." A. To live <u>victoriously</u> overcoming:
 iv. <u>sickness</u> and <u>infirmities</u>.

Romans 8:11 But if <u>the Spirit of Him</u> who raised Jesus from the dead <u>dwells in you</u>, He who raised Christ from the dead will also <u>give life</u> to your mortal bodies through His Spirit who dwells in you.

Proverbs 3:8 It [the Word] will be <u>health to your flesh</u>, and <u>strength to your bones</u>.



To be Anointed - Enabled - Strengthened - Gifted to minister the <u>Grace</u> of God to others

Acts 10:38 how God <u>anointed</u> Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power, who went about <u>doing good</u> and <u>healing</u> all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him.

To be Anointed - Enabled - Strengthened - Gifted to minister the <u>Grace</u> of God to others

Luke 4:18 The <u>Spirit of the LORD</u> is upon Me, because He has <u>anointed Me</u> to <u>preach</u> the gospel to the poor; He has sent Me to <u>heal</u> <u>the broken-hearted</u>, to <u>proclaim liberty to</u> <u>the captives</u> and <u>recovery of sight to the blind</u>, <u>to set at liberty those who are oppressed</u> ...

 - **A.** A <u>leadership</u> anointing enables you to love and to provide direction.
 - B. An administrative anointing produces order.
 - C. A healing anointing releases health.

II. The Anointing On / Upon is the Power of God working in and through that believer.
5. There are different anointing for believers to fulfill their specific assignments / ministries.
D. A psalmist anointing unlocks worship.
E. A wisdom anointing eliminates uncertainty.
F. A prophetic anointing reveals the Will of God.

 - 5. There are <u>different</u> anointing for believers to fulfill their specific assignments / ministries.
 - **G.** An <u>evangelist</u> anointing releases the power of the Gospel to save.
 - H. A teaching anointing brings clarity of the Word of God.
 - I. A <u>pastoral / shepherding</u> anointing brings love, comfort and encouragement to the sheep.

Summary:

The Anointing <u>In / Within</u>, abides forever and is <u>permanent</u> regardless of whether the believer sense Him or not.

The Anointing <u>On / Upon</u> is <u>not permanent</u>. We need to be <u>continually filled</u> with the <u>Holy Spirit</u>.



How to be Empowered by the Holy Spirit? 4 Major Postures required:

How to be Empowered by the Holy Spirit?

4 Major Postures required:

- 1. The posture of **Obedience**.
 - ✓ Do not grieve Him in dis-obedience.

Ephesians 4:30 And **do not grieve the Holy Spirit** of God, by whom you were sealed for the day of redemption.



How to be Empowered by the Holy Spirit?

4 Major Postures required:

2. The posture of **flowing** with the Holy Spirit.

1 Thessalonians 5:19 Do not <u>quench</u> the Holy Spirit (NKJV) Do not <u>put out</u> the Spirit's fire (NIV)

How to be Empowered by the Holy Spirit?

4 Major Postures required:

3. The posture of surrender.

Ephesians 5:17-18

17 Therefore do not be unwise, but understand what the will of the Lord is. 18 ... but be filled with the Spirit ...

Acknowledge and welcome His Presence in every area of your life

How to be Empowered by the Holy Spirit?

4 Major Postures required:

4. The posture of earnest seeking and paying the price for it.

John 7:37-39a

37 On the last day, that great day of the feast, Jesus stood and cried out, saying, "If anyone <u>thirsts</u>, let him <u>come to Me and drink</u>.
38 He who <u>believes in Me</u>, as the Scripture has said, out of his heart will flow rivers of living water." 39 But this <u>He spoke concerning</u> the Spirit, whom those believing in Him would receive ...
