





NEHEMIAH 8:1-12


1 All the people came together as one in the square before the Water Gate. They told Ezra the teacher of the Law to bring out the Book of the Law of Moses, which the Lord had commanded for Israel.

2 So on the first day of the seventh month Ezra the priest brought the Law before the assembly, which was made up of men and women and all who were able to understand.









NEHEMIAH 8:1-12


3 He read it aloud from the square before the Water Gate in the presence of the men, women and others who could understand. And all the people listened attentively to the Book of the Law.



NEHEMIAH 8:1-12

4 Ezra the teacher of the Law stood on a high wooden platform built for the occasion. Beside him on his right stood Mattithiah, Shema, Anaiah, Uriah, Hilkiah and Maasiah. To his left were Pedaiah, Mishael, Malkijah, Hashum, Hashabnebar, Shebaniel and Meshullam.

5 Ezra opened the book. All the people could see him because he was standing above them; and as he opened it, the people all stood up.



NEHEMIAH 8:6

6 Ezra praised the Lord, the God of Israel; and all the people lifted their hands and responded, "Amen! Amen!" Then they bowed down and worshiped the Lord with their faces to the ground.



NEHEMIAH 8:1-12

7 The Levites — Jeshua, Bani, Shabbethai, Akkub, Shabbethai, Hodiah, Maaseiah, Kelita, Azarah, Sheban, Benaiah, Hanan and Pelaiah — instructed the people in the Law of Moses as the people were standing there.

8 They read from the Book of the Law of God, making it clear and giving the meaning so that the people understood what was being read.



NEHEMIAH 8:1-17

9 Then Nehemiah the priest and teacher of the Law, and the Levites instructing the people said to them all, “The Lord your God. Do not mourn or weep, for you have had been weeping as they listened to the words of the Law.



NEHEMIAH 8:18-22

10 Nehemiah the priest and Levites and all the Levites and all the people had nothing prepared. This commandment was given to our God. Do not grieve, for the joy of the Lord is your strength.



NEHEMIAH 8:11

11 The Levites said to the people, saying, "Be still, for this is a holy day. Do not grieve."



NEHEMIAH 8:1-12

12 Then all the people went to eat and drink, to send portions of food and to celebrate with great joy, because they now understood the words that had been made known to them.











NEHEMIAH 9:2

Those of Israelite descent had separated themselves from all foreigners. They stood in their places and confessed their sins and the sins of their ancestors.




NEHEMIAH 9:3


NEHEMIAH 9:5
