


Genesis 8:20

Genesis 12:7 Then the Lord appeared to Abram and said, "To your descendants I will give this land." And there he built an altar to the Lord, who had appeared to him.



Judges 6:24 So <u>Gideon built an altar there</u> <u>to the Lord</u>, and called it The-Lord-Is-Peace. To this day it is still in Ophrah of the Abiezrites.

1 Samuel 7:17 But <u>he (Samuel)</u> always returned to Ramah, for his home was there. There he judged Israel, and there he built an altar to the Lord.

2 Samuel 24:25 And <u>David built</u> there an altar to the Lord, and offered burnt offerings and peace offerings. So the Lord heeded the prayers for the land, and the plague was withdrawn from Israel.

1 Kings 18:32 Then with the stones he (Elijah) built an altar in the name of the Lord; and he made a trench around the altar large enough to hold two seahs of seed.



2. To encounter the Lord, we must therefore posture our hearts to hear Him.


Proverbs 4:20-21, 23

B. When we sin, we grieve the Holy Spirit.

Ephesians 4:30 And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, by whom you were sealed for the day of redemption.

 - **C.** Whenever we grieve the Holy Spirit in those specific areas, we give groundfoothold to the evil one.

Ephesians 4:27 nor give <u>place-ground</u> to the devil.

 - **D.** We are then exposed to the <u>attacks</u> of the devil.

1 Peter 5:8 Be sober, be vigilant; because your <u>adversary the devil</u> walks about like a roaring lion, seeking whom he may <u>devour</u>.

 - **E.** We must grow in increasing <u>righteousness and holiness</u>.

Ephesians 4:22-24

22 that you <u>put off</u>, <u>concerning your former conduct</u>, <u>the old man</u> which grows corrupt according to the deceitful lusts, 23 and <u>be renewed in the spirit of your mind</u>, 24 and that you <u>put on the new man</u> which was created according to God, in <u>true</u> righteousness and holiness.

 - **E.** We must mature spiritually in increasing <u>righteousness and holiness</u>.
 - What <u>was</u> permissible <u>is</u> no longer permissible.
 - What is permissible for <u>ordinary nominal Christians</u> is no longer permissible for us as we <u>mature</u> in the Lord.

 - **E.** We must mature spiritually in increasing <u>righteousness and holiness</u>.
 - Separate <u>from</u> the things that <u>do not</u> value-add to our godliness.
 - Separate to the things that will value-add to our godliness.

 - **F.** Whenever God speaks to us, we must <u>respond</u> to Him.

Hebrews 3:7-8, 15

7 Therefore, as the Holy Spirit says: "Today, if you will <u>hear His voice</u>, 8 <u>do not harden</u> <u>your hearts</u> as in the rebellion, in the day of trial in the wilderness. 15 while it is said: "Today, if you will <u>hear His voice</u>, <u>do not harden your hearts</u> as in the rebellion."



Hebrews 4:7 again He designates a certain day, saying in David, "Today," after such a long time, as it has been said: "Today, if you will <u>hear His voice</u>, <u>do not harden your hearts</u>."

 who have paid "Tuition-Fees" No Pain
 - C. Obedience to the Word of God No Pain

 - (4) Glory to Glory.



2 Corinthians 3:17-18

17 Now the Lord is the Spirit; and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty. 18 But we all, with unveiled face, beholding as in a mirror the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from glory to glory, just as by the Spirit of the Lord.

- **4.** In God's love for us, He will use all manner of communication to speak to us.
 - **A.** In a gathering of God's people, the Lord will release specific words of **knowledge** and words of **wisdom** to His vessels of honour.

1 Corinthians 12:7-10

7 But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to each one for the profit of all: 8 for to one is given the word of wisdom through the Spirit, to another the word of knowledge through the same Spirit, 9 to another faith by the same Spirit, to another gifts of healings by the same Spirit, 10 to another the working of miracles, to another prophecy, to another discerning of spirits, to another different kinds of tongues, to another the interpretation of tongues.

4B. The Lord in His Sovereignty can use <u>anyone</u> in any <u>situation</u> to speak to us.



Numbers 22:27-28, 30

27 And when the <u>donkey</u> saw the Angel of the Lord, she lay down under Balaam; so Balaam's anger was aroused, and he struck the donkey with his staff. 28 Then <u>the Lord opened the mouth of the donkey</u>, <u>and she said to Balaam</u>, "What have I done to you, that you have struck me these three times?"

30 So <u>the donkey said to Balaam</u>, "Am I not your donkey on which you have ridden, ever since I became yours, to this day? Was I ever disposed to do this to you?" And he said, "No."

Acts 9:5-6


5 And he said, "Who are You, Lord?"






Our Character = Our Personality comprising 3 Areas:



 - (3) Our Volition = Will







