 - have self awareness discretion no superiority or inferiority
 - only to those who are receptive





II. Give of the <u>life</u> of the Spirit in us. A. <u>Speak</u> life always

1 Peter 4:11 If anyone speaks, <u>let him speak as the oracles of God</u>. If anyone ministers, let him do it as with the ability which God supplies, that in all things God may be glorified through Jesus Christ, to whom belong the glory and the dominion forever and ever. Amen.

1 Corinthians 12:8-9 8 for to one is given the <u>word of</u> <u>wisdom</u> through the Spirit, to another the <u>word of knowledge</u> through the same Spirit, 9 to another <u>faith</u> by the same Spirit ...

1 Corinthians 14:3 (AMP) But [on the other hand] the one who prophesies speaks to people for <u>edification [to promote their</u> <u>spiritual growth]</u> and [speaks words of] <u>encouragement</u> [to uphold and advise them concerning the matters of God] and [speaks words of] <u>consolation</u> [to compassionately <u>comfort</u> them].

II. Give of the <u>life</u> of the Spirit in us.B. <u>Share</u> the gospel

1 Peter 3:15 But sanctify the Lord God in your hearts, and <u>always</u> <u>be ready to give a defense to everyone who asks you a reason</u> <u>for the hope that is in you</u>, with meekness and fear.

1 Peter 3:15 (NIV) But in your hearts revere Christ as Lord. <u>Always be</u> <u>prepared to give an answer</u> to everyone who asks you to give the reason for the hope that you have. Luke 10:5-9

5 But whatever house you enter, first say, 'Peace to this house.'

Romans 8:14-17

14 For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, these are sons of God. 15 For you did not receive the spirit of bondage again to fear, but <u>you received the Spirit</u> of adoption by whom we cry out, "Abba, Father."



 III. Give of the <u>love</u> of Father-God in us.
 A. Continually receive and <u>experience</u> the Love of God personally.

Romans 8:14-17

16 The <u>Spirit Himself bears witness with our spirit</u> <u>that we are children of God</u>, **17** and if children, then heirs—heirs of God and joint heirs with Christ, if indeed we suffer with Him, that we may also be glorified together.

III. Give of the <u>love</u> of Father-God in us.

- **C.** Minister <u>healing</u> to the hurting and wounded. Soul-Spirit-Hurts (SSH)
 - 1. Apply the <u>blood</u> for cleansing of the wounds and hurts.
 - Apply the <u>oil</u>
 the Holy Spirit as Comforter to soothe the pains and hurts.

III. Give of the <u>love</u> of Father-God in us.

- C. Minister <u>healing</u> to the hurting and wounded. Soul-Spirit-Hurts (SSH)
 - **3.** Ask God to <u>bind up</u> the wounds and hurts for complete healing.

III. Give of the <u>love</u> of Father-God in us.D. <u>Share</u> the love of God in our relationships.

1 Corinthians 13:4-8a (NIV)

4 Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud. **5** It does not dishonor others, it is not self-seeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs. **6** Love does not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth. **7** It always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres. **8** Love never fails.
