

Anointed Works of Faith - by SP


That is what the Lord tells us to do.


How do we do that?

Jas 2:14 **What use** is it, my brethren, if someone says he **has faith** but he has **no works**? **Can that faith** save him?

15 If a brother or sister is **without clothing** and in **need of daily food**, 16 and one of you says to them, *“Go in peace, be warmed and be filled,”* and yet you do not give them what is necessary for their body, what use is that?

17 Even so **faith**, if it has **no works**, is **dead**, being by itself.

The Proposition

18 But someone may well say, “You have **faith** and I have **works**; show me your **faith without the works**, and I will show you my **faith by my works**.”

19 You believe that **God is one**. You do well; the demons also believe, and shudder.

20 But are you willing to recognize, you foolish fellow, that faith without works is useless?

The Argument on Faith

21 Was not **Abraham** our father justified by works when he offered up Isaac his son on the altar? 22 You see that **faith** was working with his **works**, and as a result of the **works**, **faith** was perfected; 23 and the Scripture was fulfilled which says, “AND ABRAHAM **BELIEVED** GOD, AND IT WAS RECKONED TO HIM AS RIGHTEOUSNESS,” and he was called the friend of God.

24 You see that a man is justified by works and not by faith alone.

25 In the same way, was not Rahab the harlot also justified by **works** when she received the messengers and sent them out by another way?

26 For just as the body without the spirit is dead, so also **faith without works is dead**

Conclusion

Body – Spirit = Dead // Faith – Work = Dead
