




- We need the wisdom from God to <u>thrive</u> in turbulent end-times.

- We must be Kingdom Disciples who <u>first</u> walk / connect with <u>the Lord</u> before going/connecting in the world.











A. Decide to magnify the Lord with our praises at all times.

Praise enables us to declare and proclaim who God is.

Hebrews 13:15 Therefore by Him let us continually offer the sacrifice of praise to God, that is, the fruit of our lips, giving thanks to His Name / confessing His Name / exalting His Name.





C. Our confidence to come into the Presence of God is always by the Blood of Jesus and through the Lord Jesus, our High Priest.

Hebrews 10:19-22

19 Therefore, brethren, having boldness to enter the Holiest by the blood of Jesus, 20 by a new and living way which He consecrated for us, through the veil, that is, His flesh, 21 and having a High Priest over the house of God, 22 let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water.





Give thanks for the Cup - The Blood of Christ




B. Why? This is because the origin of love, the fountain of love, the source of love comes from God.

Romans 5:5 Now hope does not disappoint, because the <u>love</u> of God has been poured out in our hearts by the Holy Spirit who was given to us.





III. Proclaim C. Proclaim the Finished Works of Christ on the Cross for Victorious Living. 1. Colossians 2:13-14 13 And you, being dead in your trespasses and the uncircumcision of your flesh, He has made alive together with Him, having forgiven you all trespasses, 14 having wiped out the handwriting of requirements that was against us, which was contrary to us. And He has taken it out of the way, having nailed it to the cross.

3. 1 John 3:8
