A. Decide to magnify the Lord with our praises at all times.

**Psalm 34:1** (NIV) I will bless the Lord at all times; His praise shall continually be in my mouth.

**Psalm 138:1-2**

**1** I will praise You with my whole heart; before the gods I will sing praises to You. **2** I will worship toward Your holy temple, and praise Your name for Your lovingkindness and Your truth; for You have magnified Your word above all Your name.

- A. Decide to magnify the Lord with our praises at all times.  
Praise enables us to declare and proclaim who God is.

**Hebrews 13:15** Therefore by Him let us continually offer the sacrifice of praise to God, that is, the fruit of our lips, giving thanks to His Name / confessing His Name / exalting His Name.



- B. Praise is preceded by thanksgiving.

**Psalms 100:4** Enter into His gates with thanksgiving, and into His courts with praise. Be thankful to Him, and bless His name.

Priest.

Hebrews 10:19-22

**19** Therefore, brethren, having boldness to enter the Holiest by the blood  
of Jesus, **20** by a new and living way which He consecrated for us, through  
the veil, that is, His flesh, **21** and having a High Priest over the house of  
God, **22** let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our  
hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water.

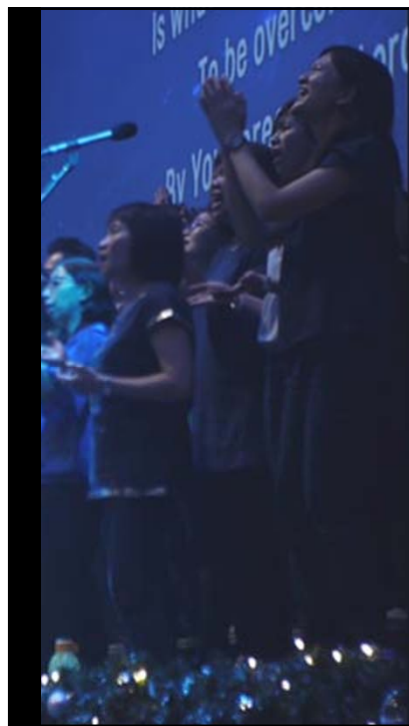

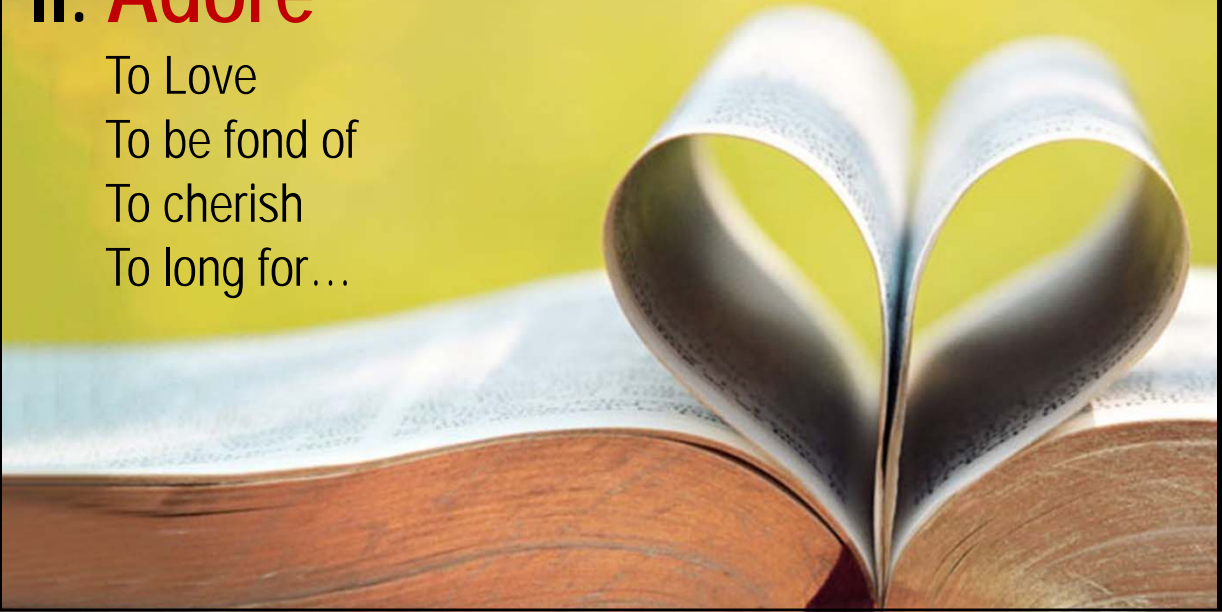






## II. Adore

To long for...

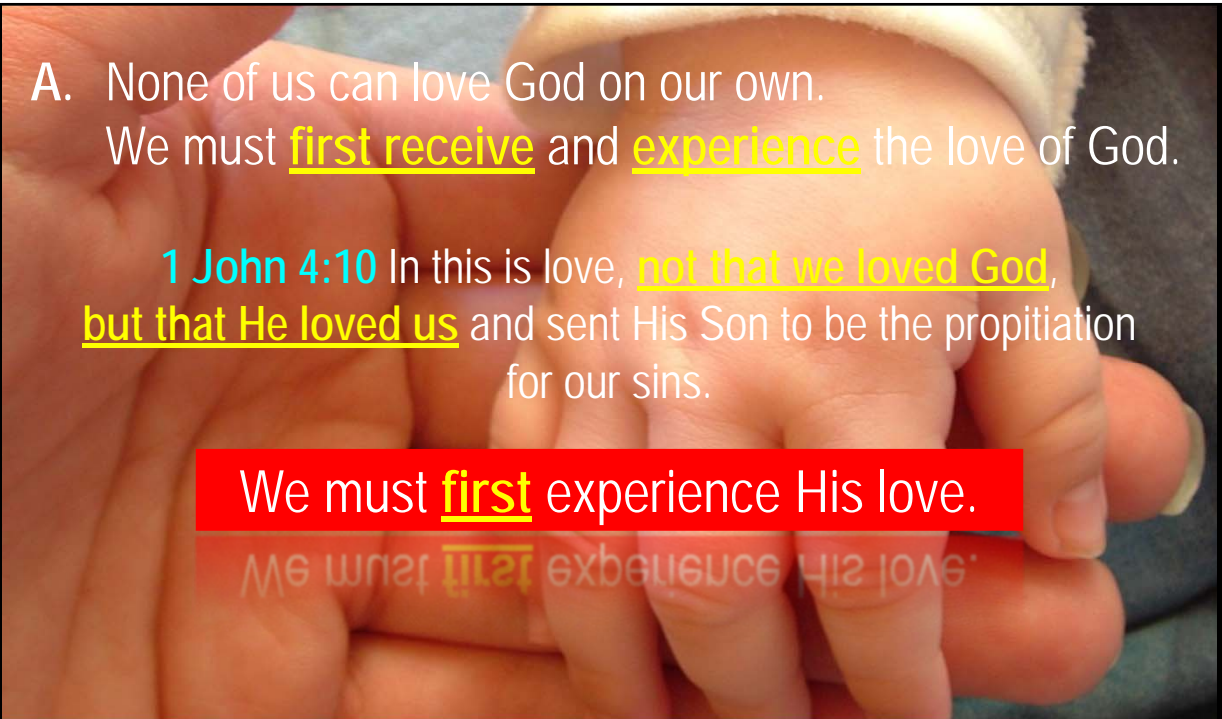


A. None of us can love God on our own.  
We must first receive and experience the love of God.

**1 John 4:10** In this is love, not that we loved God,  
but that He loved us and sent His Son to be the propitiation  
for our sins.

B. **Why?** This is because the origin of love, the fountain of love, the source of love comes from God.

**Romans 5:5** Now hope does not disappoint, because the love of God has been poured out in our hearts by the Holy Spirit who was given to us.

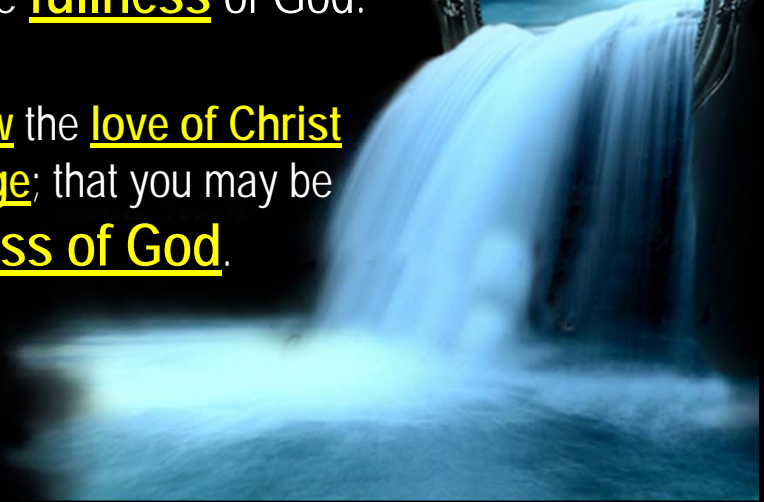


E. When we fail to experience and abide in the love of God, we will revert to our carnal-corrupt-natural love manifested in performance in works and religious practices.

F. When we receive and experience the love of God, it surpasses our understanding and fills us with the fullness of God.

**Ephesians 3:19** to know the love of Christ which passes knowledge; that you may be filled with all the fullness of God.

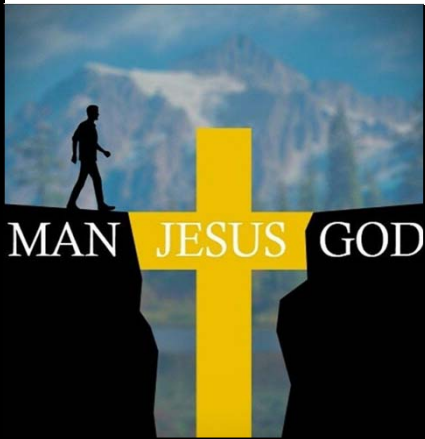

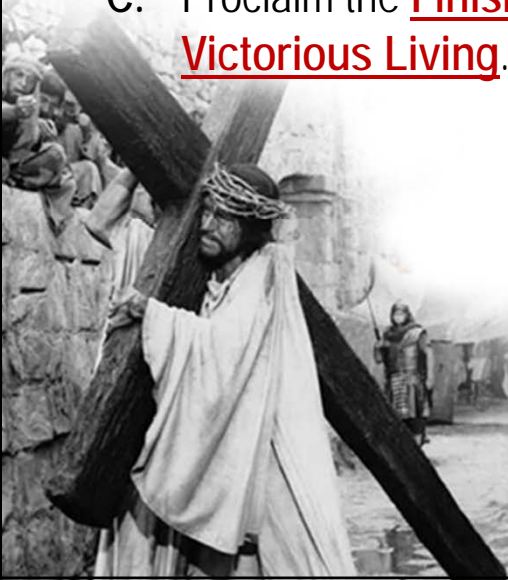

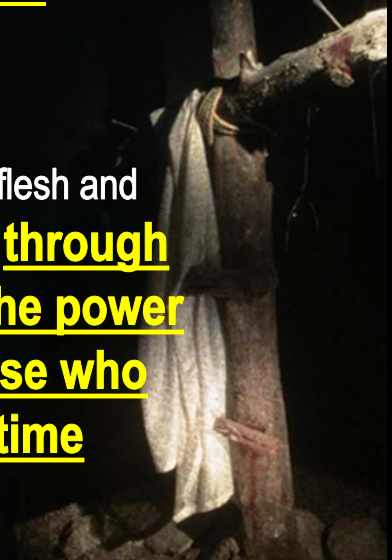
