

Our mission starts in the heart of God!


Jesus passionately at work (9:35). Why the passion?

✓ All men will hate you (v22)


✓ You will be Persecuted!(v23)

 \checkmark Do not be afraid – your soul will be saved (v28)


 \checkmark Do not be afraid – you are worth much more! (v31)

Low Invitation/Low Challenge Produces a bored culture.	High Invitation/High Challenge Produces a discipling culture.




George Barna:

The world is in the mess we have created and the contribution of the church to the solution is minimal!



The Message and its Invasion!


- The Kingdom is near!(v7)

- Superior principles to a world functioning on inferior principles!




The key to transformation is Jesus' absolute invasion.


Rather, than offering to get people into heaven with limited results in this life, Jesus' offer concerns itself primarily with getting heaven into people... and thus transforming culture.
