Greater Works? 1. Revelation 2. Demonstration



Revelation is defined as seeing what you could not see previous.

Reflection: We spent time telling God what to do rather than seeing or hearing what He wants us to do?



Come to Father God without any personal agenda

Application: Spend 15-30 minutes a day in worship seeking to know what the Father God is doing.

John 6:27 Do not work for the food that perishes, but for the food that endures to eternal life, which the Son of Man will give to you. For on him God the Father has set his seal.



Reflection: Wonder why people around us are not interested in the Gospel?

Application:

Seek God for His specific **revelation** in how you can be God's messenger to <u>demonstrate</u> His power so that the lost may marvel at the reality of God and come to believe in Jesus.
