1. Treat your spouse like your boss



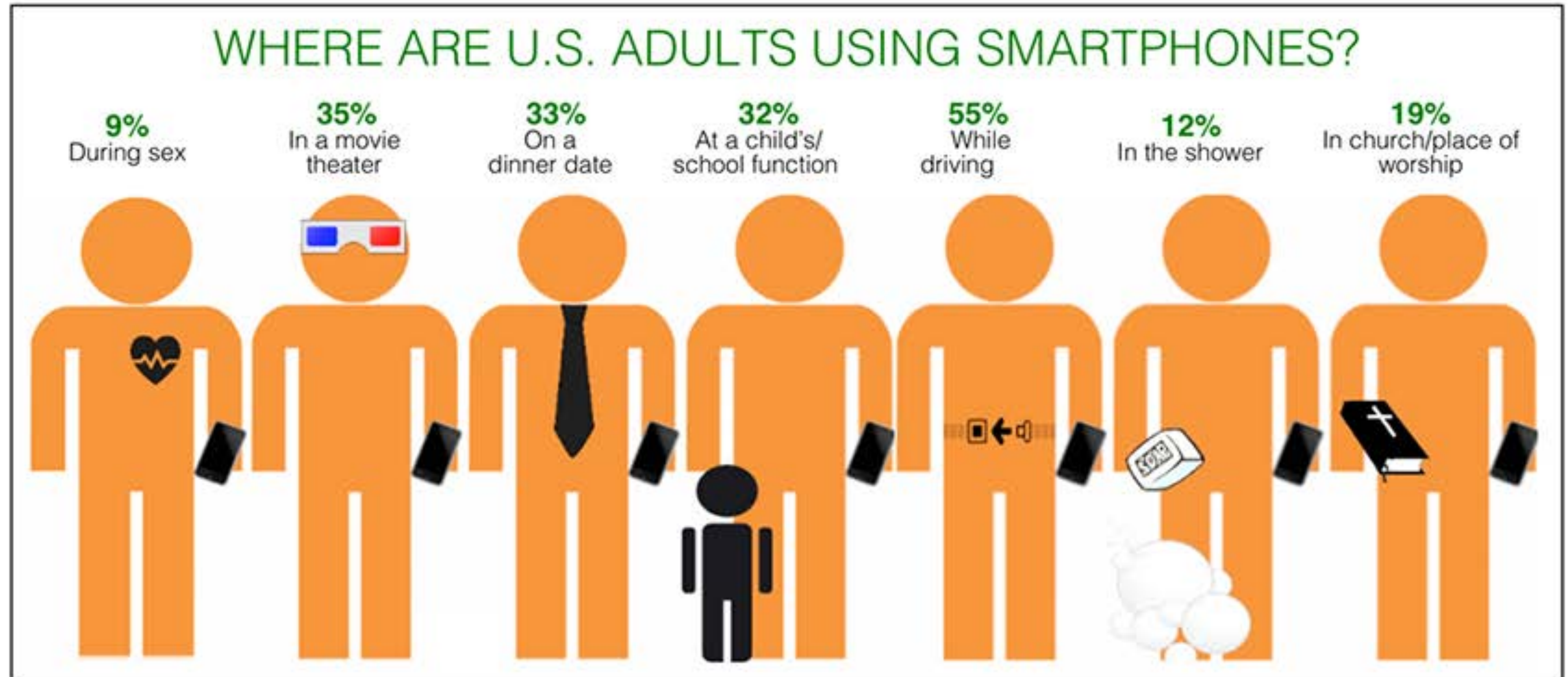
