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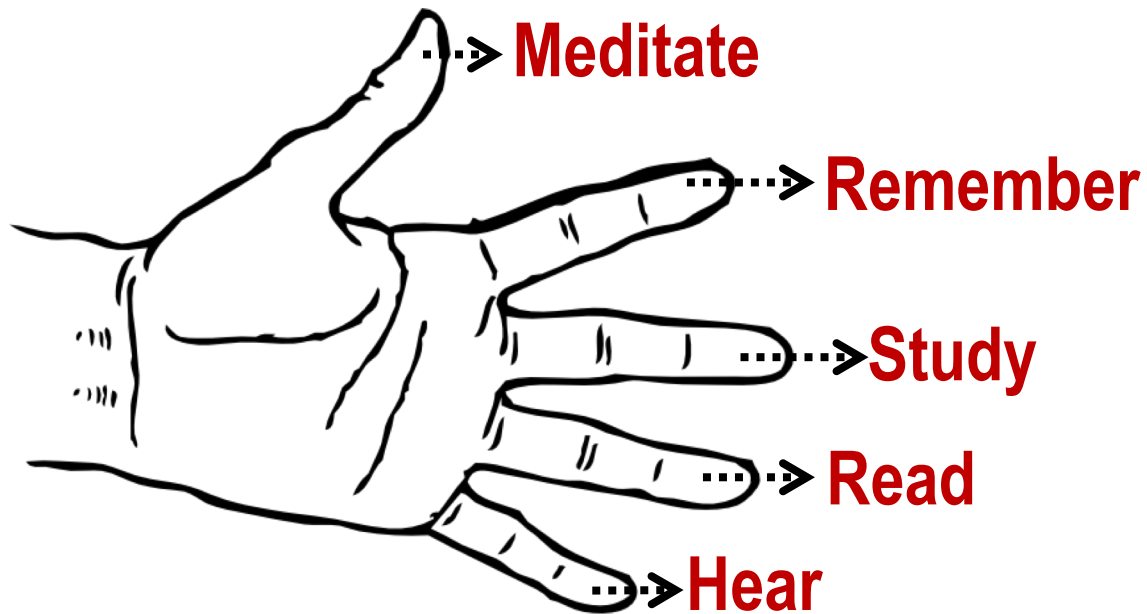
I. Holy Spirit strengthen our spirit-man as:

A. Regular intake of Word

(1) The purpose of the milk of the Word is to experience the grace of God.

1 Peter 2:2-3

2 as newborn babes, desire the pure milk of the word, that you may grow thereby,

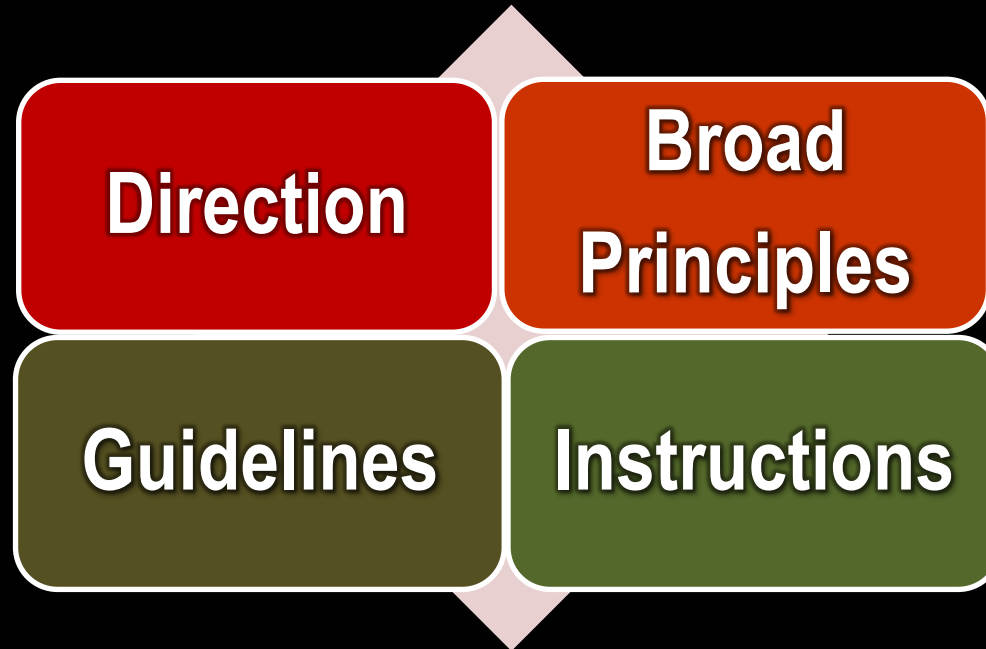

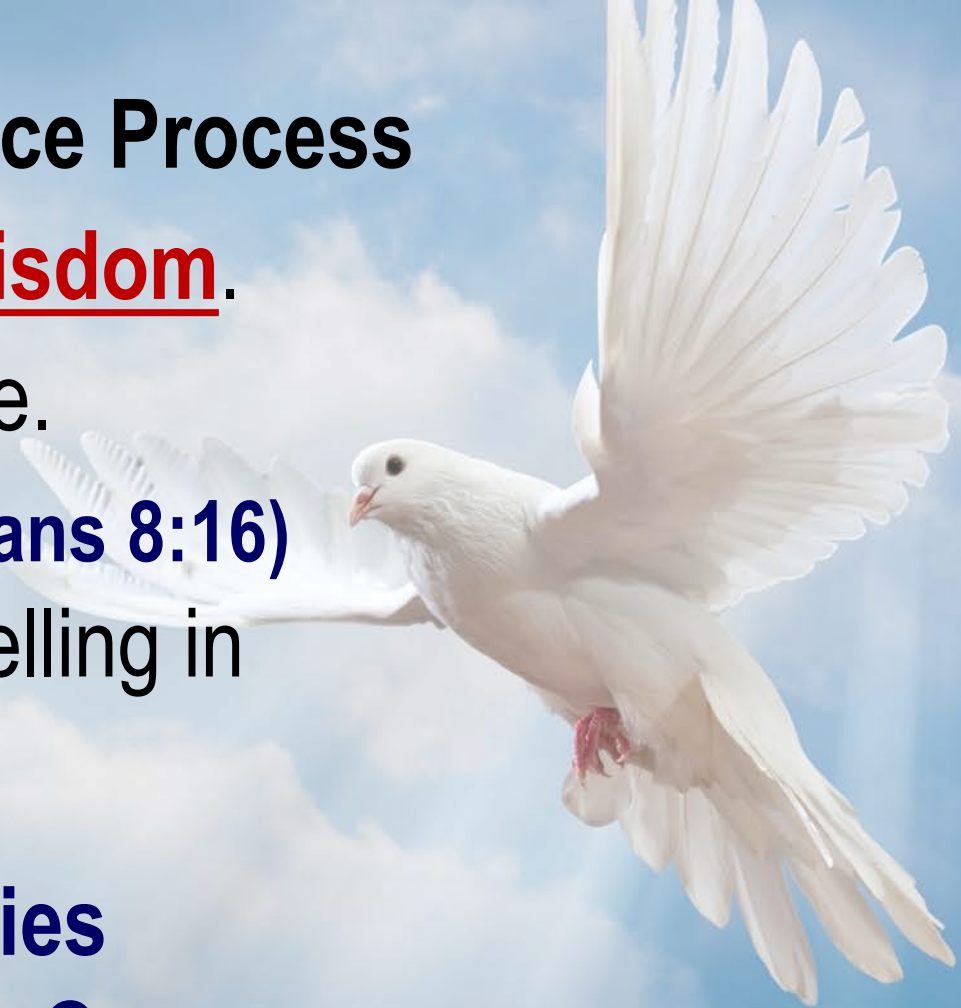

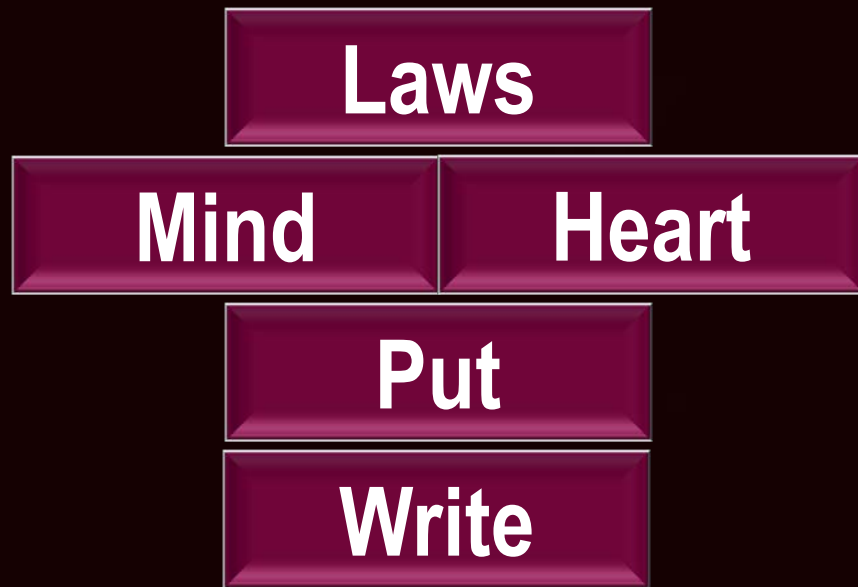
The Holy Spirit directs us in our thoughts and emotions on the decision to be made.

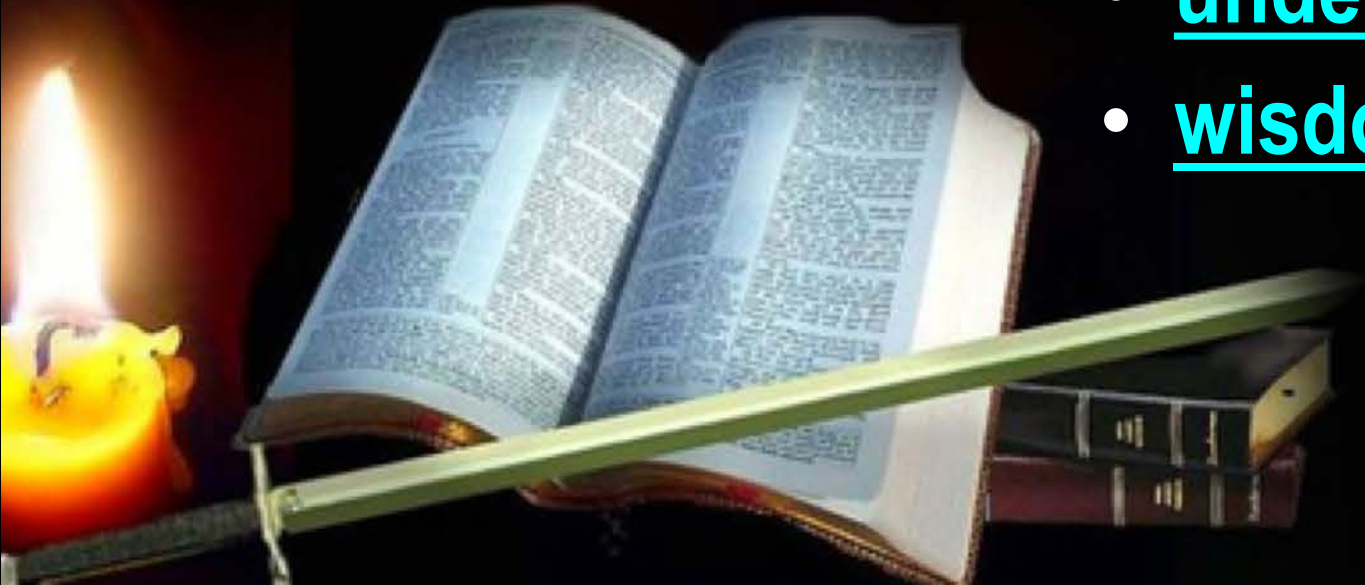

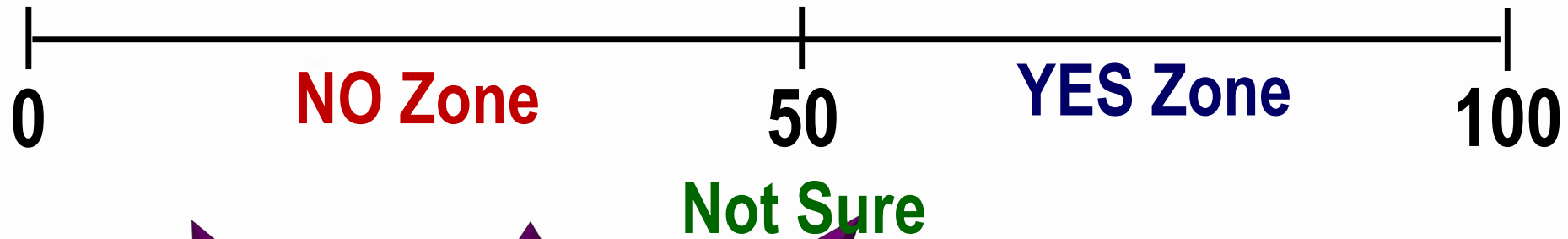
The Holy Spirit directs us in our thoughts and emotions on the decision to be made.

- wisdom - *what to decide and do*

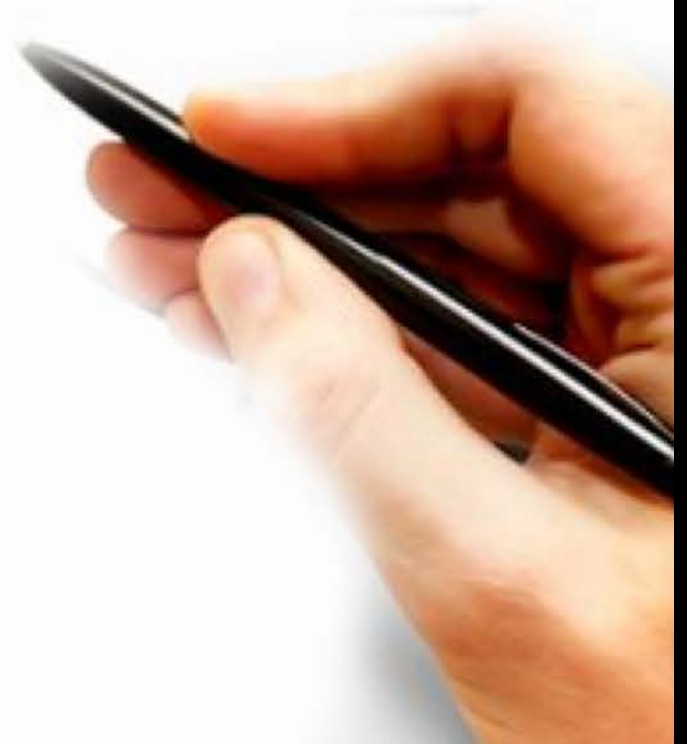


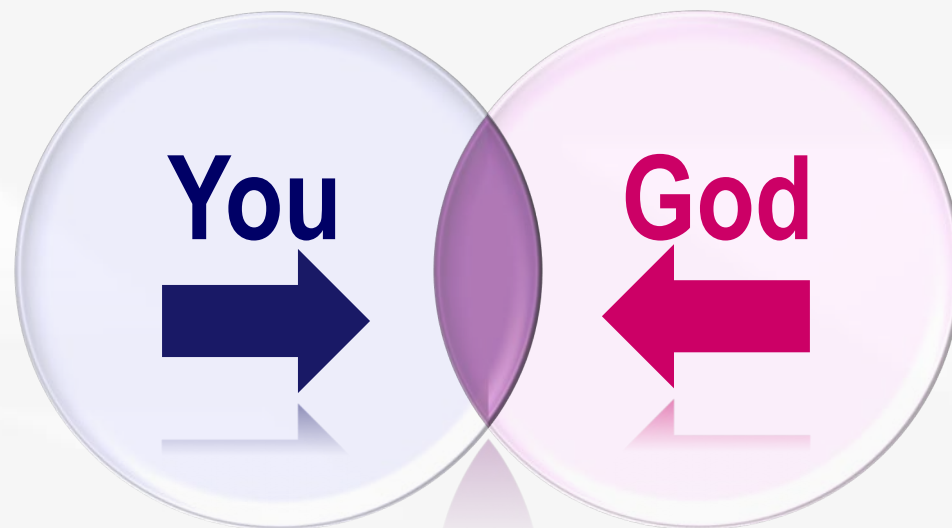
Decision-making Process



Two Conditions:

1. Do Proverbs 3:5-6 always
2. Romans 14:23
 - Decide by faith





- ✓ God desires to always guide and lead you.
- ✓ You must always desire to be guided by God.
- ✓ The area of overlap is the “Hallelujah” sector where God’s Will is your will.

Spirit of Faith - Proclaim our position in Christ:

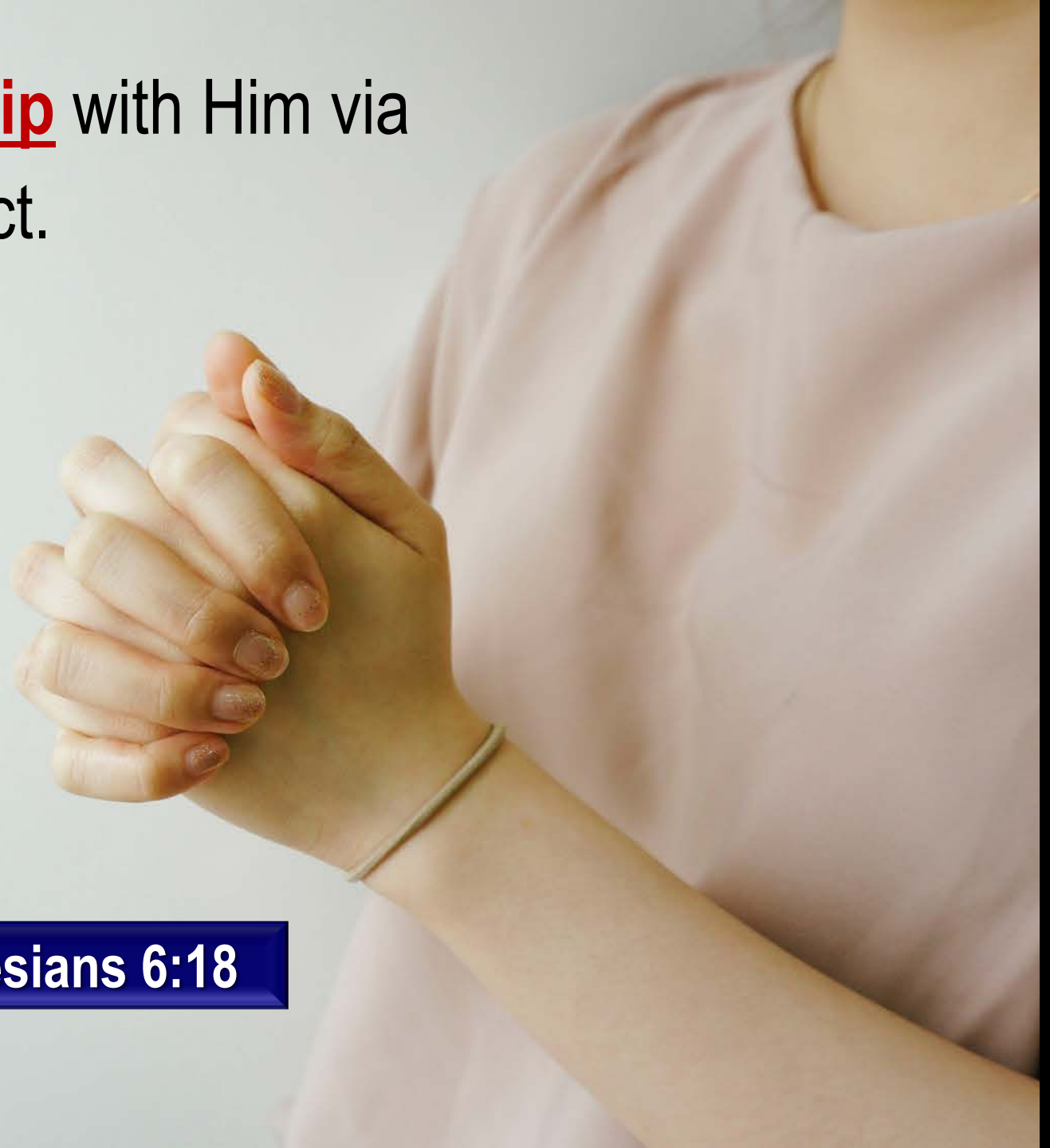
1. I can come to God 24/7 through Jesus, my Righteousness.

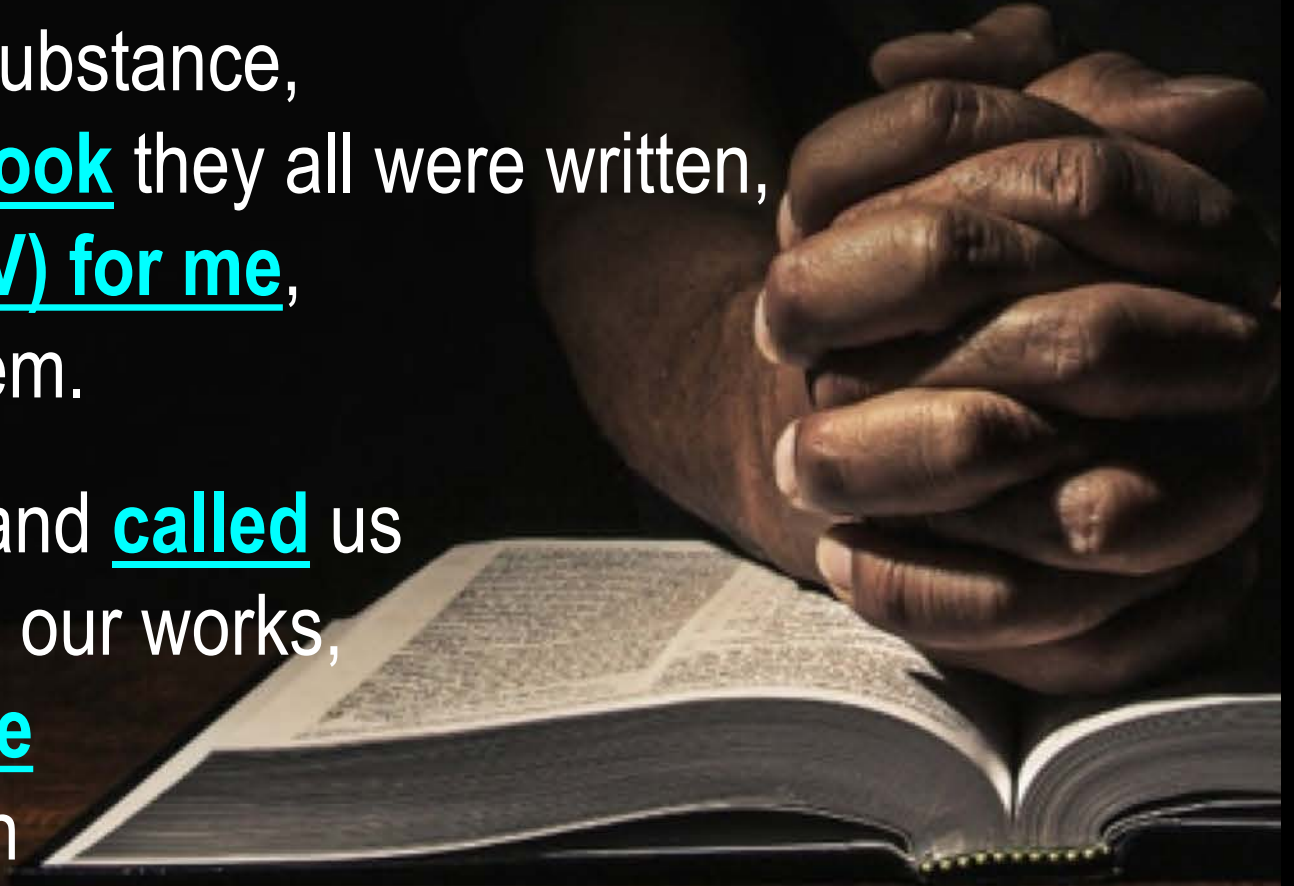


C. Continual prayer-connect

- Pray Your Book

Psalms 139:16 Your eyes saw my substance, being yet unformed. And in Your book they all were written, the days fashioned (ordained-NIV) for me, when as yet there were none of them.

2 Timothy 1:9 who has saved us and called us with a holy calling, not according to our works, but according to His own purpose and grace which was given to us in Christ Jesus before time began.

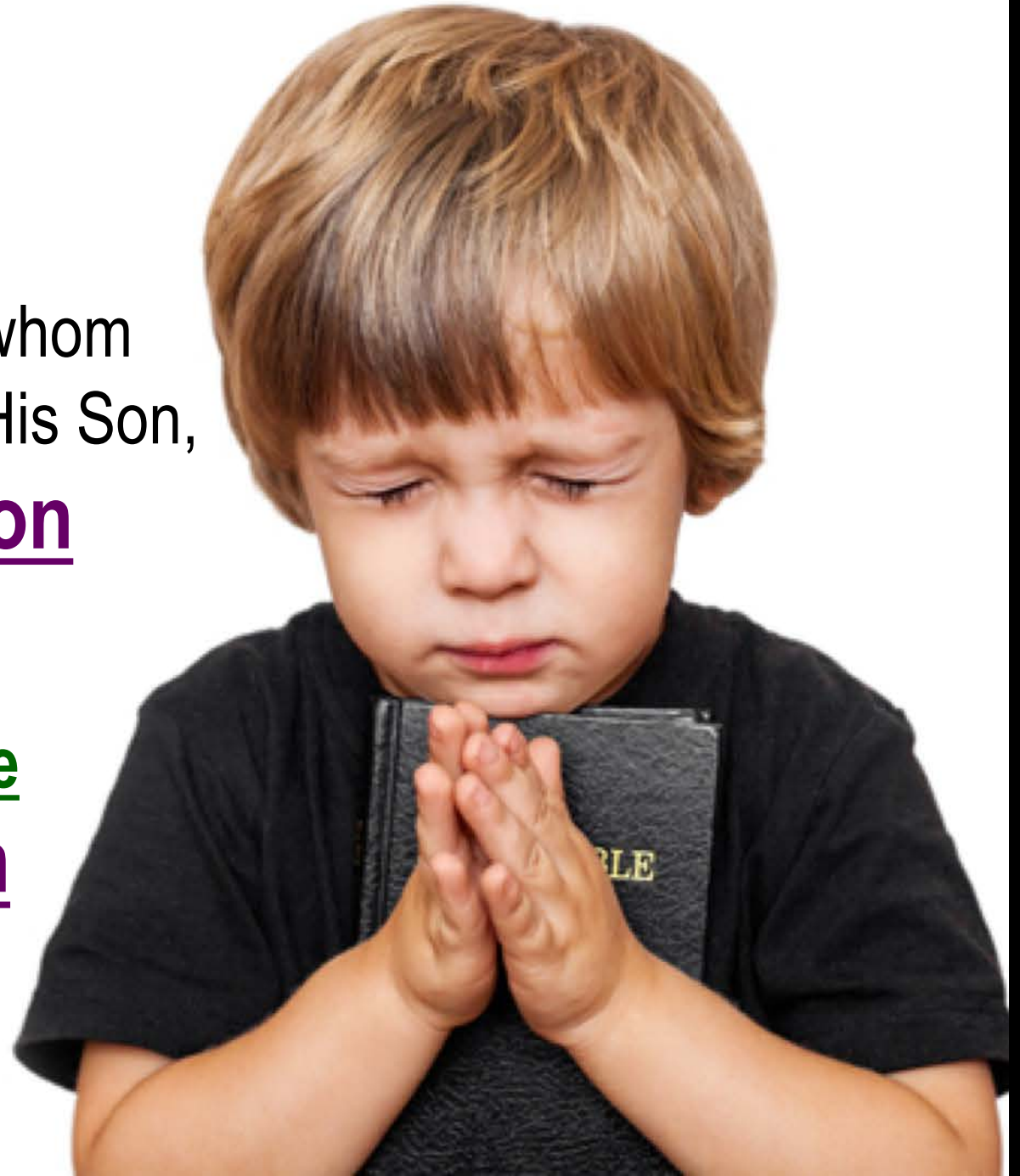


C. Continual prayer-connect

- Make Mention

Romans 1:9 For God is my witness, whom I serve with my spirit in the gospel of His Son, that without ceasing I make mention of you always in my prayers.

Ephesians 1:16 do not cease to give thanks for you, making mention of you in my prayers.



C. Continual prayer-connect

- Pray the Scriptures

Colossians 1:9-11 For this reason we also, since the day we heard it, do not cease to pray for you, and to ask that you may be filled with the knowledge of His will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding; that you may walk worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing Him, being fruitful in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God; strengthened with all might, according to His glorious power, for all patience and longsuffering with joy.



C. Continual prayer-connect

- Pray the Scriptures

2 Corinthians 9:8 And God is able to make all grace abound toward you, that you, always having all sufficiency in all things, may have an abundance for every good work.

C. Continual prayer-connect

- Spiritual Songs

Ephesians 5:18-19 And do not be drunk with wine, in which is dissipation; but be filled with the Spirit, speaking to one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord

Colossians 3:16 Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom, teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord.

Hebrews 13:15 (NIV) Through Jesus, therefore, let us continually offer to God a sacrifice of praise—the fruit of lips that confess his name.

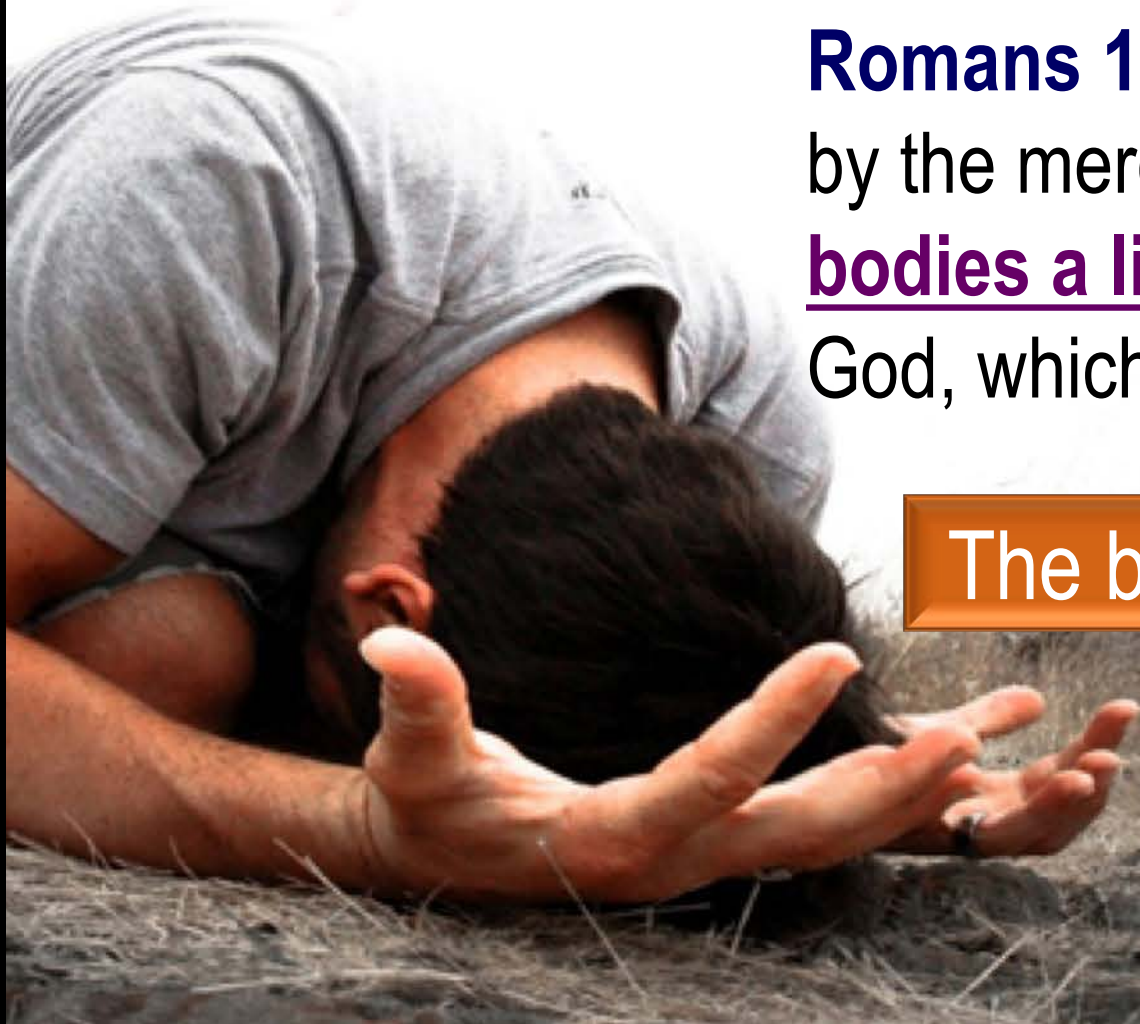
Essence of praise is declaring / knowing the Names of God.
