






1. WE NEED MORE OBADIAHS

2. WE NEED THE TOUCH OF GOD


An angel touched him and said, "Get up and eat."

He ate and drank and then lay down again.




2. WE NEED THE TOUCH OF GOD

- 16.—(1) Any person who, knowing or having reasonable cause to believe that another person is guilty of any offence included for the time being in the Second Schedule, fails to report the same to a police officer at the earliest possible opportunity shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on conviction to imprisonment
- (2) Where any person is charged with an offence under subsection (1), the burden of proving that there was no opportunity of making a report to a police officer, or that such a report was, in fact, made by him at the earliest possible opportunity, shall lie on the accused.
