

THE LAND OF MAPLE LEAVES


THE TRUE STORY OF CHRISTIANS WHO DID NOT USE THEIR VOICE

BBTCians are encouraged to read this booklet to understand the issues involved in the light of the recent debate within our nation regarding the keeping/repeal of 377A.




HOW TO SIGN UP FOR THE BBTCIANS APP




STEP 1: Search for "BBTCians" or "BBTC" in the Google Playstore or the Apple App Store. Look for the App with the BBTC logo and download and install it.
