RESCUE PROGRAMME

RESCUE is a programme that helps men overcome habitual sexual sin through accountability, camaraderie and deeper understanding of God's intent for human sexuality. At Rescue, participants will learn how to draw recovery boundaries, identify triggers and practice transparency and more. The content used in RESCUE is a curriculum-based programme written by Josh Glaser, Executive Director of Baltimorebased Regeneration Ministries.
