1. NSNW - Going Deeper. More given, more demanded!

Luke 8:18 Therefore take heed how you hear. For whoever has, to him more will be given; and whoever does not have, even what he seems to have will be taken from him."

Luke 18:1-8 Understand God wants to always bless us but cannot if there is ground against us.

This is because He cannot be loving but unrighteous

Jeremiah 9:23-24

God = Loving Kindness + Justice + Righteousness (simultaneously)

Re-align our lives to continually experience the mercy, grace and favour from God.

Titus 1:4 To Titus, a true son in our common faith: **Grace**, **mercy**, and **peace** from God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ our Saviour.

2 John 3 Grace, mercy, and peace will be with you from God the Father and from the Lord Jesus Christ, the Son of the Father, in truth and love.

Re-align our lives to continually experience the mercy, grace and favour from God.

1 Timothy 1:2 To Timothy, a true son in the faith: Grace, mercy, and peace from God our Father and Jesus Christ our Lord.

2 Timothy 1:2 To Timothy, a beloved son: Grace, mercy, and peace from God the Father and Christ Jesus our Lord.

Peace = Eirene-Shalom = Favour = Wholesome Well-being






I. Plead for Mercy.

1. Definition

A. Mercy is not getting what we deserve.

Romans 6:23 For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.





 - B. Mercy is <u>not</u> reaping the <u>negative</u> consequences of what we have <u>previously sown wrongly</u>.

Galatians 6:7-8

7 Do not be deceived, God is not mocked; for whatever a man sows, that he will also reap. 8 For he who sows to his flesh will of the flesh reap corruption, but he who sows to the Spirit will of the Spirit reap everlasting life.

Reflect from time born to date, and bring every wrong under the Blood!

B. Mercy is not reaping the <u>negative</u> consequences of what we have <u>previously sown wrongly</u>.

1 John 5:16-17

16 If anyone sees his brother <u>sinning a sin which does not lead</u> to death, he will ask, and He will give him <u>life for those who commit sin not leading to death</u>. There is sin leading to death. I do not say that he should pray about that. 17 All unrighteousness is sin, and there is <u>sin not leading to death</u>.

Mercy is not reaping the negative consequences of what **B.** we have previously sown wrongly.

Joshua 6-7 Korah & his clan | Achan who took the accursed things





Ephesians 4:27 Nor give <u>place-doorway-foothold-ground</u> to the devil.

Psalm 32:1 Blessed is he whose <u>transgression is</u> <u>forgiven</u>, whose <u>sin is covered</u>.

1 Peter 5:8 Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil walks about like a roaring lion, seeking whom he may devour.

2 Corinthians 7:1 Therefore, having these promises, beloved, let us <u>cleanse ourselves</u> from all filthiness of the flesh and spirit, perfecting holiness in the fear of God.



All sins defile us. We must cleanse ourselves!

Hebrews 12:14 Pursue peace with all people, and holiness, without which no one will see the Lord.

Question:

Hebrews 4:16 Let us therefore come boldly to the throne of grace, that we may **obtain mercy** and find grace to help in time of need.



Go to God and intentionally obtain mercy to cover our wrongs!

Primary areas Satan have legal grounds against us:

- 2. Legal ground in our bloodline.

- 5. Words of those in positions of authority over you.
- **6.** Motives of the hearts.
- 7. Failing to tithe.
- 8. Unresolved relational conflicts.

Primary areas Satan have legal grounds against us:

- 9. Failing to look after the widows, orphans and aliens.
- **10.** Husbands failing to honour their wives.
- 11. Failing to show mercy.

- **12.** Failing to forgive.
- **13.** Grieving the Holy Spirit.
- **14.** Quenching the Holy Spirit.

 - 3. The Lord's mercies are **current**, **present**, **available**.

Psalm 51:1 Have mercy upon me, O God, according to Your lovingkindness; according to the <u>multitude of Your tender mercies</u>, blot out my transgressions.


Psalm 69:16 Hear me, O Lord, for Your lovingkindness is good; turn to me according to the multitude of Your tender mercies.

Psalm 106:45 And for their sake He remembered His covenant, and relented according to the multitude of His mercies.






Hebrews 4:16 Let us therefore come boldly to the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need.

 - 2. Find a <u>promise/word from</u>
 Scriptures corresponding to the need.
 - 3. Pray <u>earnestly</u> to appropriate that grace for your specific needs.
 - 4. Do so until you receive that specific grace for the specific need!

1 Peter 2:2-3

2 as newborn babes, desire the <u>pure milk of</u> the <u>word</u>, that you may <u>grow thereby</u>,


3 if indeed you have <u>tasted-experienced</u> that the Lord is gracious.

When we continually <u>stand</u> on the Word and <u>experience</u> God coming through for us, we grow <u>Faith Convictions</u>!

II. Pursue the specific Grace for our specific needs.

James 1:17 Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and comes down from the Father of lights, with whom there is no variation or shadow of turning.





- III. Position our lives to obtain Favour.
 - 1. We must increasingly know:
 - **A.** Our Primary Calling: connected to our basic responsibilities in life.
 - B. Our Missional Calling: God's assignment for us to influence and impact lives.
 - C. We need the Favour of God to fulfil especially our Missional Calling.

E.g. Joseph, Esther, Daniel, Jesus + They grew in Favour!

III. Position our lives to obtain Favour.

2. We must increasingly <u>recognize</u> the Favour of God in our lives:

Mobilize others to help us accomplish our destiny plans and calling

Open doors

Position us in places of influence

Designed to help us to help others extend the Kingdom of God

Goodwill, acceptance and benefits flowing

Special advantages and preferential treatment

Higher levels of success and service

Winsomeness Promotes us


Favour is BONUS Grace!


- III. Position our lives to obtain Favour.

III. Position our lives to obtain Favour.


