WHAT IS A PEOPLE GROUP?

An ethno-linguistic group with a common self-identity that is shared by the various members.

7,089 unreached people groups 4.5 billion people*

WHY ARE THEY UNREACHED?

A people group is considered unreached (UPG) when there is no indigenous community of believing Christians able to engage this people group with church planting. Technically speaking, it is less than 2 percent of evangelical Christians.

3,161 unengaged unreached groups 239 million people*

WHO ARE THE UNENGAGED?

Unreached people groups are unengaged (UUPG) when there is no church planting & outreach strategy.





There are 6860 known languages in the world.

It is essential that people connect with the Word of God in their heart language for real encounter and transformation to occur.

2883 languages (42%) with some or all translations

The full Bible is available in 531 different languages, giving 4,924 million people access to Scripture

The New Testament is available in another 1,329 languages, reaching another 634 million people.

At least one book of the Bible is available in a further 1,023 other languages, reaching 243 million people.

2,195 Languages (31%) with translations in progress

There are currently over 2,195 active translation projects across more than 130 countries potentially impacting 1.9 billion people.

1,860 languages (27%) left to do

There are a further 1,860 languages that have **no active translation** going on.

What is the purpose of the Bible?



William Carey

The man who discipled & baptized India through the word of God


- Botanist "All thy works praise thee, O Lord." Carey believed that nature is declared good by its Creator, a subject worthy of human study. He frequently lectured that even lowly insects are not souls in bondage but creatures worthy of our attention.
- Mechanical Engineer introduced the first steam engine & first indigenous paper for the publishing industry to India.
- Economics Major introduced saving banks and fought lending interest rates of 36% to 72%. Also attracted foreign investments.

- Healthcare campaign for humane treatment for leprosy patients – who were burnt alive because of cultural beliefs of re-incarnation.
- Mass Communication created first newspaper.
- Agri-Horticultural Society India's land was uncultivated jungle abandoned to wild beasts & serpents.
- Education taught Bengali, Sanskrit and Marathi to Civil servants. Began schools for children of all castes and first University in Asia to liberate Indian mind from darkness of superstition.
- Mathematics, Libraries, Social Science, Philosophy, History.... Etc
