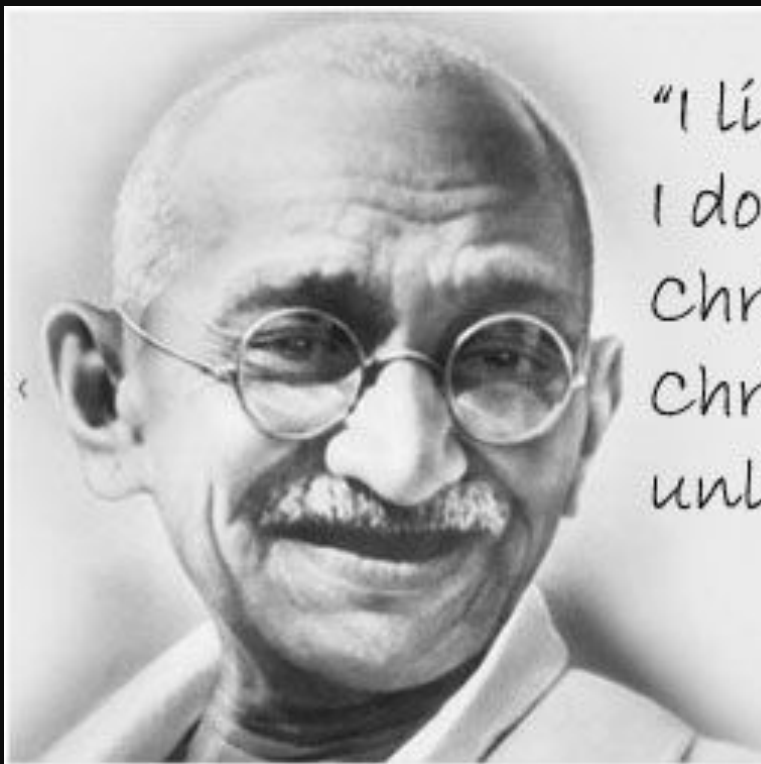

The Two Handed Gospel

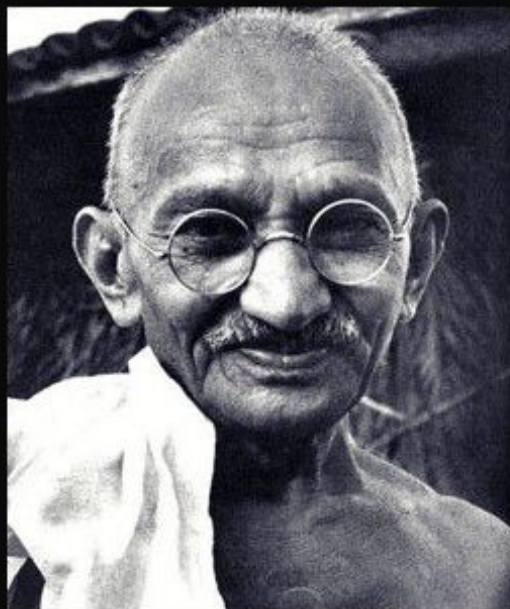
Jesus spoke the truth in love, and showed the truth with his actions. If we are to fully represent Christ today we need to both proclaim his truth and demonstrate his love.

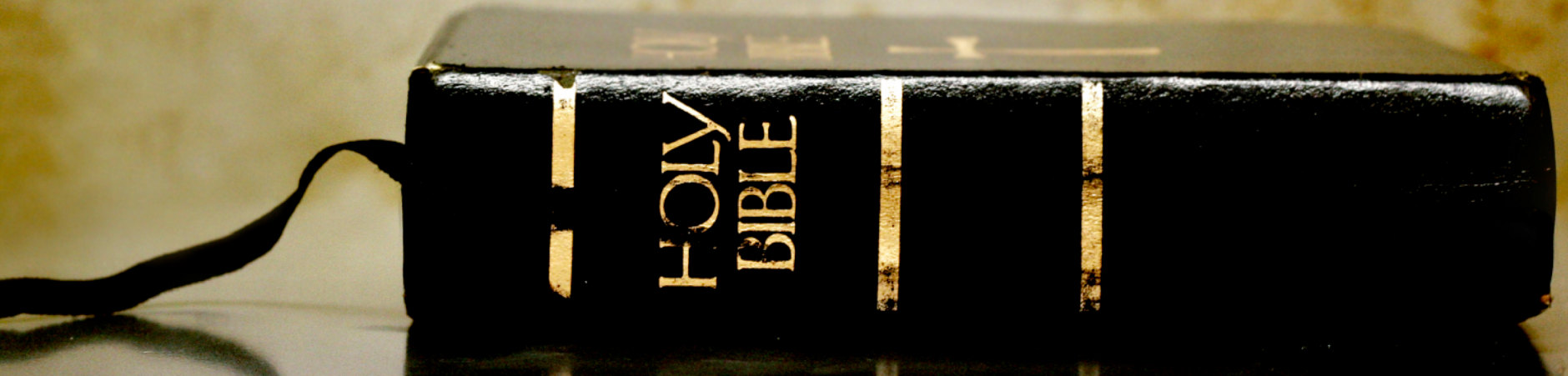
