Genesis 22:1-14

12 And He said, "Do not lay your hand on the lad, or do anything to him; for now I know that you fear God, since you have not withheld your son, your only son, from Me." 13 Then Abraham lifted his eyes and looked, and there behind him was a ram caught in a thicket by its horns. So Abraham went and took the ram, and offered it up for a burnt offering instead of his son. 14 And Abraham called the name of the place, <u>The-LORD-Will-Provide</u>; as it is said to this day, "In the Mount of the LORD it shall be provided."

This is a very unique situation between God and Abraham. Based on the specific covenantal relationship between them in Genesis 17, Abraham believed God will raise Isaac and a multitude after him.

God saved the promised son to A from being the sacrifice.

Eventually, God provided the perfect sacrifice for the sins of the world! John 3:16 This is a <u>unique situation</u> between God and Abraham based on the covenantal relationship between them. (exemplar, not mandata)

Hebrew 11:17-19

17 By faith Abraham, when he was tested, offered up Isaac, and <u>he who had received the promises</u> offered up his only begotten son, 18 of whom it was said, "In Isaac your seed shall be called," 19 <u>concluding that God</u> <u>was able to raise him up</u>, <u>even from the dead</u>, from which he also received him in a figurative sense.

Learn the principle: Faith in God. Trust His Word.

It is <u>NOT</u> a command to sacrifice our children (Molech-Canaanite)

A. Know, understand and trust God as Your ultimate Provider.

1 Kings 17:12-15 12 So she said, "As the Lord your God lives, I do not have bread, only a handful of flour in a bin, and a little oil in a jar; and see, I am gathering a couple of sticks that I may go in and prepare it for myself and my son, that we may eat it, and die."13 And Elijah said to her, "Do not fear; go and do as you have said, but make me a small cake from it first, and bring it to me; and afterward make some for yourself and your son.

1 Kings 17:12-15 14 For thus says the Lord God of Israel: 'The bin of flour shall not be used up, nor shall the jar of oil run dry, until the day the Lord sends rain on the earth." 15 So she went away and did according to the word of Elijah; and she and he and her household ate for many days.

B. Seek God first, His Kingdom and His Righteousness.

Matthew 6:25 Therefore I say to you, do not worry about your life, what you will eat or what you will drink; nor about your body, what you will put on. Is not life more than food and the body more than clothing?

B. Seek God **first**, His Kingdom and His Righteousness.

Matthew 6:31-34

31 "Therefore do not worry, saying, 'What shall we eat?' or 'What shall we drink?' or 'What shall we wear?' 32 For after all these things the Gentiles seek. For your heavenly Father knows that you need all these things. 33 But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you. 34 Therefore do not worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will worry about its own things. Sufficient for the day is its own trouble.



B. Seek <u>first</u> God, His Kingdom and His Righteousness.
(1) This is all about making <u>Jesus the KING</u> of our lives. It is about:
(A) His <u>Reign</u> and
(B) His <u>Rule</u> over our lives. B. Seek <u>first</u> God, His Kingdom and His Righteousness.
(2) His Kingdom is governed by <u>Righteousness</u>.
(A) Right <u>standing</u> with God [Justification].
(B) Right <u>believing</u> in God [The Word and Holy Spirit].
(C) Right <u>living</u> [Obedience].

B. Seek <u>first</u> God, His Kingdom and His Righteousness.
(2) His Kingdom is governed by <u>Righteousness</u>.

Romans 5:1-2 1 Therefore, having been justified by faith, we have <u>beace with</u> God through our Lord Jesus Christ (right standing), 2 through whom (Jesus) also we have access by faith into this grace (provision) in which we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God.

B. Seek <u>first</u> God, His Kingdom and His Righteousness.
(2) His Kingdom is governed by <u>Righteousness</u>.

Jeremiah 9:24 But let him who glories glory in this, That he understands and knows Me, that <u>I am the Lord</u>, <u>exercising lovingkindness</u>, <u>judgment</u>, <u>and</u> <u>righteousness</u> in the earth. For in these I delight," says the Lord.

God cannot be loving (wanting to give and bless us) but unjust and un-righteous!

Hebrews 6:10

C. Do not love the world. Deepen your relationship with God.
(1) Be rooted in the Father's love to overcome the love of the world.

1 John 2:15-16 15 Do not love the world or the things Love in the world. If anyone loves the world, of the the love of the Father is not in him. of the **16** For all that is in the world — the **lust** World Father of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life—is not of the Father but is **of the world**.

(2A) Hold very <u>loosely</u> everything of the <u>world</u>.
(2B) Hold very <u>tightly</u> to the <u>Word & your r/s with the HS</u>.

Isaiah 30:1-3

1 "Woe to the rebellious children," says the Lord, "Who take <u>counsel</u>, but <u>not of Me</u>, and who <u>devise plans</u>, but **not of My Spirit**, that they may add sin to sin; **2 who walk** to go down to Egypt, and have not asked My advice, to strengthen themselves in the strength of Pharaoh, and to trust in the **shadow of Egypt**! 3 Therefore the **strength** of Pharaoh shall be your shame, and trust in the shadow of Egypt shall be your humiliation.

Isaiah 31:1 <u>Woe to those who go down to Egypt for help</u>, and <u>rely on horses</u>, who <u>trust in chariots</u> because they are many, and in horsemen because they are very strong, but who <u>do not look to the Holy One of Israel</u>, <u>nor seek the Lord</u>!

C. Do not love the world. Deepen your relationship with God.
(2A) Hold very loosely everything of the world.
(2B) Hold very tightly to the Word & your r/s with the HS.

John 16:33 These things I have spoken to you, that **in Me you may have peace**. **In the world you will have tribulation**; but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world."

Lady in pits/failures till saw goodness of God at Calvary

(2A) Hold very <u>loosely</u> everything of the <u>world</u>.
(2B) Hold very <u>tightly</u> to the <u>Word & your r/s with the HS</u>.
Exodus 8:22-23

22 ... that no swarms of flies ... 23 ... make a difference between My people and your people...

Exodus 9:4 And the Lord will <u>make a difference between the livestock</u> of Israel and the livestock of Egypt. So nothing shall die of all that belongs to the children of Israel.

Exodus 11:7 ... the Lord does make a difference between the Egyptians and Israel.

C. Do not love the world. Deepen your relationship with God
(3) Do NOT give ground-foothold to the evil one.

1 John 5:18 ... but <u>he who has been born of God</u> <u>keeps himself</u>, and <u>the wicked one does not touch-harm</u> (NIV) him.

Ephesians 4:27 nor give place (doorway-open doors) to the devil.

1 Peter 5:8 Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil walks about like a roaring lion, seeking whom he may devour.

John 10:10a

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Hebrews 4:16 Let us therefore come boldly to the <u>throne of grace</u>, that we may <u>obtain mercy</u> and **find grace to help**

in time of **need**.

D. Find the specific grace for our specific needs. Luke 11:11-13 11 If a son asks for bread from any father among you, will he give him a stone? Or if he asks for a fish, will he give him a serpent instead of a fish? 12 Or if he asks for an egg, will he offer him a scorpion? 13 If you then, being evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your heavenly Father give the **Holy Spirit** to those who ask Him!"

God provides for our basic needs because He is our Father-God!

Where to seek Grace (specific provision)?
Seek GRACE in the Word of God:
(1) in the promises of God
(2) in the laws and principles in scriptures.

Know the Promises and Principles in scripture. e.g. 1 - About the <u>Tithe</u>

Malachi 3:8-11 8 "Will a man rob God? Yet you have robbed Me! But you say, 'In what way have we robbed You?' In tithes and offerings. 9 You are cursed with a curse, for you have robbed Me, even this whole nation. 10 Bring all the tithes into the storehouse, that there may be food in My house, and try Me now in this," says the Lord of hosts, "If I will not open for you the windows of heaven and pour out for you such **blessing** that there will not be room enough to receive it. Know the Promises and Principles in scripture. e.g. 1 - About the <u>Tithe</u>

Malachi 3:8-11

11 "And I will <u>rebuke the devourer</u> for your sakes, so that he will not destroy the fruit of your ground, nor shall the vine fail to bear fruit for you in the field," says the Lord of hosts.

> The tithe is NOT about \$. It is about our FAITH! Firstfruits to God!



Know the Promises and Principles in scripture. e.g. 2 - About showing Mercy

James 2:13 For judgment is without mercy to the one who has shown no mercy. Mercy triumphs over judgment.

Orphans - Widows - Foreigners The weaker - less privileged - dis-advantaged

Know the Promises and Principles in scripture. e.g. 3 - About being Generous

Proverbs 11:25 The generous soul will be made rich, and he who waters will also be watered himself.

You may give without loving, but you cannot love without giving!

Know the Promises and Principles in scripture. e.g. 4 - About giving to the Poor

Proverbs 19:17 He who has pity on the poor lends to the LORD, and He will pay back what he has given.

Psalm 112:5-7
5 A good man deals graciously and lends; He will guide his affairs with discretion. 6 Surely he will never be shaken; The righteous will be in everlasting remembrance. 7 He will not be afraid of evil tidings; His heart is steadfast, trusting in the Lord.

Know the Promises and Principles in scripture. e.g. 5 - About the Law of Faith [James 2:14-16]

Hebrews 11:6 But <u>without faith it is impossible to please Him</u>, for he who comes to God <u>must believe that He is</u>, and that He is a rewarder of those who <u>diligently seek Him</u>.

God responds to our **faith**, not to our needs per se.

It is **NOT** about **Praying Harder**! It is about **Praying from the Heart**!



Know the Promises and Principles in scripture. e.g. 6 - About bread and <u>seed</u>

2 Corinthians 9:10 Now may He who supplies <u>seed to the sower</u>, and bread for food, supply and multiply the seed you have sown and increase the fruits of your righteousness

Ecclesiastes 11:1, 6

1 <u>Cast your bread upon the waters</u>, <u>for you will find it after</u> <u>many days</u>. 6 In the morning <u>sow your seed</u>, and in the evening <u>do not withhold your hand</u>; <u>(diligence)</u> for you do not know which will prosper, either this or that, or whether both alike will be good. **Know the Promises and Principles** in scripture. e.g. 6 - About bread and <u>seed</u>

2 Corinthians 9:6

6 But this I say: He who <u>sows sparingly will also reap sparingly</u>, and he who <u>sows bountifully will also reap bountifully</u>. 7 So let each one <u>give as he purposes in his heart</u>, not grudgingly or of necessity; for God loves a cheerful giver.

Luke 16:10a He who is faithful in what is least is faithful also in much ...

If you're not been faithful to handle thousands of dollars, unlikely the L will entrust you with the hundreds of thousands of dollars! Stewardship - Buckets - Income Sources - Expenditure

Know the **Promises and Principles** in scripture.

- e.g. 6 About bread and seed
- The Prosperity Gospel focuses almost entirely on the <u>material</u>, <u>monetary</u>, and treat God as a <u>magic machine</u>!
- The Gospel of the KOG is NOT the Prosperity Gospel.
- H/e, the Gospel of the KOG will bless believers accordingly (faith, laws...)
- Throw the <u>dirty water</u> in the bath tub, but <u>keep the baby</u>.
- Eat the <u>meat</u>, throw away the <u>bones</u>.
- We can never buy or pay for the **Blessings of God**.
- It is all His Mercy and Grace.

Bottom-line

The key to the Lord's Providence is Surrender and Trust

Bottom-line [Act of FAITH] Combine Giving w Prayer

- Widow offered her last meal to Elijah and ate for many days
- David bought threshing floor & oxen & sacrificed to the L/asked for mercy
- Boy brought 5 loaves & 2 fishes to the L Who then fed 5000
- Disciples gave 7 loaves & few small fish to the L Who fed 4000
- 1. Know what is bread & seed. Sow a seed make an offering to the Lord.
- 2. The harvest [grace for your particular need] is in the seed.
- **3.** Water the seed with prayer asking for the grace you need (Hebrews 4:16).
- **4.** Do this intentionally as an act of faith (Hebrews 11:6).
- 5. Continue to soak this matter in expectant prayer.
