First Mention of Jehovah Shalom - Judges 6:6, 11, 13

6 So Israel was greatly impoverished because of the Midianites, and the children of Israel cried out to the Lord.

11 Now the Angel of the Lord came and sat under the terebinth tree which was in Ophrah, which belonged to Joash the Abiezrite, while his son Gideon threshed wheat in the winepress, in order to hide it from the Midianites.

13 Gideon said to Him, "O my lord, if the Lord is with us, why then has all this happened to us? And where are all His miracles which our fathers told us about, saying, 'Did not the Lord bring us up from Egypt?' But now the Lord has forsaken us and delivered us into the hands of the Midianites."

First Mention of Jehovah Shalom - Judges 6:15-16, 23-24

15 So he said to Him, "O my Lord, how can I save Israel? Indeed my clan is the weakest in Manasseh, and I am the least in my father's house." **16** And the Lord said to him, "Surely I will be with you, and you shall defeat the Midianites as one man."

23 Then the Lord said to him, "Peace be with you; do not fear, you shall not die." 24 So Gideon built an altar there to the Lord, and called it The-Lord-Is-Peace. To this day it is still in Ophrah of the Abiezrites.

I. Why do we not have peace? When we are NOT in \$\$\$ sync with God Who is loving, just & righteous.

Judges 6:1-24

1 Then the children of Israel did evil in the sight of the Lord. So the Lord delivered them into the hand of Midian for seven years, 2 and the hand of Midian prevailed against Israel. Because of the Midianites, the children of Israel made for themselves the dens, the caves, and the strongholds which are in the mountains. 3 So it was, whenever Israel had sown, Midianites would come up; also Amalekites and the people of the East would come up against them. 4 Then they would encamp against them and destroy the produce of the earth as far as Gaza, and leave no sustenance for Israel, neither sheep nor ox nor donkey.

Judges 6:1-24

Have I not sent you?" 15 So he said to Him, "O my Lord, how can I save Israel? Indeed my clan is the weakest in Manasseh, and I am the least in my father's house."

Judges 6:1-24

16 And the Lord said to him, "Surely I will be with you, and you shall defeat the Midianites as one man." 17 Then he said to Him, "If now I have found favor in Your sight, then show me a sign that it is You who talk with me. 18 Do not depart from here, I pray, until I come to You and bring out my offering and set it before You." And He said, "I will wait until you come back." 19 So Gideon went in and prepared a young goat, and unleavened bread from an ephah of flour. The meat he put in a basket, and he put the broth in a pot; and he brought them out to Him under the terebinth tree and presented them.

Judges 6:1-24

20 The Angel of God said to him, "Take the meat and the unleavened bread and lay them on this rock, and pour out the broth." And he did so. 21 Then the Angel of the Lord put out the end of the staff that was in His hand, and touched the meat and the unleavened bread; and fire rose out of the rock and consumed the meat and the unleavened bread. And the Angel of the Lord departed out of his sight.
22 Now Gideon perceived that He was the Angel of the Lord. So Gideon said, "Alas, O Lord God! For I have seen the Angel of the Lord face to face."

Judges 6:1-24 23 Then the Lord said to him, "<u>Peace be with you</u>; <u>do not fear</u>, <u>you shall not</u> <u>die</u>." 24 So Gideon built an altar there to the Lord, and called it <u>The-Lord-Is-</u> <u>Peace</u>. To this day it is still in Ophrah of the Abiezrites.

Isaiah 57:21 "There is <u>no peace</u>," says my God, "<u>for the wicked</u>." Wicked = evil Wicked = wilfully have NO regard for God [Romans 1]

Malachi 3:18 Then you shall again discern between the righteous and the wicked, between one who serves God and one who does not serve Him.

Matthew 25:26a But his lord answered and said to him, 'You wicked and lazy servant ...

1 Corinthians 3:1-3

Peace of God to overcome Life-Problems!

1. Peace that guards our hearts and mind.

Philippians 4:6-8

8 Finally, brethren, whatever things are <u>true</u>, whatever things are <u>noble</u>, whatever things are <u>just</u>, whatever things are <u>pure</u>, whatever things are <u>lovely</u>, whatever things are of good report, if there is any <u>virtue</u> and if there is anything <u>praiseworthy</u> <u>–(pray) meditate</u> on these things.

2. Peace of God <u>ruling</u> in our hearts.

Colossians 3:15 And let the <u>peace of</u> <u>Christ / God rule in your hearts</u>, to which also you were called in <u>one body</u>; and be thankful.

Peace of God to overcome especially <u>People</u>-Problems!

3. Peace at all times, in all ways and in every situation.

2 Thessalonians 3:16 Now may the Lord of peace Himself give you peace always in every way. The Lord be with you all.

2 Thessalonians 3:2-3

2 and that we may be delivered from unreasonable and wicked

men; for not all have faith. 3 But the Lord is faithful, who will establish you and guard you from the evil one.

The Lord of Peace provides **Protection** from evil & wicked people!

- **B.** Grow in <u>experiential</u> knowledge of each Person of the Trinity.
- 1 Corinthians 8:7 However, there is <u>not in everyone that knowledge</u>; for some, with consciousness of the idol, until now eat it as a thing offered to an idol; and <u>their conscience</u>, <u>being weak</u>, <u>is defiled</u>.

The issue of Weak Conscience is due to the lack of knowledge of God & His Word

+1 Corinthians 10 & Romans 14

Peace at all <u>times</u>, in all <u>ways</u> and in every <u>situation</u>. HOW?
 C. Lay hold of and experience the Promises of God.

2 Peter 1:4 by which have been given to us <u>exceedingly great and</u> <u>precious promises</u>, that through these you may <u>be partakers of the</u> <u>divine nature</u>, having <u>escaped the corruption that is in the world through</u> <u>lust</u>.

Blessings do not come to mere listeners of the Word! Blessings only come to us when we obey-apply the Word! **3.** Peace at all <u>times</u>, in all <u>ways</u> and in every <u>situation</u>. HOW?

C. Lay hold of and experience the Promises of God. Examples:


