





Romans 6:23 For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.








- 1. Due generally to the Fallen-ness of Man results in:
 - * Physical death:
 - Hundreds of years (Genesis 1 to 5)
 - to 120 years (after Noah's flood Genesis 6:3)
 - -to 80 years (Psalm 90:10 after Mt Sinai to now)
 - Aging Process (affecting life-span)
 - Sickness & Diseases
 - Corruption & Mortality of the physical body

I. Understanding Direct Sources of Sicknesses & Infirmities







Main causes of <u>lung cancer</u>

Smoking, exposure to second-hand smoke, exposure to radon gas, exposure to asbestos, other carcinogens and family history of lung cancer.

Main causes of heart attacks

Clogged arteries, age, tobacco, high blood pressure, obesity, diabetes, high blood cholesterol or triglyceride levels, stress, metabolic syndrome, family history of heart attacks, lack of physical activity, illicit drug use, a history of preeclampsia and an autoimmune condition.

Lack of Sleep & Rest will

- prevent the body from strengthening the immune system and producing more cytokines to fight infection;
- affect body weight two hormones in the body, leptin and ghrelin, control feelings of hunger and satiety, or fullness;
- cause the release of insulin, which leads to increased fat storage and a higher risk of type 2 diabetes.

Dehydration

- Dehydration can lead to digestive problems, constipation, and an overly acidic stomach.
- This increases the risk of heartburn and stomach ulcers.
- Water is needed in the processes of sweating and removal of urine and feces.
- A lack of water can cause blood to become thicker, increasing blood pressure.

Poor nutrition-diet

- A nutritional deficiency occurs when the body doesn't absorb or get from food the necessary amount of a nutrient.
- Deficiencies can lead to a variety of health problems.
- These can include digestion problems, skin disorders, stunted or defective bone growth, and even dementia.

Matthew 18:21-35

21 Then Peter came to Him and said, "Lord, how often shall my brother sin against me, and I forgive him? Up to seven times?" 22 Jesus said to him, "I do not say to you, up to seven times, but up to seventy times seven. 23 Therefore the kingdom of heaven is like a certain king who wanted to settle accounts with his servants. 24 And when he had begun to settle accounts, one was brought to him who owed him ten thousand talents.



Ephesians 4:26-27 (NIV)

26 "In your anger do not sin": Do not let the sun go down while you are still angry, 27 and do not give the devil a foothold/ground/door/space.



3. Due to the **Evil One**

John 10:10 The thief does not come except to <u>steal</u>, and to <u>kill</u>, and to <u>destroy</u>. I have come that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly.



John 8:44 ... the <u>devil</u>, He was a <u>murderer</u> from the beginning, and does <u>not stand in the truth</u>, because there is <u>no truth in him</u>. When he speaks a <u>lie</u>, he speaks from his own resources, for he is <u>a liar and the</u> father of it.

12 But when Jesus saw her, He called her to Him and said to her, "Woman, you are


loosed from your infirmity."

Deaf & Dumb Spirit (unclean spirit)




Luke 8:26-33




30 Jesus asked him, saying, "What is your name?" And he said, "Legion," because many


II. God has made provision for our healing!


Isaiah 53:4-5



Proverbs 3:8 It will be health to your flesh, and strength to your bones.


Proverbs 4:20-22

3. Through the laying of hands by believers in outreach. Healing for pre-believers is a special grace of God for the purpose of salvation.

Mark 16:17-18, 20 17 And these signs will follow those who believe: In My name they will cast out demons; ... 18 ... they will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover." 20 And they went out and preached everywhere, the Lord working with them and confirming the word through the accompanying signs. Amen.

1 Corinthians 12:7-10







V. Pastoral Guidance re Healing

- Personal
- For yourself, aim to walk in divine healing, divine health and life!
- Don't stop praying for healing. Explore ALL possibilities for healing (medical & spiritual).
- When still not healed, ask for the grace of God to go through [2 Corinthians 12:9].
- We want healing but sometimes, there is a more critical need [Acts 3:6].

Eg.: r/s; forgiveness; recon; salvation, etc.
