







...the most portentous (important) fact about any man is not what he at a given time may say or do, but what he in his deep heart conceives God to be like.




After the worship of the golden calf – needed to see something for worship in C32. Context of Ex 34:6-7



Ex20: 5 You shall not worship them or serve them; for I, the Lord your God, am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers on the children, on the third and the fourth generations of those who hate Me, 6 but showing lovingkindness to thousands, to those who love Me and keep My commandments.

Uncompromising Conduct of God (Covenant with Man)

Rom 11:22 Behold then the kindness and severity of God; to those who fell, severity, but to you, God's kindness, if you continue in His kindness; otherwise you also will be cut off.

Ex 34:8 Moses made haste to bow low toward the earth and worship. 9 He said, "If now I have found favor in Your sight, O Lord, I pray, let the Lord go along in our midst, even though the people are so obstinate, and pardon our iniquity and our sin, and take us as Your own possession."

Promises of God

10 Then God said, "Behold, I am going to <u>make a covenant</u>. Before all your people <u>I will perform miracles</u> which have not been produced in all the earth nor among any of the nations; and all the people among whom you live <u>will see the working of the Lord</u>, for it is a <u>fearful thing</u> that I am going to perform with you.
