**Receiving the Holy Spirit is accompanied by:**

- Speaking in tongues
- Preaching in boldness
- Obedience
- Performing signs and wonders
- Worshipping with joy

*So in every case of the Holy Spirit's coming or being received in the book of Acts there are **definite effects** that one can point to as evidence that the Spirit has been received. ....*

*...one thing is clear: Luke expects the receiving of the Holy Spirit (however we receive him) to be a **real, identifiable experience** of the living God, **not just a logical inference** from a human act of will.*

Writing of Luke in both Gospel of Luke and Acts:

## How to receive the Power of the Holy Spirit?

Be hungry for more of the Holy Spirit

Ask God for the Holy Spirit (Lk11)

Come and be prayed over by leaders



I think it would be a mistake to limit baptism in, by, or with the Holy Spirit to a single second event after conversion. Even though you might experience one, that doesn't mean it's the normative way that this baptism is to be understood. I think the kind of filling and empowering that we receive in such experiences are needed again and again and again in the Christian life. They're not consistently the same in every season of the Christian life.

So this later outpouring of the Spirit on the Gentiles (in Acts 10:44) is equated with the first Pentecostal outpouring, and both are explained as a baptism with the Spirit. Therefore, Paul sees what happened at Pentecost as both a baptism with the Spirit and a filling with the Spirit. Since Luke refers later on to the disciples being filled again (Acts 4:8, 31; 13:4), but never refers to them as being baptized again with the Spirit, it seems to me that for Luke "baptism with the Spirit" refers to that initial filling by the Spirit after a person trusts in Christ.

Well, what then does Jesus mean in Acts 1:5 and Luke 3? I think when he says you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit, he means you will receive extraordinary power for Christ-exalting ministry. That's what I think he means. You will receive extraordinary power for Christ-exalting ministry.

But now back to the person who is asking if you have been baptized with the Spirit. If he uses Paul's definition, "Have you been united to Christ by the Spirit so that you are part of his body (1 Corinthians 12:12)?" — then the answer for all believers should be, "Yes, I have indeed been baptized with the Spirit." If he uses Luke's definition and means, "Have you ever once been so filled by the Holy Spirit that you were filled with joy, had victory over besetting sins, and were ready to witness?" — then the answer should be and could be yes for all Christians, but probably won't be.
