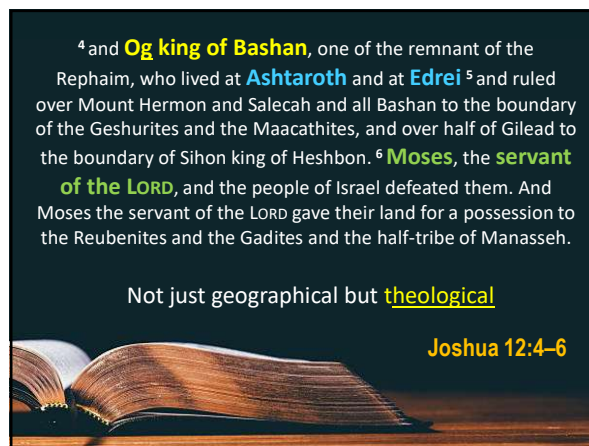






The Amorites

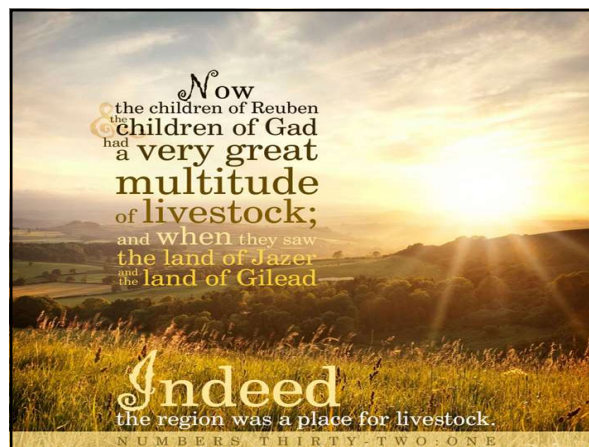
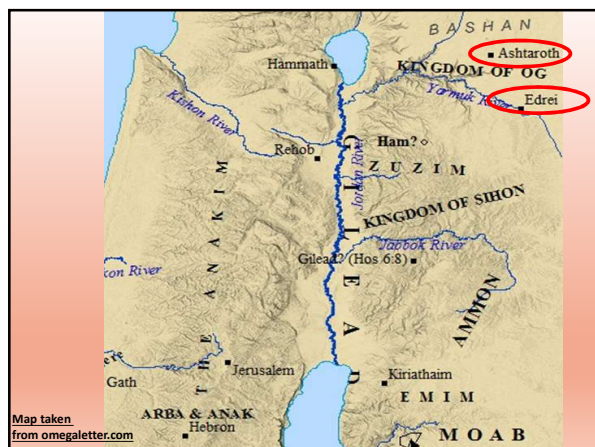
- Means Highlanders
- Lived in Heshbon
- Occupied hill country
(Deuteronomy 1:7,19-20; Numbers 13:29)
- Known as "High and Mighty One"
- Known for their military power
(Deuteronomy 1:44)



⁴ and **Og king of Bashan**, one of the remnant of the Rephaim, who lived at **Ashtaroth** and at **Edrei** ⁵ and ruled over Mount Hermon and Salecah and all Bashan to the boundary of the Geshurites and the Maacathites, and over half of Gilead to the boundary of Sihon king of Heshbon. ⁶ **Moses**, the **servant of the LORD**, and the people of Israel defeated them. And Moses the servant of the LORD gave their land for a possession to the Reubenites and the Gadites and the half-tribe of Manasseh.
