Pastoral Word #2 COVID19 is NOT God's Judgment

- **1.** Biblical Judgments of pestilences are <u>supernatural</u> in origin:
 - boils in Egypt on man and beast
 - in Revelation
 - Num 16 -14.7K; Num 25 -24K; 2 Sam 24 -70K

COVID19 virus is natural, evolved-mutated, not supernatural
2. Biblical judgments of pestilences are vs <u>specific</u> sins & pp.

COVID19 is a <u>sin consequence</u> (fallen-ness of Man) Those afflicted are <u>NOT</u> more sinful than others - Luke13

Pastoral Word #2 COVID19 is <u>NOT</u> God's Judgment

The Lord is WTH us in our pain and sufferings!

The Church - Repent, Pray, Worship, Connect, Give, Good Deeds, Gospel, etc.

Pray & Help - Government, Healthcare Workers, The Sick, Unemployed, Poor, The Affected, Economy, Homeless, Foreigners, etc.

We develop our relationship with Him as we sense His Presence.

A. Regularly speaking forth the Rhema Word.

2 Corinthians 4:13 And since we have the same <u>spirit of faith</u>, according to what is written, "<u>I believed and therefore</u> <u>I spoke</u>," <u>we also believe and therefore</u> <u>speak</u>.

SPIRIT OF FAITH - Proclaim our **position** in Christ: (1) I can come to God $\frac{24/7}{100}$ through Jesus, my Righteousness. I am deeply loved and completely forgiven (2) in Christ. I am highly <u>favoured</u>. (3)I am always protected in Christ Jesus. (4) I have access to Divine Wisdom. (5) I walk in Divine healing, health and life. (6) I am always blessed in Christ. (7)

2. Surrender continually in daily living. How? **B.** Always <u>obey-apply-do</u> the instructions in the Word of God. Matthew 7:24-25 24 Therefore whoever hears these sayings of Mine, and does them, I will liken him to a **Wise** man who built his house on the rock: 25 and the rain descended, the floods came, and the winds blew and beat on that house; and it did not fall, for it was founded on the rock.

The evidence of submitting to the Lordship of Christ is obedience.

D. Continually <u>sanctify-consecrate</u> ourselves.
 (3) Always <u>yield</u> to the <u>Holy Spirit</u>.

(A) In Daily Living Galatians 5:16, 18, 25 (NIV) 16 So I say, walk by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the flesh 18 But if you are led by the Spirit, you are not under the law. 25 Since we live by the Spirit, let us keep in step with the Spirit.

D. Continually <u>sanctify-consecrate</u> ourselves. (3) Always <u>yield</u> to the <u>Holy Spirit</u>.

(B) In Worship John 4:23-24 23 But the hour is coming, and now is, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth; for the Father is seeking such to worship Him. 24 God is Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth."

D. Continually <u>sanctify-consecrate</u> ourselves. (3) Always <u>yield</u> to the <u>Holy Spirit</u>.

Like a tea bag being immersed in the hot water (C) In Prayer Jude 1:20 But you, beloved, building yourselves up on your most holy faith, praying in the Holy Spirit. Eph 6:18

Hebrews 12:14 Pursue peace with all people, and holiness, without which no one will see the Lord.

Matthew 3:11-12

11 I indeed baptize you with water unto repentance, but He who is coming after me is mightier than I, whose sandals I am not worthy to carry. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire. 12 His winnowing fan is in His hand, and He will thoroughly clean out His threshing floor, and gather His wheat (precious) into the barn; but He will burn up the chaff (worthless) with unquenchable fire." Malachi 3:3 vs Heb 12:29
