




The Young Church at Colossae

Colossians 2:1-2 (NIV)

1 I want you to know how hard I am contending for you and for those at Laodicea, and for all who have not met me personally. 2 My goal is that they may be encouraged in heart and united in love, so that they may have the full riches of complete understanding, in order that they may know the mystery of God, namely, Christ.








The syncretistic mix in Colossae included:

- religious and rabbinical traditions (Colossians 2:8)
- circumcision (Colossians 2:11)
- dietary considerations (Colossians 2:16)
- sabbatical and festival observations (Colossians 2:16)
- the worship of angels (Colossians 2:18)
- false humility (Colossians 2:22)
- ascetic practices and sacrifices (Colossians 2:23)

The Colossian heresy:

- A. detracts from the person, authority and work of Christ
- B. calls for human works supported by human philosophy and the traditions
- C. affirms Jewish elements
- D. boasts a mix of mystery, secrecy and superiority limited to a privileged few, i.e. the gnostics




The heresy did not deny Christ, it dethroned Him

Christ is Supreme

Colossians 1:15-18


15 He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn over all creation. 16 For by Him all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers. All things were created through Him and for Him. 17 And He is before all things, and in Him all things consist. 18 And He is the head of the body, the church, who is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead, that in all things He may have the pre-eminence.







Colossians 1:27 To them God willed to make known what are the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles: which is Christ in you, the hope of glory.



The key to full riches of wisdom and knowledge - to live in Christ.

Colossians 2:6-7

6 As you therefore have received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk in Him, 7 rooted and built up in Him and established in the faith, as you have been taught, abounding in it with thanksgiving.

3 Images of living in Christ Colossians 2:7

- 1. Rooted in Him
- 2. Built up in Him
- 3. Strengthened (established) in the Faith

Overflowing with thanksgiving








2. Built up in Him
