- Do not entertain fear of the virus
- Gather by faith
- Do not get stuck with the comfort of staying at home
- Discipleship issue
- It takes discipline to dress up, transport, stand to worship with fellow believers in person
- We need to take up the good habit of regular church-going

  - ✓ a **call** by your spiritual leader to do so


**Exempted** from In-Person gathering for now:

# Mark 3:14-15

4. Have power to cast out demons

I. In the NT, every believer is a priest & king.

Revelation 1:5-6 Jesus made us kings and priests to Father-God.

1 Peter 2:9 We are a royal priesthood.

Revelation 5:10 Jesus made us  
kings and priests to reign  
on the earth.





- I. In the NT, every believer is a priest & king.
  1. To live and minister as a priest & king, the disciple must develop his relationship with God.
  2. Relationship takes intentionality, time, effort, energy, resources to build.

1. The disciple as a priest minister to God.

John 4:23-24

23 But the hour is coming, and now is, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth; for the Father is seeking such to worship Him.

24 God is Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth.

II. WHAT does it mean for a disciple to be a Priest?

# As Kings - We speak to the mountain!

Mark 11:12-14, 20

**12** Now the next day, when they had come out from Bethany, He was hungry. **13** And seeing from afar a fig tree having leaves, He went to see if perhaps He would find something on it.

When He came to it, He found nothing but leaves, for it was not the season for figs. **14** In response Jesus said to it, "Let no one eat fruit from you ever again." And His disciples heard it.

**20** Now in the morning, as they passed by, they saw the fig tree dried up from the roots.



# As Kings - We speak to the mountain!

Mark 11:22-24

22 So Jesus answered and said to them, “Have faith in God (the faith of God) 23 For assuredly, I say to you, whoever says to this mountain, ‘Be removed and be cast into the sea,’ and does not doubt in his heart, but believes that those things he says will be done, he will have whatever he says. 24 Therefore I say to you, whatever things you ask when you pray, believe that you receive them, and you will have them.





## Background to Mark 11

- Last week of earthly ministry of Christ.
- Daily Jesus & Disciples walked from Bethany to Jerusalem.
- Over Mount of Olives and down the trail towards Jerusalem.
- In Jerusalem for the day & back to Bethany for the night.
- One day, on route, Jesus was looking for figs to eat.

## Background to Mark 11

- There was none on that tree but leaves.

- The disciples heard it.
- The next day, disciples saw the fig tree dried up from roots.





**Important to always know context:**

We cannot speak to the physical mountain to be removed!

This is about a Lesson on Prayer of Faith  
by Speaking to the Mountain-Problems of our lives!

E. There will be consequences when we violate the boundaries of our authority and power.

## 2 Peter 2:10-11

**10** and especially those who walk according to the flesh in the lust of uncleanness and despise authority. They are presumptuous, self-willed. They are not afraid to speak evil of dignitaries,

**11** whereas angels, who are greater in power and might, do not bring a reviling accusation against them before the Lord.

E. There will be consequences when we violate the boundaries of our authority and power.

**v11** put on **WHOLE** armor to stand against the wiles of the devil.

The **HOW** is in other portions of scripture. **2 Tim 3:16**-whole counsel.

**Luke 9:1-2 = Mark 3:14-15**

**1** Then He called His twelve disciples together and gave them power and authority over all demons, and to cure diseases.

**2** He sent them to preach the kingdom of God and to heal the sick.

Mark 16:15, 17-18

15 ... Go into all the world and preach the Gospel to every creature. 17 And these signs will follow those who believe: In My name they will cast out demons; 18 ... they will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover.

**Context:** Evangelism - Sharing the Gospel



2. Do not always talk about your mountain.

- The more you talk about your mountain, the bigger it gets.
- You may turn a mole-hill into a mountain.
- If you don't speak to your mountain, it will speak to you.



2. Do not always talk about your mountain.

- It will taunt you:

Your marriage  
will fail

You will never  
kick that habit!

2. Do not always talk about your mountain.

EG: **1 Samuel 17** - The armies of Israel and Goliath

- Goliath insulted and taunted the armies of Israel.
- Goliath mocked the God of Israel.
- The armies of Israel were too fearful, they did not speak to Goliath. They all spoke about Goliath.
- The more they talked about the size of the giant, the more impossible he seemed to beat.



3. In prayer, by faith, ask God directly-specifically for the grace you need for the *problem-mountain*.

Hebrews 4:16 Let us therefore come boldly to the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need.

Luke 11:9 So I say to you, ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you.

10 For everyone who asks receives, and he who seeks finds, and to him who knocks it will be opened.



3. In prayer, by faith, ask God directly-specifically for the grace you need for the *problem-mountain*.

Focus on God's Power and not the size of the mountain.

EG: **1 Samuel 17** - David vs Goliath

- David was not focusing on the size of the mountain
- He was focusing on the size of his God

3. In prayer, by faith, ask God directly-specifically for the grace you need for the *problem-mountain*.

Other soldiers said	David said
“Look how much bigger Goliath is than me”	“How much smaller he is than God”
“Goliath is too big to fight”	“He is too big to miss”
“Complaining to God, the size of Goliath”	“Telling your Goliath the size of your God”




4. You exercise your authority and power over the mountain by speaking to it.

**Proverbs 18:21** Death and life are in the power of the tongue, and those who love it will eat its fruit.

With your Will+word+faith-command

**God will not do for you what He has already:**

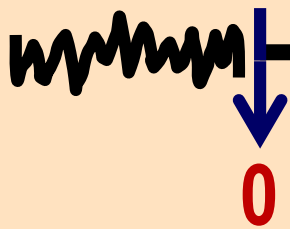
- Done! Finished at the Cross! **2 Corinthians 1:20**

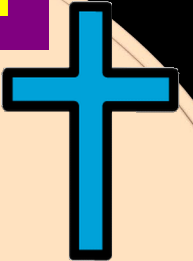

## Application #2 - Resist the devil

## Application #3 - Rebuke sickness and diseases

no more hold over this body! This body  
is now cleansed and covered by the blood

## Application #4 - Take authority over the environment of our situations

In Jesus name, every unclean spirit in this hotel room, get out of here! This room is cleansed and covered by the Blood of the Lamb! Lord, we ask for Your peace, wisdom, favour and Your very Presence to be with us in our stay here these 5 days!

In Jesus' name!

5. As you speak to the mountain, do not doubt in your heart.

**Mark 11:23** I say to you .. Whatsoever you shall say to this mountain: Be removed and be cast to the sea; and shall not doubt in your heart, but believe that those things you say shall come to pass; you shall have (receive) whatsoever you say.

Pray - Say - Believe - Receive (time-factor-Mountains)



# Our Belief System

**27** When she heard (1) about Jesus, she came behind Him in the crowd and touched (3) His garment. **28** For she said, (2) “If only I may touch His clothes, I shall be made well.”

**29** Immediately the fountain of her blood was dried up, and she felt in her body that she was healed (4) of the affliction.
