

TIMELINE FOR ABRAM (ABRAHAM) from the promise given at age 70 (Gen. 12:1-4) until JACOB ARRIVES IN EGYPT - 220 YEARS



Promised was made in Gen 12 when Abraham was 75yrs. Abraham was 100 when Isaac was born.




