
1. Know that God has a **plan** for your life.


2. It is up to <u>me</u> to discover, know and obey God's Plan-Will (Thelema) for my life.





 - Live by the Spirit


B. From the Holy Spirit of Wisdom.

The details of the guidance.

The <u>inward witness</u> [Romans 8:16] of the Spirit of Wisdom dwelling in the believer guides us in the <u>following</u> <u>ways</u>:



(1) The Holy Spirit directs us to **people** in our lives.







Hebrews 10:19 Therefore, brethren, having boldness to enter the Holiest by the blood of Jesus ...




- 1. When we draw near to God, we eliminate the evil one by:

James 4:6-7



2. What is left then is between the Lord and us.






Decision-Making Process



Decision-Making - Like two halves of a magnet:




Decision-Making Process - 2 Keys Conditions:

A. Proverbs 3:5-6

5 Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and lean not on your own understanding; 6 in all your ways acknowledge Him, and He shall direct your paths.

B. Romans 14:23

But he who doubts is condemned if he eats, because he does not eat from faith; for whatever is not from faith is sin.




A. God desires to always guide and lead you.

1. Live our lives in total dependence on God.




2. Ask for God's intervention in relating to people and in our situations.
