#### **2 Corinthians 12:7-10**

7 And lest I should be exalted above measure by the abundance of the revelations, a thorn in the flesh was given to me, a messenger of Satan to buffet me, lest I be exalted above measure. 8 Concerning this thing I pleaded with the Lord three times that it might depart from me. 9 And He said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for My strength is made perfect in weakness." Therefore most gladly I will rather boast in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me. 10 Therefore I take pleasure in infirmities, in reproaches, in needs, in persecutions, in distresses, for Christ's sake. For when I am weak, then I am strong.

## v7: A Thorn in the flesh was given to me

- "Thorn" from a Greek Word: "Skolops" meaning a pointed piece of wood, a pale, a stake
- Impalement
- An Agony
- A stake driven into the flesh
- This thorn was a messenger of Satan

### **v8:** I pleaded with the Lord three times

### "Pleaded" from:

- Greek Word "Parakaleo"
- Related Word "Paraclete"
- One who entreats or intercedes a description of the Holy Spirit

v9: My Grace is sufficient for you
"Grace" from Greek Word "Charis"

- Samson's final victory
- The Salvation of the thief on the Cross




