
#### **CLARIFYING TERMS**

## A) GOD DEALS WITH 3 GROUPS OF PEOPLE SEPARATELY

1 Cor 10:32 (NLT) "Don't give offence to Jews or Gentiles or the church of God."

The whole of mankind is divided into 3 groups:

- 1. Gentiles. From Adam to Abraham.
- 2. Israel/Jews. From Abraham, Isaac, Jacob onwards. God made a specific covenant with the Jews.
- 3. The Church. Created after Jesus died and ascended to heaven. From that point, everyone, Jew or Gentile, who believes and receives the Lord Jesus in the window of grace is part of the Church (Gal 3:26-28)



All scripture is profitable for us, but not every scripture/covenant is written for the Church. Applying a scripture to the Church when meant for Israel or vice versa leads to confusion and misunderstanding of the prophetic word.

### B) THE DAY OF CHRIST VS THE DAY OF THE LORD

The Day of Christ = Pre-Tribulation Rapture (Phil 1:10)

The Day of the LORD (Yahweh/Jehovah/I AM) is a series of events encompassing:

- Rapture
- Tribulation
- Christ's Second Coming
- Millennial Kingdom
- Great White Throne Judgement
- New Heavens & Earth
