2. End-times Prophecies will <u>NOT</u> be fully understood until the Time of the End!

Daniel 12:4, 8-9

4 "But you, Daniel, shut up the words, and <u>seal the book until the time of the end</u>; many shall run to and fro, and knowledge shall increase."
8 Although I heard, <u>I did not understand</u>. Then I said, "My lord, what shall be the end of these things?" 9 And he said, "Go your way, Daniel, for <u>the words are closed up and sealed till the time of the end</u>.

2. End-times Prophecies will <u>NOT</u> be fully understood until the Time of the End!

Jeremiah 23:20 The anger of the Lord will not turn back until He has executed and performed the thoughts of His heart. In the latter days you will understand it perfectly.

Jeremiah 30:24 The fierce anger of the Lord will not return until He has done it, and until He has performed the intents of His heart. In the latter days you will consider it.

2. End-times Prophecies will <u>NOT</u> be fully understood until the Time of the End!

Ezekiel 38:8, 16 (This battle is yet future)

8 <u>After many days</u> you will be visited. In the <u>latter years</u> you will come into the land of those brought back from the sword and gathered from many people on the mountains of Israel, which had long been desolate; they were brought out of the nations, and now all of them dwell safely.

16 You will come up against My people Israel like a cloud, to cover the land. It will be in the <u>latter days</u> that I will bring you against My land, so that the nations may know Me, when I am hallowed in you, O Gog, before their eyes."

3. Revelation of the Time of the End will come to those who <u>study</u> the Prophetic Scriptures and <u>seek</u> the Lord accordingly.

2 Timothy 2:15 (KJV) <u>Study</u> to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, <u>rightly dividing the word of truth</u>.

Ezra 7:10

 Revelation of the Time of the End will come to those who <u>study</u> the Prophetic Scriptures and <u>seek</u> the Lord accordingly.

Deuteronomy 29:29 The <u>secret things belong to the Lord our God</u>, but <u>those things which are revealed belong to us and to our children</u> <u>forever</u>, that we may do all the words of this law.

1 Corinthians 2:9 But as it is written: "Eye has not seen, nor ear heard, nor have entered into the heart of man <u>the things which God has prepared</u> <u>for those who love Him</u>."

 Growing apostasy, lies and deceptions.
 Nations against nations.
 ✓ on horizon will be the Psalm 83 and Ezekiel 38-39 Wars.
 Natural calamities EQs, extreme weather.
 - The longing for the Rapture.

- **COVID-19** pre-cursor of plagues 6th Trumpet J of Rev 9 (1/3)
 - ✓ exponentially worse
- Peace Treaties with Israel Abrahamic Accords
 - pre-cursor of ultimate AC Treaty with Israel and many nations
- <u>Digital Currencies</u> Cryptocurrencies, BitCoins, etc.
 - ✓ pre-cursor to the mark of the beast

II. The current times of increasing lawlessness is an indication of the <u>wrath of God</u>.

Romans 1:18 For <u>the wrath of God</u> is revealed from heaven against all <u>ungodliness and unrighteousness</u> <u>of men</u>, who suppress the truth in unrighteousness.



1. God has placed <u>4 restraints</u> in society: A. Man himself \rightarrow <u>Conscience</u>

Romans 2:15 who show the work of <u>the law written in their hearts</u>, their <u>conscience also bearing witness</u>, and between themselves their thoughts accusing or else excusing them).



God has placed <u>4 restraints</u> in society:
 B. Family → <u>Rod</u>

Proverbs 13:24 He who spares his rod hates his son, but he who loves him disciplines him promptly. 1. God has placed <u>4 restraints</u> in society: **C.** Government \rightarrow <u>Sword</u>

Romans 13:4 For he is God's minister to you for good. But if you do evil, be afraid; for he does not bear the <u>sword</u> in vain; for he is God's minister, an avenger to execute wrath on him who practices evil.

1. God has placed <u>4 restraints</u> in society: D. Church \rightarrow The <u>Truth - Salt & Light</u>

Matthew 5:13-16

13 You are the salt of the earth ...

14 You are the light of the world ...

15 Nor do they light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on a lampstand, and it **gives light to all who are in the house**.

16 <u>Let your light so shine before men</u>, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven.



The restraints are increasingly being <u>destroyed</u> by:
 A. Sexual revolution

Romans 1:24, 26-27

24 Therefore God also gave them up to <u>uncleanness</u>, in the <u>lusts of</u> <u>their hearts</u>, to <u>dishonour their bodies among themselves</u>:
26 For this reason God gave them up to <u>vile passions</u>. For even their <u>women exchanged the natural use for what is against nature</u>.
27 Likewise also the <u>men</u>, leaving the natural use of the woman, burned in their lust for one another, <u>men with men</u> committing what is shameful, and receiving in themselves the penalty of their error which was due.

- 2. The restraints are increasingly being destroyed by:
 - B. Increasing separation and divorces;
 break up of families; confusion over gender
 - C. Riots and violence; lawlessness

The restraints are increasingly being <u>destroyed</u> by:
 D. Culture in the world.

Romans 1:28 (NKJV) And even as they did not like to retain God in their knowledge, God gave them over to a <u>debased mind (reprobate mind)</u>, to do those things which are not fitting.

Romans 1:28 (AMP) And since they did not see fit to acknowledge God or consider Him worth knowing [as their Creator], God gave them over to a <u>depraved mind</u>, to do things which are improper and repulsive,

3. Consequently, the End-Time Church is a type of the Laodicean Church.

Revelation 3:15-17

15 "I know your works, that you are <u>neither cold nor hot</u>. I could wish you were cold or hot. **16** So then, because you are <u>lukewarm</u>, and <u>neither cold nor hot</u>, I will vomit you out of My mouth. **17** <u>Because you say</u>, 'I am rich, have become wealthy, and have need of nothing'—and <u>do not know that</u> <u>you are wretched</u>, <u>miserable</u>, <u>poor</u>, <u>blind</u>, <u>and naked</u>— 3. Consequently, the End-Time Church is a type of the Laodicean Church.
2 Thessalonians 2:3 Let no one deceive you by any means; for <u>that Day (Rapture) will not come unless the falling away comes first</u>, and the <u>man of sin (anti-Christ)</u> is revealed, the son of perdition.

3. Consequently, the End-Time Church is a type of the Laodicean Church.

Matthew 24:12 And because <u>lawlessness</u> will <u>abound</u>, the <u>love (agape) of many (believers)</u> will grow cold.

1 Timothy 4:1 Now the Spirit expressly says that in latter times some (believers) will depart from the faith, giving heed to deceiving spirits and doctrines of demons.

Titus 2:13 looking for the **blessed hope and glorious appearing** of our great God and Saviour Jesus Christ.



1. This blessed hope is the **<u>rapture</u>** which is imminent.

Philippians 3:20 For our citizenship is in heaven, from which we also <u>eagerly</u> wait for the Saviour, the Lord Jesus Christ.

1 Thessalonians 1:10 and <u>to wait for His Son from heaven</u>, whom He raised from the dead, even Jesus who delivers us from the wrath to come.

2 Timothy 4:8 Finally, there is laid up for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous Judge, will give to me on that Day, and not to me only but also to all who have loved His appearing.

2. We are told to <u>comfort</u> one another with the imminent rapture.

1 Thessalonians 4:18 Therefore <u>comfort one another</u> with these words.

1 Thessalonians 4:16-17

16 For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of an archangel, and with the trumpet of God. And the <u>dead in</u> Christ will rise first. 17 Then we who are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. And thus we shall always be with the Lord.

3. In the meanwhile, we are to live:

A. Soberly B. Righteously C. Godly

Titus 2:11-13

11 For the grace of God that brings salvation has appeared to all men,
12 teaching us that, <u>denying ungodliness (actions) and worldly</u>
<u>lusts (thoughts)</u>, we should <u>live soberly</u>, <u>righteously</u>, <u>and godly</u>
<u>in the present age</u>.
13 looking for the <u>blessed hope and glorious</u>
<u>appearing</u> of our great God and Saviour Jesus Christ.

3. In the meanwhile, we are to live:A. <u>Soberly</u> (not easily distracted)

1 Peter 4:7 (NKJV) But the end of all things is at hand; therefore **be serious and watchful in your prayers**.

1 Peter 4:7 (NIV) The end of all things is near. Therefore **be alert and of sober mind so that you may pray**.

1 Peter 5:8 <u>Be sober</u>, <u>be vigilant</u>; because your adversary the devil walks about like a roaring lion, seeking whom he may devour.

In the meanwhile, we are to live: A. <u>Soberly</u> (not easily distracted)

1 Thessalonians 5:6, 8

6 Therefore let us not sleep, as others do, but let us <u>watch</u> and be <u>sober</u>.
8 But let us who are of the day be <u>sober</u>, putting on the <u>breastplate of faith and love</u>, and as a <u>helmet the hope of salvation</u>.

3. In the meanwhile, we are to live:B. <u>Righteously</u> (not unrighteous)

1 Timothy 6:11 But you, O man of God, flee these things and <u>pursue</u> <u>righteousness</u>, godliness, faith, love, patience, gentleness.

2 Timothy 3:16 <u>All Scripture</u> is given by inspiration of God, and is <u>profitable</u> for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, <u>for instruction in righteousness</u>.

In the meanwhile, we are to live:
 C. <u>Godly</u> (not worldly)

2 Peter 1:6-7
6 to <u>knowledge</u> self-control, to <u>self-control</u> perseverance, to <u>perseverance **godliness**</u>, 7 to godliness brotherly kindness, and to <u>brotherly kindness love</u>.

1 Timothy 6:6 Now godliness with contentment is great gain. **4.** How to keep on living soberly, righteously and godly?

Applications:

- A. Establish daily disciplines with God:
 - (1) Discipline of continual **Prayer**.
 - (2) Discipline of <u>Word</u> intake.
 - (3) Discipline of building <u>Altar of T</u>, <u>P&W</u>.



Applications:

- A. Establish daily disciplines with God:
 - (4) Discipline of <u>Thought Life</u> (2 Corinthians 10:5; Philippians 4:8).
 - (5) Discipline of <u>Healthy Emotions</u> (Ephesians 5:9).
 - (6) Discipline of <u>Seeking Wisdom from Above</u>, <u>Reading and</u> <u>Godly Counsel/Mentors</u>.

Daily - Regular Disciplines in all these areas build Strength, Capacity, Resiliency and Maturity.

Applications:

- **B.** Be fully connected to the Holy Spirit.
 - Worship in the Spirit
 - Pray in the Spirit
 - Revelation from the Holy Spirit
 - Walk with the Holy Spirit
 - Be led by the Holy Spirit
 - Keep in step with the Holy Spirit
 - Live by the Spirit

Applications:

C. Enthusiastically <u>serving</u> the Lord.

HOW?

- remember your <u>calling</u> (2 Timothy 1:9; Psalm 139:16)
- know there is a day of <u>accountability</u> (2 Corinthians 5:10-11)
- daily build <u>disciplines</u> about your work and ministry
- grow relationships with bosses and mentors
- find ways to inject <u>fun and joy</u>, satisfaction and pleasantness in your work and ministry
- consciously know <u>the Lord</u> is with you always and knows all things (Matthew 28:20; Hebrews 4:13)

Applications:

C. Enthusiastically <u>serving</u> the Lord.

1 Corinthians 15:58 Therefore, my beloved brethren, be <u>steadfast</u>, <u>immovable</u>, <u>always abounding in the work of the Lord</u>, <u>knowing</u> <u>that your labour is not in vain in the Lord</u>.

Hebrews 6:10 For God is not unjust to forget your work and labour of <u>love</u> which you have shown toward His name, in <u>that you have ministered</u> to the saints, and <u>do minister</u>.

Bottom-line

Titus 2:12-13

12 Teaching us that, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should <u>live soberly</u>, <u>righteously</u>, and godly in the present age, 13 <u>looking for</u> <u>the blessed hope</u> (not the AC, mark of B, etc.) and glorious appearing of our great God and Savior Jesus Christ.
