


The difference between:



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I. The Prophecy of Daniel's 70th Week

Daniel's 70th week is the last one week of years of God's dealings with Israel.

It will be the 7 years of Tribulation, when God's wrath is poured on the un-believing God-rejecting Israel and the world.



Daniel 9:24-26

24 Seventy weeks are determined for your people (Israel) and for your holy city (Jerusalem), to finish the transgression, to make an end of sins, to make reconciliation for iniquity, to bring in everlasting righteousness, to seal up vision and prophecy, and to anoint the Most Holy. **25** Know therefore and understand, that from the going forth of the command to restore and build Jerusalem until **Messiah the Prince (the Lord Jesus)**, there shall be **seven weeks and sixty-two weeks**; the street shall be built again, and the wall, even in troublesome times. **26** And **after the sixty-two weeks** Messiah shall be cut off, but not for Himself; and the **people of the prince who is to come (Romans-AC)** shall destroy the city and the sanctuary. The end of it shall be with a flood, and till the end of the war desolations are determined.

(a) Crucifixion and death of the Lord Jesus

(c) Age marked with wars and desolation.



26 And after the sixty-two weeks Messiah (Lord JC) shall be cut off, but not for Himself; and the people of the prince (Romans) who is to come shall destroy the city and the sanctuary. The end of it shall be with a flood, and till the end of the war desolations are determined.

24 Seventy weeks are determined for your people (Israel) and for your holy city (Jerusalem), to finish the transgression, to make an end of sins, to make reconciliation for iniquity, to bring in everlasting righteousness, to seal up vision and prophecy, and to anoint the Most Holy.

The Lord Jesus Christ came, at the end of the 69 weeks, **(7+62 weeks)** as the Messiah for Israel to fulfill **Daniel 9:24** for Israel but He was rejected and **Daniel 9:24** is NOT fulfilled!

Hence, none of the prophecies mentioned in Daniel 9:24 has occurred for Israel.

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II. Why the “**suspension**” of Daniel’s 70th Week?

Because Israel rejected Jesus as their Messiah.

- Israel has been looking for a “**political messiah**” as in the time of Jesus to rid them of the Roman occupation.
- Today, same - to give them “**peace and security**” in own land from enemies.
- Looking for the “**messiah**” to do so and will be deceived by the Anti-Christ.
- They have never believed up to now that they needed a “**spiritual messiah**” to save them from their sins as they have the law of Moses, even though we know that the law kills, and no one is able to keep the law perfectly.
- Jesus was the only Man-God on earth Who ever did!
- Israel wants a “**warrior**” king, not the suffering-Servant Who came and died for the sins of the world.

Because Israel rejected Jesus as their Messiah.

- Israel earlier rejected John the Baptist sent by Father-God.
- Israel then rejected and crucified the Lord Jesus.
- 3 days later, He rose again fulfilling the sign of Jonah to prove His authenticity as the Son of God (Matthew 12:39-40).
- Israel had 40 days after Jesus' resurrection to recognize the sign of His resurrection and to receive Him as their Messiah which they did not.
- He ascended to heaven fulfilling another prophecy.
- Hosea 5:15 - Then I will go back to my place until they admit their guilt. And they will seek my face; in their misery they will earnestly seek me.

Because Israel rejected Jesus as their Messiah.

- Stephen filled with the Holy Spirit in the early Church addressed the Jewish Council in Acts 6-7, tracing God's Covenant with Abraham, Moses and David.
- But they rejected Stephen's message from God.
- This was the last straw. God's dealings with Israel is now "**suspended**".
- The KOG began with Israel - Exodus 19:5-6.
- Because of their disobedience and rejection of the revelation of God, the KOG was taken from Israel and given to the Church.

Matthew 21:43 Therefore I say to you, the kingdom of God will be taken from you and given to a nation (the Church) bearing the fruits of it.

Because Israel rejected Jesus as their Messiah.

- God then revealed the Gospel of Grace to Paul for all mankind in church age.
- This is understood clearly by the Council of the Church in Jerusalem in Acts 15.
- After Church is raptured, the Kingdom will be restored to Israel. Acts 15:13-18 i.e. the Lord will first take from among the Gentiles a people (the Church) for Himself and after that, would return to rebuild David's fallen tabernacle.

This is called "**prophetic compression**" where time gap between prophecy in one verse is separated by time but the time is not revealed.

EG#1: Zechariah 9:9 - Messiah entering Jerusalem on a donkey (1st coming) while in 9:10, He is ruling over the nations (2nd Coming).

EG#2: Isaiah 9:6 a child is born, a son is given (1st Coming) while in 9:7 He is ruling on David's throne over the nations (2nd Coming).

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III. Daniel's 70th Week has NO relevance to the Church

Daniel 9:24 Seventy weeks are determined for your people (Israel) and for your holy city (Jerusalem), to finish the transgression, to make an end of sins, to make reconciliation for iniquity, to bring in everlasting righteousness, to seal up vision and prophecy, and to anoint the Most Holy.

The time of Jacob's trouble has completely no relevance to the Church for the following reasons:

1. To finish the transgression:

for the **Church**

- Christ said that is already finished.

John 1:29 .. John saw Jesus coming toward him, and said, "Behold! The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!"

John 19:30 So when Jesus had received the sour wine, He said, "It is finished!" And bowing His head, He gave up His spirit.

for **Israel**

- To bring Israel's disobedience to the Old Covenant to an end.

The time of Jacob's trouble has completely no relevance to the Church for the following reasons:

2. To make an end of sins:


for the **Church**

- Christ was already made sin for us.

2 Corinthians 5:21 For He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.

for **Israel**

- To put an end to all sin in Israel as the remnant righteous of the Jews enter the Millennial Kingdom.



The time of Jacob's trouble has completely no relevance to the Church for the following reasons:

3. To make reconciliation for iniquity/atonement:

for the **Church**

- We are already reconciled to God.

2 Corinthians 5:18 Now all things are of God, who has reconciled us to Himself through Jesus Christ, and has given us the ministry of reconciliation.

for **Israel**

- Israel will recognise and receive Jesus as their Messiah under the terms of the Old Covenant as He reigns over them in the Millennial Kingdom.



The time of Jacob's trouble has completely no relevance to the Church for the following reasons:

4. To bring in everlasting righteousness:

for the **Church**

- We already possess God's righteousness.

Romans 3:21-22

21 But now the righteousness of God apart from the law is revealed, being witnessed by the Law and the Prophets, **22** even the righteousness of God, through faith in Jesus Christ, to all and on all who believe. For there is no difference.

for **Israel**

- To usher in the Millennial Messianic Kingdom on earth where Jesus the Righteous One (Jehovah Tsidkenu) will rule.

The time of Jacob's trouble has completely no relevance to the Church for the following reasons:

5. To seal up the vision and prophecy:

for the **Church**

- We are already sealed with the Holy Spirit, the Source of vision & prophecy.

Ephesians 1:13 .. having believed, you were sealed with the Holy Spirit of promise.

Ephesians 4:30 .. by whom you were sealed for the day of redemption.

for **Israel**

- The fulfilment of all prophecies for Israel
and to bring all revelation by granting
a full knowledge of God.

Hebrews 8:6-13 .. For all shall know Me

6. To anoint the Most Holy

for the **Church**

- We are already **anointed**.

1 John 2:27 But the anointing which you have received from Him abides in you, and you do not need that anyone teach you; but as the same anointing teaches you concerning all things, and is true, and is not a lie, and just as it has taught you, you will abide in Him.

for **Israel**

- To set up the Millennial Kingdom temple where Christ Jesus, the Most Holy will reside.

Matthew 21:43 Therefore I say to you, the kingdom of God will be taken from you (Israel) and given to a nation (the Church) bearing the fruits of it.






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V. Summary Overview of Daniel's 70th Week



1. Daniel's 70th week begins when the anti-Christ confirms a Covenant between Israel and many nations for 1 week of years.

Daniel 9:27 Then he (anti-Christ) shall confirm a covenant with many for one week (7 years); but in the middle of the week he shall bring an end to sacrifice and offering. And on the wing of abominations shall be one who makes desolate, even until the consummation, which is determined, is poured out on the desolate.



2. Before the start of Daniel's 70th week, the Battle of Gog & Magog of Ezekiel 38-39 will happen, resulting in the appearing of the anti-Christ (AC) to broker the Peace Covenant between Israel and the nations.

The Ezekiel 38-39 War is led by Russia, Turkey and Iran plus various nations against Israel.

With God's intervention, Israel will emerge victorious.

The Jews will follow the AC thinking he is their promised **Messiah**

3. The anti-Christ is fully revealed after the Church is raptured.

2 Thessalonians 2:3 Let no one deceive you by any means; for that Day (Rapture) will not come unless the falling away comes first, and the man of sin is revealed, the son of perdition, (the anti-Christ).

2 Thessalonians 2:6-7

6 And now you know what is restraining, that he (the anti-Christ) may be revealed in his own time. 7 For the mystery of lawlessness is already at work; only he (the Church) who now restrains will do so until he (the Church) is taken out of the way.

3. The anti-Christ is fully revealed after the Church is raptured.

2 Thessalonians 2:6-7

6 And now you know what is restraining, that he may be revealed in his own time. **7** For the mystery of lawlessness is already at work; only he who now restrains will do so until he is taken out of the way (raptured).


Q: What is preventing the anti-Christ from being fully revealed?
(2 Thessalonians 2:7)

**A: the CHURCH of born again, blood-bought believers
indwelt by the Holy Spirit!**

4. In mid-Tribulation, the anti-Christ commits the abomination of desolation

Daniel 9:27 Then he shall confirm a covenant with many for one week; but **in the middle of the week** he shall bring an end to sacrifice and offering. And on the wing of abominations shall be one who makes desolate, even until the consummation, which is determined, is poured out on the desolate.

Matthew 24:15 Therefore when you see the 'abomination of desolation', spoken of by Daniel the prophet, standing in the holy place" (whoever reads, let him understand).



4. In mid-Tribulation, the anti-Christ commits the abomination of desolation

2 Thessalonians 2:4 who (anti-Christ) opposes and exalts himself above all that is called God or that is worshiped, so that he sits as God in the temple of God, showing himself that he is God.

Daniel 11:37 He shall regard neither the God of his fathers nor the desire of women, nor regard any god; for he shall exalt himself above them all.

Sodom & Egypt - Rev 11:8



5. In the final 3-1/2 years, all remaining on earth has **2 choices** to make:
- A. either take the Mark of the Beast to live through the tribulation but incur the wrath of God to end up in the Lake of Fire;

OR

- B. become a Tribulation (Tn) Saint and be martyred.

--- **CONTRAST** ---

Church → Matthew 16:18 → overcomers of gates of hell

Tn Saints (not church) → Revelation 13:7 → religious beast overcome them

Revelation 14:9-11

9 Then a third angel followed them, saying with a loud voice, “If anyone worships the beast and his image, and receives his mark on his forehead or on his hand,

10 he himself shall also drink of the wine of the wrath of God, which is poured out full strength into the cup of His indignation. He shall be tormented with fire and brimstone in the presence of the holy angels and in the presence of the Lamb.

11 And the smoke of their torment ascends forever and ever; and they have no rest day or night, who worship the beast and his image, and whoever receives the mark of his name.”

Revelation 20:4 And I saw thrones, and they sat on them, and judgment was committed to them. 6. At the end of the 7 Tribulation Years, the anti-Christ will be destroyed at the Battle of Armageddon at the 2nd Coming of the Lord Jesus.

2 Thessalonians 2:8 And then the lawless one will be revealed, whom the Lord will consume with the breath of His mouth and destroy with the brightness of His coming.

7. Throughout the 7 Tribulation Years, the Gospel is continuously preached:

B. In the last 3-½ years by the **2 angels with the everlasting Gospel.**
