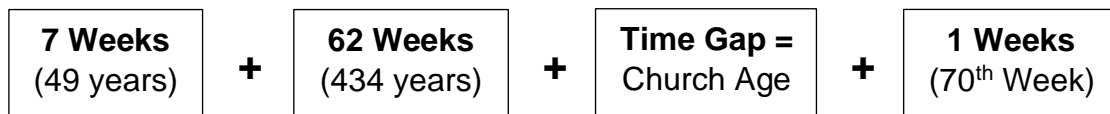

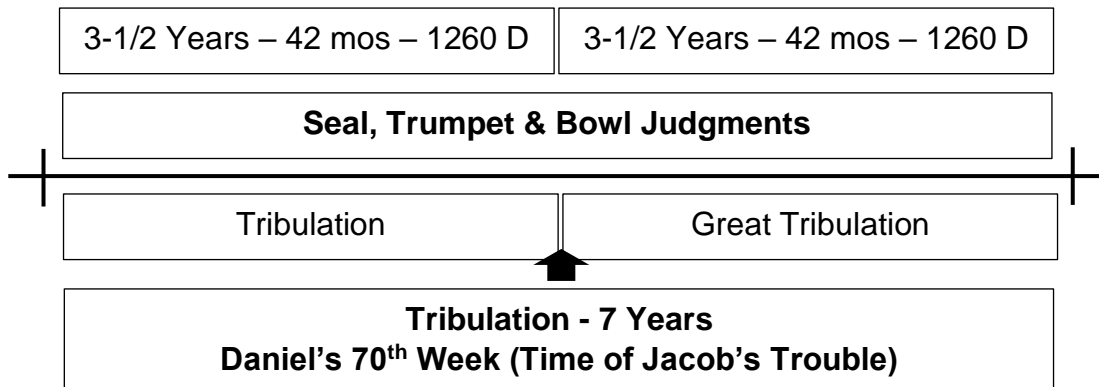

V. Summary Overview of Daniel's 70th Week

1. Daniel's 70th week _____ when the anti-Christ confirms a Covenant between Israel and many nations for 1 week of years. Daniel 9:27
2. Before the start of Daniel's 70th week, the Battle of Gog & Magog of Ezekiel 38-39 will happen, resulting in the appearing of the anti-Christ (AC) to broker the Peace Covenant between Israel and the nations.
3. The anti-Christ is fully revealed _____ the Church is raptured.
2 Thessalonians 2:3, 6-7
4. In mid-Tribulation, the anti-Christ commits the abomination of desolation.
Daniel 9:27; Mathew 24:15; 2 Thessalonians 2:4
5. In the final 3-1/2 years, all remaining on earth has **2 choices** to make:
 - A. Either take the Mark of the Beast to live through the tribulation but incur the wrath of God to end up in the Lake of Fire;
 - OR**
 - B. Become a Tribulation Saint and be martyred.

6. At the end of the 7 Tribulation Years, the anti-Christ will be destroyed at the Battle of Armageddon at the 2nd Coming of the Lord Jesus. 2 Thessalonians 2:8
7. Throughout the 7 Tribulation Years, the Gospel is continuously preached:
 - A. In the first 3-1/2 years by the 144K Evangelists and the 2 Witnesses.
This will climax with their respective raptures. Revelation 7:9, 14
 - B. In the last 3-1/2 years by the 2 angels with the everlasting Gospel.
