What is depression?

Medical Definition

- It is a Bio-Chemical Disorder; 35% Genetic & 65% Environmental factors.
- It is a "common cold" of mental health problem.

Diagnostic Criteria of Depression

- Low mood most times of the day (> 2 weeks)
- Decreased interest or pleasure
- Changes in Appetite & weight
- Insomnia/hypersomnia

- Agitation or motor retardation
- Fatigue or loss of energy
- Feelings of worthlessness or excessive guilt
- Decreased concentration/ indecisiveness
- Recurrent Suicidal ideas

Take those thoughts that come to you the moment you wake up in the morning. You have not originated them but they are talking to you, they bring back the problems of yesterday, etc. Somebody is talking. Who is talking to you? Your self is talking to you. Now this man's treatment [in Psalm 42] was this: instead of allowing this self to talk to him, he starts talking to himself.

"Why art thou cast down, O my soul?" he asks. His soul had been depressing him, crushing him. So he stands up and says,: "Self, listen for moment, I will speak to you." (Spiritual Depression, 20-21)

If God is for you, who can be against you? He who did not spare his own Son but gave him up for you, how will he not also with him graciously give you all things? Who shall bring any charge against you as God's elect? It is God who justifies. Who is to condemn? Christ Jesus is the one who died — more than that, who was raised — who is at the right hand of God, who indeed is interceding for you. Who shall separate you from the love of Christ? NO ONE.(Romans 8:31–35 paraphrased)

Ungodly belief – anything that is contrary to the bible

- I am always a victim.
- God will not help me.
- I am a horrible sinner.
- My enemies are nearer than God.
- There is no hope.
- No point trying....sure to fail anyway.





Casting out the depression spirit – just snap out!





If you have depression, you are spiritually weak!

Moses - Num 11: 14 I alone am not able to carry all this people, because it is too burdensome for me. 15 So if You are going to deal thus with me, please kill me at once, if I have found favor in Your sight, and do not let me see my wretchedness."

A Song in the Night

Notice the questions and complaints?

Psalmist was very REAL with God. He did not hold back his frustration (external issues) nor hide his feeling (internal issues). Because it is ok to be REAL with God!

A Song in the Night

Even when you are feeling angry!

- Good Christian never get angry?
- God expects us to get angry sometimes.
- Jesus never said "Don't get angry".
- He did say "Be angry and do not sin" (Eph 4:26)
- Why?
- Because anger is a natural response to emotional pain.
 - Anger has the potential to take us deeper in intimacy with God WHEN we bring what hurts us to God for healing.

A Song in the Night

Even when you are feeling desperate!

- When you feel that "*I am not good enough*".
- When you feel that you need HELP!
- Feeling of desperation CAN push us to our knees and <u>closer to God</u>.
- Desperation is ONLY a blessing when we allow God to exchange it with His love and plan.
- But WATCH UP FOR PRIDE ie I can handle it or I don't want God to help me.

A Song in the Night Ps 42 – 4 ways of being real with God

- 1. He asked God why? v9
- 2. He affirmed God's sovereign love.

V9 I will say to God my rock, "Why have You forgotten me? Why do I go mourning because of the oppression of the enemy?"

 - It looked & felt liked God had forgotten him.
- Why is God silent? Is He real? PTO

Theological Q	Responses
<section-header></section-header>	There are things that exist but cannot be seen ie values, thoughts, ideas.
	Category fallacy – assigning a property which applies only to an object of another category eg what is the colour of musical note. Nature of God is invisible.
	Some objects are partly visible – we do not see the 3 D objects in their entirety eg our body has parts we cannot see. YET we believe in what we do not really see.
	There are other ways of seeing ie other forms of awareness other than sensory perception eg Fear, Holy Presence.


