


Drop in percentage of those who identify as **Christians** from 77% (2009) to 65% (2019)

Large generation gap in American religion


In 2018/2019, % of U.S. adults who identify as ...




Percentage of Christians grown from 13% (1990) to 15% (2000) to 18% (2010)

Increasing trend of "no religious affiliation" among the young








