Heb 12:14 **Pursue peace** with all men, and the sanctification without which no one will see the Lord.

Pursue peace with all men, **and the sanctification** (NASB95) **Strive for peace** with everyone, **and for the holiness** (ESV) **Pursue peace** with all people, **and holiness**, (NKJV)

Why Pursue Holiness?

1. See God

Heb 12:14 Pursue peace with all men, and the sanctification (holiness) without which no one will see the Lord.

See God Matt 5: 8 "Blessed are the *pure in heart*, for they shall see God.

1 Thess 4:7 For God has not called us for the purpose of impurity, but in <u>sanctification</u>. 8 So, <u>he who rejects this</u> is not rejecting man but the God who gives His Holy Spirit to you.

2. Command of God

1 Pet 1: 14 As obedient children, do not be conformed to the former lusts which were yours in your ignorance, 15 but like the Holy One who called you, be holy yourselves also in all your behavior; 16 because it is written, **"You shall be holy, for I am holy."**

"The Bible could not be any clearer: <u>The reason</u> for your entire salvation, <u>the design</u> behind your deliverance, <u>the purpose</u> for which God chose you in the first place

is <u>holiness</u>."

What is Holiness?

Ex 3: 5 Then He said, "Do not come near here; remove your sandals from your feet, for the place on which you are standing is holy ground."

What is Holiness?

Among God's characteristics, as He has revealed himself, none is more significant than His holiness (see Lev. 11:44–45; 19:2; 20:7). "Holy" and "holiness" occur more than **900 times in Scripture**, and both the Old and New Testaments speak more about His holiness than any other attribute.

Rudolf Otto (1869 – 1937) was an Eminent German Lutheran theologian, philosopher, and comparative religionist. He is regarded as one of the most influential scholars of religion in the early twentieth century. The "holy" is manifested in a double form: as the mysterium tremendum ("mystery that repels"), in which the dreadful, fearful, and overwhelming aspect of the numinous appears, and as the mysterium fascinosum ("mystery that attracts"), by which humans are irresistibly drawn to the glory, beauty, adorable quality, and the blessing, redeeming, and salvation-bringing power of transcendence.




What is bitterness?

It is an internal, self inflicting wound that comes from responding improperly to an event or an offense.

The root of bitterness is a recognized burt that causes one "to be bitter".

Yes, gathering with the church can be inconvenient, but so is love. Relationships are messy, but so is love. Vulnerable conversations are scary, but so is love.

Yet to offer or encourage (even with good intentions) virtual church as a permanent option, <u>hurts Christian discipleship</u>. It trains Christians to think of their faith as autonomous. It teaches them they can follow Jesus as a member of the "family of God," in some abstract sense, without teaching them what it means to be a part of a family and <u>to make</u> sacrifices for a family.

In that regard, pastors should encourage people away from virtual "attendance" as much as they are able. We need to find a gentle way to remind our members that the livestream option is <u>not good for them</u>. It's <u>not good for their discipleship</u>, and it's <u>not good for their faith</u>. We want this to be clear to them, lest they become complacent and not work hard at gathering with us, if they can.
