

John 15:3 You are already clean because of the word which I have spoken to you.

Acts 20:32 So now, brethren, I commend you to God and to the word of His grace, which is able to build you up and give you an inheritance among all those who are sanctified.

John 17:17 Sanctify them by Your truth. Your word is truth.



Ephesians 5:27 that He might present her to Himself <u>a glorious</u> church, <u>not having spot or wrinkle</u> or any such thing, but that she should be holy and without blemish.

 - not having "any such thing"
 - being holy and blameless
