
Significant Signs of the Time of the End

 - ✓ pre-cursor to the mark of the beast?


Evil End-Times

Ephesians 5:15-21

15 See then that you walk circumspectly, not as fools but as wise, 16 redeeming the time, because the days are evil. 17 Therefore do not be unwise, but understand what the will of the Lord is. 18 And do not be drunk with wine, in which is dissipation; but be filled with the Spirit, 19 speaking to one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord, 20 giving thanks always for all things to God the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, 21 submitting to one another in the fear of God.

 - B. To walk in love.


Ephesians 5:2 And walk in love, as Christ also has loved us and given Himself for us, an offering and a sacrifice to God for a sweet-smelling aroma.

- 1 John 5:14 Now this is the <u>confidence</u> that we have in Him, that if we <u>ask</u> <u>anything according to His will</u>, <u>He hears us</u>. 15 And if we know that He hears us, whatever we ask, we <u>know that we have the petitions that we have asked</u> John 15:7; Jer 9:23-24

- 1 Thessalonians 1:10 and to wait for His Son from heaven, ... even Jesus who delivers us from the wrath to come.



6. To walk wisely is to be filled with the Spirit.


Romans 5:5 - Overflow with LOVE




II. Worship Whole-heartedly

Matthew 18:20 For where two or three are gathered together in My name, I am there in the midst of them.




II. Worship Whole-heartedly
