



- It can dull your motivation and focus. And it may be the dominant emotion of 2021.





New Hope 1. Holds us effectively: anchor of the soul

Some "Faith-Hopes" in the Book of Hebrews:

- 1. 3: 6 but Christ was faithful as a Son over His house—whose house we are, if we hold fast our confidence and the boast of our hope firm until the end.
 - = Hope of future glory and salvation
- 2. 7: 19 (for the Law made nothing perfect), and on the other hand there is a bringing in of a better hope, through which we draw near to God
 - = Hope of intimacy with God

Some "Faith-Hopes" in Hebrews:

- 3. 10: 23 Let us hold fast the *confession of our hope without wavering, for He who promised is faithful;
 - = Hope in Jesus

(3:1...consider Jesus, the Apostle and High Priest of our *confession)

Hope Within the Veil:




