THE BOLD CHURCH



- ACTS 4:1 As they spoke to the people, the priests, the captain of the temple, and the Sadducees came upon them, 2 being greatly troubled because they taught the people and preached through Jesus the resurrection from the dead.
- 3 And they seized them and put them in custody, for it was already evening. 4 But many of those who heard the word believed, and the number of the men grew to about five thousand.
- 5 On the next day their rulers, elders and scribes 6 were assembled at Jerusalem with Annas the high priest, and Caiaphas, and John and Alexander, and all who were of the family of the high priest.
- 7 When they had stood them in the midst, they asked, "By what power or by what name have you done this?"

ACTS 4:8 Then Peter, filled with the Holy Spirit, said to them, "Rulers of the people and elders of Israel: 9 If we today are being examined concerning a good deed done to a crippled man, how this man has been healed, 10 be it known to you all, and to all the people of Israel, that by the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, whom you crucified, whom God raised from the dead, by Him this man stands before you whole.





MATT 21:42-43 Jesus said to them, "Have you never read in the Scriptures: 'The stone the builders rejected has become the cornerstone' ... Therefore I tell you, the kingdom of God will be taken away from you and given to a people who will produce its fruit."

EPH 2:19-20 You are members of his household, built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, with Christ Jesus himself the chief cornerstone.

The events of Acts 4 take place just a few weeks after...
the disciples saw their promised King and Messiah arrested;
Peter had denied knowing Jesus not once, but three times;
John stood by Mary, watching her son Jesus die on the Cross;
a remnant of 120 disciples were holed up in the Upper Room.

Now they were BOLD enough to preach the name of Jesus, even in the face of the same hostile crowd who had Jesus killed, even though they were seized and held in custody, even when they faced the high priest and elders at their temple.

And the ONE MESSAGE they had (more urgent than their self-defence):

"There is no salvation in any other, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved." (4:12)

Their BOLD PROCLAMATION led 5,000 to believe in Jesus!

WHERE DID THEY FIND THEIR BOLDNESS/CONVICTION?

4:7 When they had stood them in the midst, they asked, "By what power or by what name have you done this?"

1. WHAT POWER? THE POWER OF THE HOLY SPIRIT!

4:8 Then Peter, filled with the Holy Spirit, said to them ... >> Their Pentecost Experience + the miracle in Acts 3

2. WHAT NAME? THE NAME OF JESUS!

4:2 ... they taught the people and preached through Jesus the resurrection from the dead.

>> Their Personal Experience: Jesus, Lazarus ...





ACTS 4:13 When they saw the boldness of Peter and John and perceived that they were illiterate and uneducated men, they marvelled. And they recognised that they had been with Jesus. 14 But seeing the man who was healed standing with them, they had nothing to say against it.

- 15 So when they had commanded them to go outside of the Sanhedrin, they conferred among themselves, 16 saying, "What shall we do to these men? For, indeed, that an acknowledged miracle has been done through them is revealed to all who dwell in Jerusalem, and we cannot deny it.
- 17 "But lest it spread further among the people, let us threaten them that they no longer speak to anyone in this name."

ACTS 4:18 Then they called them and commanded them not to speak or teach at all in the name of Jesus. 19 But Peter and John answered them, "Whether it is right in the sight of God to listen to you more than to God, you judge.

20 "For we cannot help but declare what we have seen and heard."

21 When they had further threatened them, they let them go, finding no way to punish them, because of the people.

For all glorified God for what was done, 22 for the man on whom this miracle of healing was performed was over forty years old.

Those watching may have denied that Jesus was the Messiah. But there was something all the onlookers could not deny:

The transformation in the followers of Jesus.

4:13 When they saw the boldness of Peter and John and perceived that they were illiterate and uneducated men, they marvelled. And they recognised that they had been with Jesus.

4:14 But seeing the man who was healed standing with them, they had nothing to say against it. 4:16 "Indeed, an acknowledged miracle has been done, revealed to all who dwell in Jerusalem, and we cannot deny it."

LESSON #1

You don't have to be "educated" to be an evangelist!
Your qualification is if you know Christ!

LESSON #2

People can dispute your theology – "theoretical" God – but they can't argue against your personal experience, or against personal transformation evidenced by all.

LESSON#3

If we have truly been touched & transformed by Christ, "we cannot help but declare what we have seen and heard"!
