



Hebrews 7:23 Also there were many priests (from the Tribe of Levi), because they were prevented by death from continuing.

Hebrews 7:2-3 to whom (**Melchizedek**) also Abraham gave a tenth part of all, first being translated "king of righteousness," and then also **king of Salem**, meaning "king of peace," without father, without mother, without genealogy, having neither beginning of days nor end of life, but made like the Son of God, remains a priest continually.

## 2. We have a Perfect High Priest

Hebrews 7:16-17, 22, 24-25

16 who has come, not according to the law of a fleshly commandment, but according to the power of an endless life.

17 For He testifies: “You are a priest forever according to the order of Melchizedek.”

22 by so much more Jesus has become a surety of a better covenant.

24 But He, because He continues forever, has an unchangeable priesthood. 25 Therefore He is also able to save to the uttermost those who come to God through Him, since He always lives to make intercession for them.

1. Let us **draw near** to God fully assured in faith.

Hebrews 10:22 let us **draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith**, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water.



We are to draw near to God **confidently and with boldness**.



This is because the Blood of Jesus can **perfectly and completely**:

- A. **forgive** us - 1 John 1:9
- B. **cleanse** us - 2 Corinthians 7:1
- C. **cover** us - Psalm 32:1

In the OT, the Israelites were commanded **NOT** to draw near - Exodus 19:12-23

1. Let us draw near to God fully assured in faith.

Hebrews 10:22 let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water. →

- Our fallen-ness inclines us to undo the finished works of Christ.
- We try to bring our own offerings for our sins in order to draw near to God
- This is what Israel under the OT did again and again.

Romans 10:3 For they being ignorant of God's righteousness, and seeking to establish their own righteousness, have not submitted to the righteousness of God. 4 For Christ is the end of the law for righteousness to everyone who believes.

1. Let us draw near to God fully assured in faith.

Hebrews 10:22 let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience ...



The issue is a guilty conscience + condemnation each time we fail!

Being short fused	Wandering eyes	Comparing	Cheating

1. Let us draw near to God fully assured in faith.

The issue is a guilty conscience + condemnation each time we fail!

- We are encouraged to draw near with our conscience already cleansed by faith.
- Guilty conscience is from our attempts by works rather than by faith.
- Hence, the encouragement to continually draw near to God fully assured in faith (in Christ not ourselves).

2 Corinthians 5:17



Hebrews 7:25 Therefore He is also able to save to the uttermost those who come to God through Him, since He always lives to make intercession for them.

1. Let us draw near to God fully assured in faith.

**Hebrews 10:22** let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water.

**Romans 6:3** Or do you not know that as many of us as were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into His death? **4** Therefore we were buried with Him through baptism into death, that just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life.

We declare in water baptism, we already died with Christ and now walk in new life in Him.

**Hebrews 10:14** By one sacrifice, He has perfected forever those who are being sanctified!

**James 4:6-8 [Steps to draw near to God]**



Hebrews 3:14 For we have become partakers of Christ if we hold the beginning of our confidence steadfast to the end.







**A.** Consider one another to stir up love.

**1 Peter 4:8** And above all things have fervent love for one another, for "love will cover a multitude of sins."

**Colossians 3:14** But above all these things put on love, which is the bond of perfection.

**B.** Consider one another to stir up good works.

(1) This is the other half of our personal destiny - purpose in life.  
(Matthew 5:16)

**Ephesians 2:10** For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them.

**Colossians 1:10** that you may walk worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing Him, being fruitful in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God.

**B.** Consider one another to stir up good works.

(2) Our good works must always be guided by the Word of God.

**2 Timothy 3:16-17** All Scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness, that the man of God may be complete, thoroughly equipped for every good work.

- offended • hurt • wounded • etc.

- having divine conversations




