


### Psalm 23

Will you stop viewing internet pornography and submit to God for deliverance and walk in holiness?




III. Know and experience the Lordship of the Good Shepherd.

This is all about making Jesus Lord and Master of our lives i.e. He desires that in everything, the sheep must go through the Shepherd.


1 Peter 2:25 For you were like sheep going astray, but have now
