There was a wide gulf in the views among the different age groups on the issue. About 67 per cent of respondents aged 18-29 have greater acceptance for same-sex relationships than they were three years ago, compared with only 29 per cent of respondents aged 50 years old and above.

6 Consistent with other recently published studies on gay attitudes in Singapore, those under 25 are roughly twice as tolerant as those over 50

Ms Melanie Ng, director of public affairs at Ipsos in Singapore, said: "Today, we continue to see a steady shift in societal attitudes, led by younger adult Singaporeans who are more ready to see the country embrace same-sex relationships.

"At the same time, while the older generation of Singaporeans remains largely opposed to same-sex relationships, we also see attitudes slowly changing."





BBTC PASTORAL MESSAGE (22 AUG)

ROMANS 12:1-3

1 Therefore, I urge you, brothers and sisters, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God—this is your true and proper worship.

WHAT MUST WE SURRENDER FOR A BIBLICAL WORLDVIEW?

... offer your <u>bodies</u> as a living sacrifice ...

... by the renewing of your mind ...

... do not think of yourself more highly than you ought ...

Because of what God has done for us, our response should be to surrender **our bodies, our minds, and our egos** to Him.

This is our reasonable service, our true and proper worship.

HOW DO WE POSTURE OURSELVES FOR BIBLICAL WORLDVIEW?

ROM 12:3 Do not think of yourself more highly than you ought, but rather think of yourself with sober judgment, in accordance with the faith God has distributed to each of you.

1. With humility. His ways/thoughts are higher than ours (Isa 55).

2. With soberness. If this matters to God, it should matter to us.

3. With faith. God has distributed to each of us faith! Activate it!

THE SWORD = WORD & SPIRIT

- EPH 6:17 The sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God.
- HEB 4:12 The word of God is living and active, sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing to the division of soul and of spirit, of joints and of marrow, and discerning the thoughts and intentions of the heart.

WE ARE GIVEN THE SWORD OF THE SPIRIT/WORD NOT TO <u>SLAY</u>, BUT TO <u>STAND</u>.

- EPH 6:11 & 13 "Put on the full armour of God, so that you can take your stand against the devil's schemes ... so that when the day of evil comes, you may be able to stand your ground, and after you have done everything, to stand."
- NEH 4:17-18 "Each laboured on the work with one hand and held his weapon with the other. And each of the builders had his sword strapped at his side while he built."

WHAT DO WE STAND ON? THE TRUTH!

- JOHN 16:13 When He, the <u>Spirit of truth</u>, comes, He will guide you into all the truth.

- 1. We must <u>KNOW</u> the Bible. No shortcuts!
- 2. We must <u>TEACH & TRANSMIT</u> its lessons.
- 3. We must not merely teach it, but <u>EXEMPLIFY</u> it in our lives.
- 4. Above all, the key lesson we must transmit in our discipleship is to <u>LOVE</u> <u>& TREASURE THE WORD</u>

We have much work ahead of us.
